this book constitutes the refereed proceedings of the 4th dementia lab conference d lab 2019 held in eindhoven the netherlands in october 2019 the 12 full and 7 short papers presented in this volume were carefully reviewed and selected from 53 submissions the papers are organized in topical sections inclusion participation technology experience and dementia lab ideas

this book presents an international perspective of the influence of educational context on science education the focus is on the interactions between curriculum development and implementation particularly in non western and non english speaking contexts i e outside the uk usa australia nz etc an important and distinguishing feature of the book is that it draws upon the experiences and research from local experts from an extremely diverse cohort across the world 26 countries in total the book addresses topics such as curriculum development research or evaluation of an implemented curriculum discussion of pressures driving curriculum reform or implementation of new curricula e g technology or environmental education the influence of political cultural societal or religious mores on education governmental or ministerial drives for curriculum reform economic or other pressures driving curriculum reform the influence of external assessment regimes on curriculum and so on

this laboratory manual accompanies the eighth edition of chemistry in context applying chemistry to society this manual provides laboratory experiments that are relevant to science and technology issues with hands on experimentation and

data collection it contains 34 experiments to aid the understanding of the scientific method and the role that science plays in addressing societal issues experiments use microscale equipment wellplates and beral type pipets and common materials project type and cooperative collaborative laboratory experiments are included with the movement towards sustainability and green chemistry the investigations in this lab were developed to use minimally toxic reagents and to use them in small quantities where possible

this book first published in 1996 presents a collection of papers by gordon foxall charting the development of the behavioural perspective model bpm which he devised in the early 1980s and subsequently developed the model offers a unique and original behaviour based theory of consumer choice in seeking to answer the question where does consumer choice take place by drawing upon behavioural psychology foxall presents an exciting challenge to previous theories whose emphasis has been on the internal working of the consumer s mind in reaching rational decisions and choices bringing alive the important subject of economic consumption this seminal volume will be of great interest to students and researchers in consumer research
