night by a mysterious woman the penchant of the informants for the fantastic in many of their tales often reflects their hopes and fears such as their dreams of suddenly acquiring wealth or their fears of being haunted by the dead miller closely observes the teller's relation to the stories to the duendes the ánimas death god the devil and she notes the tension on the part of the informant in his relation to their religion the material is documented according to several standard tale and motif indices and is placed within the context of the larger body of hispanic folk tradition by the citation of parallel versions throughout the hispanic world the tales transcribed from taped interviews are presented in colloquial spanish accompanied by summaries in english
