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latin america s economic performance is mediocre at best despite abundant natural resources and flourishing neighbors to the north the perplexing question of how some of the wealthiest nations in the world in the nineteenth century are now the most crisis prone has long puzzled economists and historians the decline of latin american economies examines the reality behind the struggling economies of argentina chile and mexico a distinguished panel of experts argues here that slow growth rampant protectionism and rising inflation plagued latin america for years where corrupt institutions and political unrest undermined the financial outlook of already besieged economies tracing latin america s growth and decline through two centuries this volume illustrates how a once prosperous continent now lags behind of interest to scholars and policymakers alike it offers new insight into the relationship between political systems and economic development

this revised and updated third edition contains a wealth of new material that draws on new research in this area

the book analyses present latin american issues in their historical course since independence beginning 1810 and its aftermath up to the contemporary period the authors focus on political economic social environmental and cultural developments it examines the legacies of the past and the multiple changes that have taken place in the last two centuries today s situation suggests that modernization is well under way and will continue offering broad insight into present and future concerns the book enables readers to evaluate potential areas of economic and social growth as well as assess risks stemming from past events

differences between latin american countries while recognizing the external influences to which the whole region has been subject victor bulmer thomas notes the failure of the region to close the gap in living standards between it and the united states and explores the reasons he also examines the new paradigm taking shape in latin america since the debt crisis of the 1980s and asks whether this new economic model will be able to bring the growth and improvement in equity that the region desperately needs this third edition contains a wealth of new material that draws on the new research in the area in the past ten years

in recent years the simultaneous development of prominent social movements and the election of left and centre left governments has radically altered the political landscape in latin america these social movements have ranged from the community based piqueteros of argentina that brought down three governments in the space of a month in 2001 to the indigenous movements in ecuador and bolivia that were instrumental in toppling five governments in the last decade and in the cases of venezuela and brazil social movements helped to provide the political base from which leftist leaders like hugo chávez and lula were swept into power by election this wide ranging volume moves beyond simple discussion of these social movements to address an issue that is crucial for politics in the region today but has yet to be properly analysed specifically what is the position of the social movements after progressive governments take power are they co opted in support of government policies or do they remain at arm s length as continuing opponents how many of the movement s demands are actually met and what happens when the government almost inevitably disappoints its supporters in such movements this unique and important work explores these questions shedding new light on how these social movements continue to operate in latin america

interracial sexual relations are often a key mythic basis for latin american national identities but the importance of this has been under explored peter wade provides a pioneering overview of the growing literature on race and sex in the region covering historical aspects and contemporary debates he includes both black and indigenous people in the frame as well as mixed and white people avoiding the implication that race means black white relations
