to depose king richard and install henry bolingbroke on the english throne with the aid of his powerful friend hotspur henry is victorious but crowned henry iv he rules a kingdom in crisis in wales rebellion threatens henry s heir hal is named prince of wales but the welsh have a prince of their own blood and he is calling them to arms more dangerous still a rift is opening between henry hotspur and hal as tension mounts the three men are inexorably drawn into a bloody collision on which the fate of the realm will hang
