for over a century the idea that african americans are psychologically damaged has played an important role in discussions of race in this provocative work daryl michael scott argues that damage imagery has been the product of liberals and conservatives of racists and antiracists while racial conservatives often playing on white contempt for blacks have sought to use findings of black pathology to justify exclusionary policies racial liberals have used damage imagery primarily to promote policies of inclusion and rehabilitation in advancing his argument scott challenges some long held beliefs about the history of damage imagery he rediscovers the liberal impulses behind stanley elkins s sambo hypothesis and daniel patrick moynihan s negro family and exposes the damage imagery in the work of ralph ellison the leading anti pathologist he also corrects the view that the chicago school depicted blacks as pathological products of matriarchy new negro experts such as charles johnson and e franklin frazier he says disdained sympathy seeking and refrained from exploring individual pathology scott s

reassessment of social science sheds new light on brown v board of education revealing how experts reversed four decades of theory in order to represent segregation as inherently damaging to blacks in this controversial work scott warns the left of the dangers in their recent rediscovery of damage imagery in an age of conservative reform

this edited volume first published in 1999 attempts to integrate neo darwinian and culturalist perspectives in the study of emotion

an informal yet rigorous exploration of human emotions in all their complexity and subtlety why do we cry at the movies what is the best way to manage destructive feelings such as jealousy although emotions pervade our lives their nature causes and effects have only recently been studied by social scientists and philosophers despite growing scientific interest in the subject empirical findings have not yet caught up with our intuitive knowledge in this book aaron ben ze ev carries out what he calls a careful search for general patterns in the primeval jungle of emotions in an engaging informal style he draws on a variety of theoretical approaches and popular sources to produce a coherent account of emotions in all their subtlety all of the ideas are illustrated with examples drawn from everyday life the book is organized into two parts the first presents an overall conceptual framework for understanding emotions it looks at the typical characteristics and components of emotions distinguishes emotions from other affective phenomena classifies the emotions and covers such related issues as emotional intelligence regulating emotions and emotions and morality the second part discusses individual emotions including envy jealousy pleasure in others misfortune pity compassion anger hate disgust love sexual desire happiness sadness pride regret and shame the text is laced with insightful and often amusing quotations from sources ranging from mae west to montesquieu

friedrich nietzsche 1844 1900 is widely acknowledged as one of the greatest thinkers of the nineteenth century his work continues to have a significant influence on philosophy cultural criticism and modern intellectual history the nietzschean mind seeks to provide a comprehensive survey of his work not only placing it in its historical context but also exploring its contemporary significance comprising twenty eight chapters by a team of international contributors the volume is divided into seven parts major works philosophical psychology and agency the self value culture society and politics metaphysics and epistemology the affirmation of life this handbook includes coverage of all major aspects of nietzsche s thought including his discussions of value culture society the self agency action philosophical psychology epistemology and metaphysics explorations of the philosophical and scientific influences upon nietzsche s thought and discussion of nietzsche s major works essential reading for students and researchers in philosophy nietzsche s work is central to ethics moral psychology and political philosophy

sometimes funny sometimes infuriating sometimes heartbreaking this is the story of one young man s quest for meaning in an increasingly meaningless world

natalie mylonas uses ezekiel 16 as a case study in order to reveal the critical relationship between space emotion and identity politics in the hebrew bible drawing on interdisciplinary research that emphasises how space and emotions are inextricably linked in human experience mylonas explores the portrayal of yhwh s wife jerusalem in ezekiel 16 as a personified city who feels emotion she foregrounds purity and gender issues as well as debates on emotions in the hebrew bible emphasising that

spatiality is a key component of how these issues are conceptualised in ancient israel this book argues that the power struggle between jerusalem and yhwh in ezekiel 16 is a struggle over the contested space of jerusalem s body and the city space jerusalem s emotions are in a dynamic relationship with the spaces in the text they are signified by these spaces shift as the constitution of the spaces shifts and are shaped by jerusalem s use of space her desire pride and shamelessness are communicated spatially through her use of city space while her representation as disgusting is underscored by her uncontrollable female body mylonas concludes by showing how ezekiel s vision of the new jerusalem in ezekiel 40 48 re establishes sacred space through the erasure of the feminine city metaphor coupled with strict boundary policing which is a far cry from the assault on jerusalem s boundaries described in ezekiel 16

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
