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rambles of a runaway from southern slavery tells of an extraordinary life in and out of slavery in the united states and canada born elijah turner in the virginia tidewater circa 1810 the author eventually procured freedom papers from a man he resembled and took the man s name henry goings his life story takes us on an epic journey traveling from his virginia birthplace through the cotton kingdom of the lower south and upon his escape from slavery through tennessee and kentucky then on to the great lakes region of the north and to canada his rambles show that slaves were found not only in fields but also on the nation s roads and rivers perpetually in motion in massive coffles or as solitary runaways a freedom narrative as well as a slave narrative this compact yet detailed book illustrates many important developments in antebellum america such as the large scale forced migration of enslaved people from long established slave societies in the eastern united states to new settlements on the cotton frontier the political economic processes that framed that migration and the accompanying human anguish goings s life and reflections serve as important primary documents of african american life and of american national expansion the civil war and reconstruction this edition features an informative and insightful introduction by calvin schermerhorn

every year in the united states almost two million children run away from home in addition on the average the police in our country have at any one time over 100 000 active missing adult cases this book will show readers how with just a little advance preparation and insight they can greatly increase their chances of finding a missing loved one even after police have stopped actively looking with sensationalized child disappearances teenagers vanishing and adults faking their own deaths the challenge of finding missing persons often falls most directly on those who love them and though in past years this involved a considerable amount of footwork that is no longer the case with the advent of the internet and the many new search engines available much of the searching and canvassing can now be done from computers family members and friends looking for missing loved ones need to know what programs and databases to access though to get the search under way snow reveals to readers the process the police use when trying to locate missing people of interest information that readers can then use to locate their own missing loved ones using real stories and first hand accounts the author offers hope and guidance to those who may have given up the search for a child a spouse a parent or a friend

this new bold precedent setting study conclusively demonstrates that contrary to popular belief significant numbers of slaves did quite frequently rebel against their masters and struggled to attain their freedom by surveying a wealth of documents such as planters records petitions to county courts and state legislatures and local newspapers the book shows readers how slaves resisted when where and how they escaped where they fled to how long they remained in hiding and how they survived away from the plantation of equal importance it also examines the reactions of the white slaveholding class revealing how they marshaled considerable effort to prevent runaways meted out severe punishments and established patrols to hunt down escaped slaves reflecting a lifetime of thought by one of our leading authorities on african american history runaway slaves illuminates as never before the true nature of that most peculiar institution of the south

combining archaeological and historical methods gabino la rosa corzo provides the most detailed and accurate available account of the runaway slave settlements palenques that formed in the inaccessible mountain chains of eastern cuba from 1737 to 1850 decades before the end of slavery on the island the traces that remain of these communities provide important clues to historical processes such as slave resistance and emancipation anticolonial insurgency and the emergence of a free peasantry some of the communities developed into thriving towns that still exist today la rosa challenges the claims of previous scholars and demonstrates how romanticized the communities have become in historical memory in part by using detailed maps drawn on site la rosa shows that palenques were smaller and fewer in number than previously thought and they contained mostly local rather than long distance fugitives in addition the residents were less aggressive and violent than myth holds often preferring to flee rather than fight a system of oppression that was even more effective and organized than generally supposed la rosa s study illuminates many social and economic issues related to the african diaspora in the caribbean with particular focus on slavery resistance and independence this translation makes the book available in english for the first time

this straightforward reference surveys the knowledge base on homeless runaway and thrown away children and adolescents and makes concrete recommendations for policy and practice it is a comprehensive volume that covers new state legislation in the u s dealing with runaway and homeless youth the book s ecological approach grounds readers in the demographics of this diverse population family and other risk factors for leaving home and alternative arrangements such as foster care and the survival skills homeless young people use to sustain themselves chapters cover a gamut of physical psychological and social problems from drug abuse to depression to stis with special attention paid to the multiple difficulties faced by lgbt street youth and street youths experiences with the legal and justice systems the author also assesses established and emerging interventions used with runaway youth and the effectiveness of policy initiatives dealing with improving conditions for youth on the streets and at risk included in the coverage runaway youth at the time of their disappearance food insecurity and related problems among homeless and runaway youth substance use among homeless and runaway adolescents runaway and homeless sexual minorities court responses to runaway offenses and other juvenile status violations street youth in different countries presenting the complex situation as it stands and with clear suggestions for action runaway and homeless youth is a valuable resource for family therapists sociologists social workers school administrators health professionals police judges and other criminal justice professional along with professionals involved in young people s well being and policy making initiatives

this concise and accessible new text examines the correlations between runaway children and teenage prostitution in the united states from a criminological sociological and psychological perspective the author takes a systematic approach to defining and describing the differences between youth who run away from home and those who leave institutional settings and distinguishes the difference between runaway and throwaway children a careful examination of teenage prostitution among girls and boys helps to illuminate the special problems faced by children who have run away in addition the author discusses laws related to runaways teenage prostitution and the sexual exploitation of minors as well as the criminal justice response to the problems runaways and prostitution involving youth in other countries is also explored the text s findings support current conclusions on the characteristics of runaways the relationship between runaways and teen prostitution and the implications of running away from home runaway kids and teenage prostitution is divided into five parts part i examines the scope and dynamics of running away and differentiates between runaways and throwaways part ii explores teenage prostitution and provides information on girl and boy prostitutes and the people who exploit them child sexual abuse and child pornography as correlates to the problem are studied in part iii and part iv reviews the law that attempts to combat teenage prostitution part v is devoted to an examination of the scope and significance of the problem in other countries together these chapters provide readers with a clear picture of the problem of runaways and teenage prostitution in the united states and around the world

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
