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khutbah ilhamiyyah the revealed sermon is an arabic sermon delivered by hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad the promised messiah as on the occasion of eid ul adha on that very morning of 11 april 1900 he had received the divine revelation today you will deliver the speech in arabic you have been endowed with this ability accordingly he stood up before a live audience of approximately 200 people and began to deliver the sermon ad lib a stream of eloquently structured sentences in the arabic language began to flow forth in rapid succession highlighting the nature and essence of the islamic philosophy of sacrifice we present here the actual text of the sermon as transcribed by two audience members while the sermon was simultaneously being delivered khutbah ilhamiyyah is an insightful read for anyone

seeking to behold a divine miracle in all its grandeur and glory and the profound mysteries deeply embedded within the arabic language

the life of one man has perhaps never been the centre of such passionate debate as with the case of jesus the messiah peace be upon him while some consider him imposter others believe he was saved from being hung on the cross by ascending into the heavens physically in this book with compelling testimony mirza ghulam ahmad peace be upon him presents the true and accurate biographical findings on the life of jesus he argues with conclusive historical evidence that jesus survived the crucifixion and travelled to kashmir india where he died at the ripe age of 120 toward the end of this treatise the author also sheds light on a prophecy regarding muhammad husain of batala and the purpose of a prayer duel with the same

the writings elucidate many of islamic teachings this book contains excerpts of his writings with topics ranging from allah to life after death the original text has been provided alongside the english translation

mere claims do not prove that a certain religion is true the distinct hallmark of a true and living religion is that it establishes the existence of god in every age and with undeniable evidence in this work mirza ghulam ahmad of qadian the promised messiah and mahdi explains that islam is a living religion that is not based on tales of the past but possesses the power to endow its followers the ability to manifest miracles and signs even today a tree is recognised by its fruit he states and the fruits of islam can be tasted by all even today the author takes up the challenge of dr henry martyn clark to engage in a debate that he said would once and for all settle the differences between christianity and islam and determine the superiority of one over the other a debate dubbed the holy war by dr clark the author presents copies of correspondence between dr clark and himself as well as letters to and from the muslims of jandiala who were to be represented in this debate it also contains the conditions settled for the aforementioned debate and proclaims a prophecy regarding muhammad husain of batala

the history of religion demonstrates that all prophets have suffered vehement opposition like all the prophets of god hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad of qadian the promised messiah and mahdi was also opposed throughout his life maulvi muhammad husain of batala a staunch opponent spared no opportunity to harm and malign the promised messiah when all else failed he began to submit false reports to the british government alleging that mirza ghulam ahmad was a rebel of the state and believed in the advent of a bloodthirsty violent mahdi who would force all non muslims to islam it was due to these false reports that the author wrote a brief but eloquent treatise outlining his true beliefs regarding the advent of the promised mahdi in islam in this book the author explains that the divinely appointed reformer and mahdi to appear in the latter days would bring a message of peace and conquer the world with love not through violence and bloodshed he also reassures the government of his loyalty to the state and exposes the hypocrisy of maulvi muhammad husain and the falsity of his reports to the government

our teaching is an abridged version of the teaching of the holy founder of the ahmadiyya muslim community as laid down in his book kashti e nuh noah s ark this book is addressed primarily to members of the ahmadiyya muslim community for their moral and spiritual education its contents however are so spiritually inspiring

that anyone in search of truth and spirituality can derive benefit from it it is a must read for anyone who wishes to understand the essence of ahmadiyya beliefs and the standard of righteousness that ahmadi muslims must strive to uphold this teaching is none other than what has been taught in the holy quran indeed the promised messiah as and the holy founder of the ahmadiyya muslim community has said whoever neglects even a minor commandment out of the 700 commandments of the holy quran closes the door of salvation upon himself

hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad as of qadian claimed to be the same promised messiah and mahdi that the holy prophet muhammad sas prophesied would come to rejuvenate islam and restore its original lustre during his early life mirza ghulam ahmad as saw a dream in which he handed a book of his own authorship to the holy prophet sas as soon as the book touched the holy prophet s blessed hand it transformed into a beautiful honey filled fruit which was then used to revive a dead person lying nearby the promised messiah as was inspired with the following interpretation allah the almighty then put it in my mind that the dead person in my dream was islam and that allah the almighty would revive it at my hands through the spiritual power of the holy prophet peace and blessings of allah be upon him it is this very book barahin e ahmadiyya which is to be instrumental in revitalizing islam in the latter days in accordance with the grand prophecy of the holy prophet sas its subject matter is of universal importance and as such it will prove to be a source of lasting value for all readers this significance of barahin e ahmadiyya cannot be overstated

