there exists a general lack of biblical understanding for the idea of testing that emerges in the old testament as a significant theological theme the faithful from both old testament and new testament times are tested for their faith this kind of experience often involves enduring hardship and difficult times while often confused with the biblical idea of temptation the biblical idea of testing stems from a metallurgical background and carries a unique covenantal function testing will be at the center of how god responds to the rebellion of his people and reveals god's primary concern for the faith of his saints our study will first focus on the language of testing and explore the semantic range for the idea of testing that draws from both the biblical context as well as the world of the ancient near east this study will then focus on the often overlooked joseph narrative and its unique contribution to the theology of testing that is presented by the rest of the pentateuch finally the remainder of the biblical texts will be investigated on the theme of testing the last chapter will appreciate the fact that god tests his sons adam abraham joseph mooses job israel and even christ it is through the experience of god's tested sons that believers are invited to more fully and deeply understand their own experience of testing

a cursory glance at hebrews critique of israel's fear at sinai in heb 12 18 29 suggests that the author has misunderstood or manipulated his sources in the pentateuch the appointment of moses as israel's mediator receives explicit approval exod 19 9 deut 5 28 while heb 12 25 labels their request for mediation a refusal to heed the word of god this book argues that hebrews use of the sinai narratives resides on a complex trajectory established by four points the sinai covenant according to exodus the reenactment of that covenant according to deuteronomy the call for a new covenant according to jeremiah and the present reality of that covenant established by god and mediated by jesus christ the basis for hebrews critique arises from its insight that while israel's request established covenant from a distance jesus demonstrates that true covenant mediation brings two parties into a single space the purpose for hebrews critique lies in its summons to zion the mountain on which jesus sits at the right hand of god as the high priestly mediator of the new covenant

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
