this annotated bibliography of nineteenth century british periodicals complete with a detailed subject index reveals how victorian commentaries on journalism shaped the discourse on the origins and contemporary character of the domestic imperial and foreign press drawn from a wide range of publications representing diverse political economic religious social and literary views this book contains over 4 500 entries and features extracts from over forty nineteenth century periodicals the articles cataloged offer a thorough and influential analysis of their journalistic milieu presenting statistics on sales and descriptions of advertising passing judgment on space allocations pinpointing different readerships and identifying individuals who engaged with the press either exclusively or occasionally most importantly the bibliography demonstrates that columnists routinely articulated ideas about the purpose of the press yet rarely recognized the illogic of prioritizing public good and private profit simultaneously thus highlighting implicitly a universal characteristic of journalism its fractious ambiguous conflicting behavior

sheds new light on the presence and impact of continental european literary traditions in post napoleonic britain

contends that gender politics were influential in the early development of literary criticism and

the writings of female critics

the collected works of john stuart mill took thirty years to complete and is acknowledged as the definitive edition of j s mill and as one of the finest works editions ever completed mill s contributions to philosophy economics and history and in the roles of scholar politician and journalist can hardly be overstated and this edition remains the only reliable version of the full range of mill s writings each volume contains extensive notes a new introduction and an index many of the volumes have been unavailable for some time but the works are now again available both as a complete set and as individual volumes

the first of three volumes charting the history of the modernist magazine in britain north america and europe this collection offers the first comprehensive study of the wide and varied range of little magazines which were so instrumental in introducing the new writing and ideas that came to constitute literary and artistic modernism in the uk and ireland in thirty seven chapters covering over eighty magazines expert contributors investigate the inner dynamics and economic and intellectual conditions that governed the life of these fugitive but vibrant publications we learn of the role of editors and sponsors the relation of the arts to contemporary philosophy and politics the effects of war and economic depression and of the survival in hard times of radical ideas and a belief in innovation the chapters are arranged according to historical themes with accompanying contextual introductions and include studies of the new age blast the egoist and the criterion new writing new verse and scrutiny as well as of lesser known magazines such as the evergreen coterie the bermondsey book the mask welsh review the modern scot and the bell to return to the pages of these magazines returns us a world where the material constraints of costs and anxieties over censorship and declining readerships ran alongside the excitement of a new poem or manifesto this collection therefore confirms the value of magazine culture to the field of modernist studies it provides a rich and hitherto under examined resource which both brings to light the debate and dialogue out of which modernism evolved and helps us recover the vitality and potential of that earlier discussion

transatlantic footholds turn of the century american women writers and british reviewers analyses british reviews of american women fiction writers essayists and poets between the periods of literary domesticity and modernism the book demonstrates that a variety of american women writers were intelligently read in britain during this era british reviewers read american women as literary artists as women and as americans while their notion of who counted as women was too limited by race and class they eagerly read these writers for insight about how women around the world were entering debates on women s place the class struggle religion indian policy childrearing and high society in the process by reading american women in varied ways reviewers

became hybrid and dissenting readers the taste among british reviewers for american women s books helped change the predominant direction that high culture flowed across the atlantic from east to west to west to east britons working in london or far afield were deeply invested in the idea of america america their responses prove is a transnational construct

coverage of publications outside the uk and in non english languages expands steadily until in 1991 it occupies enough of the guide to require publication in parts

in the law of evidence in victorian england which was originally published in 1997 christopher allen provides a fascinating account of the political social and intellectual influences on the development of evidence law during the victorian period his book sets out to challenge the traditional view of the significance of jeremy bentham s critique of the state of contemporary evidence law and shows how statutory reforms were achieved for reasons that had little to do with bentham s radical programme and how evidence law was developed by common law judges in a way diametrically opposed to that advocated by bentham dr allen s meticulous account provides a wealth of detail into the functioning of courts in victorian england and will appeal to everyone interested in the english legal system during this period

the work details the emergence in the post napoleonic war period of a growing popular interest in the critical potentialities of political economy it considers why this occurred and discusses how the conceptual and analytical tools of political economy were utilised to formulate a critique of early industrial capitalism the book examines the theories of labour exploitation and capitalist crisis which represented the essence of that critique both as they were elaborated by early nineteenth century british anti capitalist and socialist writers and as they were popularised by writers in the working class press of the period 1816 34 the book argues that by 1834 in consequence of the efforts of writers such as hodgskin thompson gray owen and their popularisers the foundations of a distinctively anti capitalist and socialist political economy had been established and widely disseminated but these foundations were theoretically flawed they were flawed by an overconcentration on the sphere of exchange which derived from a particular conception of the determination of exchange value under capitalism an overconcentration which led on to the suggestion of remedies for the problem of working class poverty and distress which were necessarily doomed to failure

james mill s 1773 1836 role in the development of utilitarian thought in the nineteenth century has been overshadowed both by john stuart mill 1806 1873 and by jeremy bentham 1748 1832 of the three the elder mill is considered to be the least original and with the least important if any contributions to utilitarian theory true as this statement may be even those who have tried to challenge some of its aspects take the common portrayal of mill the rationalist the maker of

sylogisms the geometrician as given this book does not studying james mill s background has surprising results with reference to influences outside the benthamite tradition as well as unexpected implications for his contributions to debates of his time the book focuses on his political ideas the ways in which he communicated them and the ways in which he formed them in an attempt to reveal a portrait of mill unencumbered from the legacy of thomas babington macaulay s 1800 1859 brilliant essay utilitarian logic and politics

after adam smith looks at how politics political economy were articulated altered in the century following the publication of smith s wealth of nations

the correspondence of jeremy bentham volume 13 contains authoritative and fully annotated texts of all known and publishable letters sent both to and from bentham between 1 july 1828 and his death on 6 june 1832 in addition to 474 letters the volume contains three memorandums concerning bentham s health shortly before this death his last will and testament and extracts from both the autobiography and the manuscript diaries of bentham s nephew george of the letters that have already been published most are drawn from the edition of the works of jeremy bentham prepared under the superintendence of bentham s literary executor john bowring a small number of letters have been reproduced from newspapers and periodicals this volume publishes for the first time all the extant correspondence between bentham and daniel o connell the irish liberator other new acquaintances included charles sinclair cullen barrister and law reformer and john tyrrell the real property commissioner throughout the period bentham maintained regular contact with old friends and connections but he also entered into sporadic correspondence with such leading figures in government as the duke of wellington robert peel and henry brougham further afield bentham corresponded amongst others with the marquis de la fayette in france edward livingston in the united states of america and josé del valle in guatemala

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
