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with the 1989 beijing massacre fading from popular memory in the west china from the mid 1990s to a few years ago felt more open than ever to global trade communication travel and cultural and educational exchanges there was even talk in the mainstream press that china was heading toward a more democratic future it was during this second sino western honeymoon that authors in the us canada france the uk and elsewhere began writing mystery fiction set in contemporary china in their regional languages these china mysteries crime detective and mystery thriller novels that take place in china but were not written or published there formed a new genre of popular fiction that highlighted the world's hopes and fears after tiananmen the multinational and multicultural writers of china mysteries among them ex prc nationals like qiu xiaolong zhang xinxin and diane wei liang converged on the china mainland to negotiate political and cultural complexities through crime fiction plotlines their books emerged from western lineages of the modern novel and popular genre fiction with chinese contributions and depended on western commercial publishing models shaped by cultural national political and economic factors this work examines more than a hundred china mysteries many describing and analyzing social and economic changes at the center of modern life in china to provide a brief history of the genre and analyze the formulaic and original elements of the mysteries including their attention to matters of location social content characterization history and biography it also highlights the role of information acquisition as a motivation for readers and authors of popular fiction which has become a topic of discussion in chinese literature studies with its timely commentary on sino western relations as presented through crime fiction china mysteries will appeal to students and scholars of contemporary chinese literature and culture as well as fans of crime novels and others who are curious about the global dimensions of the genre and how it complicates our understanding of world literature

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the foreigner is a familiar character in popular crime fiction from the foreign detective whose outsider status provides a unique perspective on a familiar or exotic location to the xenophobic portrayal of the criminal other exploring popular crime fiction from across the world the foreign in international crime fiction examines these popular works as transcultural contact zones in which writers can tackle such issues as national identity immigration globalization and diaspora communities offering readings of 20th and 21st century crime writing from norway the uk india china europe and australasia the essays in this book open up new directions for scholarship on crime writing and transnational literatures

exploring how margaret atwood s fiction reimagines the figure of the detective and the nature of crime jackie shead shows how the author radically reworks the crime fiction genre shead focuses on surfacing bodily harm alias grace the blind assassin oryx and crake and selected short fiction showing the ways in which atwood s protagonists are confronted by their own collusion in hegemonic assumptions and thus are motivated to investigate and expose crimes of gender class and colonialism

shead begins with a discussion of how atwood's treatment of crime fiction's generic elements particularly those of the whodunit clue puzzle and spy thriller departs from convention through discussion of atwood's metafictional strategies shead also examines atwood's techniques for activating her readers as investigators who are offered an educative process parallel to that experienced by some of the author's protagonists this book also marks a significant intervention in an ongoing debate among atwood critics that pits the author's postmodernism against her ethical and humanistic concerns

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in the first major study of representations of world war ii in french crime fiction margaret anne hutton draws on a corpus of over a hundred and fifty texts spanning more than sixty years included are well known writers male and female such as aubert simenon boileau narcejak vargas daeninckx and jonquet as well as a broad range of lesser known authors hutton's introduction situates her study within the larger framework of literary representations of world war ii setting the stage for her discussions of genre the problem of defining crimes and criminals in the context of the war the epistemological issues that arise in the relationship between world war ii historiography and the crime novel and the temporal textures linking past crimes to the present filling a gap in the fields of crime fiction and fictional representations of the war hutton's book calls into question the way both crime fiction and the french theatre of world war ii have been conceptualized and codified

for trained firearm investigators a bullet casing or trajectory can tell a story where was the shooter standing did the bullet come from his gun from early cases like the st valentine's day massacre to present day war crimes in croatia discover the techniques that firearms investigators have developed and utilized to solve crimes

how exactly is money laundered the answer to this question is not well understood and for this very reason costly prevention measures remain ineffective this much-needed book provides the first in-depth explanation of the methods used by intelligent criminals to amass wealth from large-scale trafficking in drugs arms and human beings as well as from less odious crimes the author shows clearly not only why existing approaches to combat money laundering are bound to fail but also how money

launderers easily circumvent such measures based on qualitative interviews with both alleged criminals and prevention experts detailed illustrations of concrete steps taken by intelligent and specialized perpetrators of money laundering allow practitioners to anticipate and effectively combat this type of crime the author fully documents such aspects of money launderers behaviour as the following resources required dealing with detection risks and international mobility a central chapter covers in depth the various markets institutions and facilities that are particularly favourable to money laundering and original insights accompany the presented findings with relevant quotations from the interviewees the author offers tailored recommendations for different professional groups including bankers prosecutors defence lawyers and judges in its critical questioning of the logic behind anti money laundering regulations and their costly implementation the book demonstrates that either the existing measures of prevention are drastically tightened and extended to almost all branches of the economy or the financial sector is relieved of the burden it bears and alternative ways of fighting this type of crime are sought instead it will prove enormously valuable to understanding and investigating white collar and financial crime and be welcomed by practitioners and professionals in financial markets banking criminal lawyers and compliance experts as well as academia
