tarnishing wolfie's reputation monty dedicates himself to uncovering the truth for the sake of the man's family and to satisfy his own persistent sense of unease monty discovers that wolfie's zealous studies of glacier's mysterious embattled wolverine population so vital to park ecology had met resistance both local and federal to muddy the waters further a wilderness facility for rehabilitating troubled teens one that monty's older brother attended may have a disturbing connection to the case as monty delves further into an investigation that goes deeper than he ever imagined he wrestles with the demons of his past which lead back to harsh betrayals he thought he'd buried long ago and then a second body is found

a moving chronicle of who belongs in america like so many american factory towns lewiston maine thrived until its mill jobs disappeared and the young began leaving but then the story unexpectedly veered over the course of fifteen years the city became home to thousands of african immigrants and along the way turned into one of the most muslim towns in the us now about 6 000 of lewiston s 36 000 inhabitants are refugees and asylum seekers many of them somali cynthia anderson tells the story of this fractious yet resilient city near where she grew up offering the unfolding drama of a community s reinvention and humanizing some of the defining political issues in america today in lewiston progress is real but precarious anderson takes the reader deep into the lives of both immigrants and lifelong mainers a single muslim mom an anti islamist activist a congolese asylum seeker a somali community leader their lives unfold in these pages as anti immigrant sentiment rises across the us and national realities collide with those in lewiston home now gives a poignant account of america s evolving relationship with religion and race and makes a sensitive yet powerful case for embracing change

on april 22 1896 martin begnaud was brutally murdered in his general store in scott station louisiana he was bound gagged blindfolded stabbed more than fifty times and robbed of over 5 000 ten months later after one of the most extensive manhunts in nineteenth century louisiana public shock and outrage reemerged when two teenage brothers from france ernest and alexis blanc were arrested for the

crime william arceneaux sets the story of begnaud s murder the blanc brothers trial and the media circus surrounding it all against the backdrop of acadian history from the 1604 establishment of a french colony in the canadian maritime provinces to the eventual creation of a new acadia in south louisiana by intertwining a suspenseful account of this heinous crime with an exploration of the citizens it affected no spark of malice provides insight into a fascinating people place and era

on most days the wilderness gave me peace but not tonight in a land sculpted by glaciers the forest is on fire thick smoke chokes the mountain air and casts an apocalyptic glow over the imposing peaks and vistas of montana s glacier national park when firefighters are called in to dig firebreaks near the small town bordering the park a crew member is shocked to unearth a shallow grave containing human remains park police officer monty harris is summoned to the site to conduct an excavation but with an incendiary monster threatening to consume the town monty seeks help from gretchen larson the county s lead crime scene investigator while the two work frantically to determine the true identity of the victim a teenager suddenly disappears from one of the campgrounds in glacier could the cases somehow be connected as chances for recovery of the missing boy grow slimmer and the fbi finds only dead ends gretchen and monty desperately race to fit all the pieces together while battling time the elements and their own unresolved inner conflicts the weight of night is the latest novel in an award winning series which paints a moving picture of complex flawed people fighting to make their way in a wilderness where little is black or white publishers weekly it is a gripping tribute to the power of redemption set against one of america s most majestic and unforgiving landscapes

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this book fills an important niche for the birdwatching community by offering comprehensive entries detailing the best locations for finding birds throughout the state for enthusiasts of all levels of skill and interest it contains descriptions of 201 birding sites in maine with explicit directions on how to get there for all sixteen of the state s counties several as large as other new england states each chapter features a county map a brief overview by derek j lovitch numerous specific site guides and a list of rarities the book also contains a detailed and useful species accounts guide for finding the most sought after birds

barry forshaw is acknowledged as a leading expert on crime fiction and film following his books on nordic noir brit noir and euro noir he now tackles the largest and some might argue most impressive body of crime fiction from a single country the united states to produce the perfect reader s guide to modern american crime fiction the word noir is used in its loosest sense every major living american writer is considered including the giants harlan coben patricia cornwell james lee burke james ellroy and sara paretsky as well as non crime writers such as stephen king who stray into the genre often through a concentration on one or two key books many exciting new talents are highlighted and barry forshaw s knowledge of and personal acquaintance with many of the writers grants valuable insight into this massively popular field but the crime genre is as much about films and tv as it is about books and american noir is a celebration of the former as well as the latter us television crime drama in particular is enjoying a golden age and all of the important current series are covered here as well as key contemporary films

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