the malfuzat are a compilation of discourses letters and narrations of the promised messiah may peace of allah be upon him they offer a unique insight into the interactions between the promised messiah as and his eager audiences great and small and how his divinely inspired wisdom and intellect quenched the souls of a world thirsting for guidance these indescribably enchanting experiences compelled eyewitnesses to record them in an attempt to seize those special moments for future generations in the hopes that they might somewhat behold the magnetic aura radiating from the long awaited imam of the age this present edition of malfuzat is the complete english translation of the urdu volume 10 and covers the period from november 1907 through may 1908 this period represents the last several months of the promised messiah s life and testifies to his selfless dedication and tireless efforts to bring about the victory of islam over ignorance right up to his final breath upon reading these accounts one cannot help but feel an immense debt of gratitude for the revolutionary ideas and innovative arguments with which he quickened a nation that was all but dead

the book was written by the promised messiah as on 20th august 1899 and published on 24th august 1899 in this brief exposition the promised messiah as has presented in a new light the same views expressed in his book tohfa e qaisariyyah a gift for the queen which was written on the occasion of the diamond jubilee of her majesty queen victoria in this book the promised messiah as has once again commended the british government for granting peace security and religious freedom to all its subjects he has then refuted the false doctrine of the advent of a militant messiah and mahdi who according to some would presumably coerce the world into accepting islam furthermore he has also beautifully removed misconceptions surrounding the concept of jihad and clearly expounds that islam was never spread by the sword nor is religious compulsion permitted in islam the promised messiah as then goes on to beautifully explain that the christian concept of

atonement which logically results in jesus as bearing the burden of curse is a dishonour to the pure and holy person of jesus as finally the promised messiah as has presented his claim as being the promised messiah and mahdi of the latter days awaited by all world religions

siratul abdal hallmarks of the saints was penned in arabic by hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad the promised messiah peace be on him in 1903 the book describes the distinctive qualities morals and virtues that set apart those who have made a holy change in themselves for the sake of god indeed the life of the promised messiah himself is a compelling portrait of the characteristics of such holy personages siratul abdal is a masterpiece of the arabic language employing the most eloquent powerful and persuasive features of expression of classical arabic although the eloquence of the original text simply cannot be reproduced in another language every effort has been made to convey the message of the original arabic text

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held under the auspices of hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad the promised messiah and mahdi as february 2 1900 was the day of eidul fitr hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad as the promised messiah and mahdi advised the members of the jama at to hold a meeting on that day and offer prayers for the success of the british government in his address he commented on the chapter an naas of the holy qur an and reminded the audience of the duties they owed to the government especially because of the goodness of the government which it had displayed in various ways after the address he told the gathering to pray for the victory of the british government in the battle that was being fought in transvaal and then led a silent prayer for this purpose some amount was collected to be sent for the injured in this battle this gathering of the jama at came to be known as the prayer meeting

fath e islam the victory of islam is an urdu treatise penned in 1890 by hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad as the promised messiah and mahdi it outlines the divinely ordained strategy to combat the aggressive misinformation campaigns orchestrated by the christian missionaries throughout the muslim world accordingly the promised messiah as implemented the following five branches 1 publishing books 2 distributing leaflets 3 hosting guests and visitors in search of truth 4 replying to letters of inquiry 5 establishing a community through bai at initiation through these five initiatives the promised messiah as was not only able to effectively defend islam and the holy prophet muhammad sa against the widespread slanders but he also took the offensive by exposing the fundamental weaknesses of the christian faith and its deviations from the true teachings of jesus as

at a time when injustice immorality and sin ran rampant the religion of islam dawned to revive the bond between humanity and its creator and to establish peace in the world it was at the hand of the prophet of islam that an unparalleled moral and spiritual transformation took place but the holy prophet muhammad peace and blessings of allah be upon him prophesied that a time would come when the true teachings of islam would be forgotten and at this time a divinely appointed reformer would appear to rejuvenate islam in fulfilment of this prophecy hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad peace be upon him appeared in qadian india and claimed to be the divinely appointed reformer awaited by all the world religions this book comprises an address delivered by the promised messiah in which he speaks about the purpose of his advent and what it means to be an ahmadi

the book the miracle of ahmad i jāz e ahmadi is one of the signs of truthfulness of the founder of ahmadiyya muslim community it was written in 1902 when an opponent in mudh india alleged that all prophecies made by hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad as were false and that he did not possess the miraculous knowledge of the arabic language he had claimed in response the promised messiah as wrote this book containing a lengthy arabic qasīdah ode in praise of the holy prophet muhammad may peace and blessings of allah be upon him in a mere five days he challenged his opponents to produce the like of it and announced a prize money of rs 10 000 which was his total worth at the time no one arose to the challenge instead a large number of residents of town of mudh were decimated by the plague as prophesied in this book

the third plague pandemic claimed millions of lives in india and raged with particular intensity in the punjab province by 1902 it had encroached within a few miles of the environs of qadian twenty two years earlier the promised messiah mirza ghulam ahmad as of qadian had prophesied the outbreak of such a plague he boldly proclaimed on the basis of the divine revelation that as a sign of his truthfulness god would safeguard qadian even though it lay directly in the path of this ravaging disease the promised messiah as also pointed out that god had foretold in previous holy scriptures that he would send a severe plague as a warning in the latter days when the promised messiah would appear in defence against the plague the promised messiah as reviews various proposals put forward to fight the bubonic plague and then prescribes the true method for deliverance that people should reform themselves and accept the promised messiah as commissioned by god

the great reformer is the english translation of mujaddid e azam a comprehensive biography of the mujjadid reformer in islam and founder of the ahmadiyya movement hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad by a close associate and compatriot dr basharat ahmad this monumental research work published in urdu in three volumes was translated into english in 2008 by hamid rahman phd it is widely considered to be the most authentic and complete portrayal of the great and tireless service rendered to islam by the founder of the ahmadiyya movement the first two volumes published in 1939 and 1940 respectively consist of the founder s life history and also contain synopsis of each of his major urdu arabic and persian works the third volume deals with his islamic philosophy thoughts exposition of islamic concepts defense of islam in reply to non muslim critics and his mission of carrying the message of islam to the west

islam is a religion that inculcates the importance of being loyal to the country in which one lives hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad peace be upon him the promised

messiah and mahdi and founder of the ahmadiyya muslim community always taught the same to his followers however maulvi muhammad husain of batala a staunch opponent sought to defame the author by sending false reports to the government alleging that the promised messiah peace be upon him was a man who secretly conspired against the state against this backdrop the author was moved to pen this treatise in which he outlines his own family background and the long standing services of his family in support of the british government he also presents a succinct summary of the teachings of his community moreover the author explains that muslims who believe in the return of a violent mahdi who would forcibly convert the world to islam could not be further from the truth

ahmadis and the aryas of qadian is the english translation of qadian kei arya aur hamm written by hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad the promised messiah as and published in 1907 the background to this book is that during the jalsa salana of 1906 in the month of december that year whilst the promised messiah as was leading zuhr prayer a hindu got up and began uttering the most vile obscenities to a crowd of almost 2 000 guests who were praying behind the promised messiah when the promised messiah as had completed his prayers he felt the hearts of his followers to be aggrieved owing to the abuse and comforted them by saying a few words he highlighted that the hindus of qadian were the foremost witnesses of the signs which had been manifested at his hand as they were the first people to witness them he further explained which signs had been manifested that caused thousands of people to enter the fold of his community many of which were directly related to the hindu faith the promised messiah as challenges two aryas by name to swear on oath whether the signs of the promised messiah as are false stating that he is certain that if they falsely swear an oath god s wrath shall descend upon them

this is the third volume of the series bearing the title the essence of islam the first volume of which was published in 1979 like the first volume it sets out in the words of the promised messiah hazrat mirza ghulam ahmad of qadian himself a summary of his exposition of four further topics family and personal background status of the promised messiah as the purpose of the promised messiah s advent propagation establishment of a holy jama at and instructions

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
