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this 1935 book answered some of the theological questions raised by moral man and immoral society 1932 and articulated for the first time niebuhr's theological position on many issues

a practical guide to soil tests for Australian soils and conditions

combining pragmatics dialectics analytics and legal theory this work translates interpretative canons into patterns of natural argument

presenting a realistic interpretation of quantum mechanics and in particular a realistic view of quantum waves this book defends with one exception Schrodinger's views on quantum mechanics Johansson goes on to defend the view that the collapse of a wave function during a measurement is a real physical collapse of a wave and argues that the collapse is a consequence of quantisation of interaction lastly Johansson argues for a revised principle of individuation in the quantum domain and that this principle enables a sort of explanation of non-local phenomena

using the model of reading other people's mail William Countryman proposes that we read the letters of the New Testament as an ongoing conversation between the text itself and the modern interpreter and the community

this is a multi-disciplinary study that adopts an innovative and original approach to a highly topical question that of meaning-making in museums focusing its attention on pedagogy and visual culture this work explores such questions as how and why is it that museums select and arrange artefacts shape knowledge construct a view how do museums produce values how do active audiences make meaning from what they experience in museums this stimulating book provokes debate and discussion on these topics and puts forward the idea of a new museum the post-museum which will challenge the familiar modernist museum a must for students and professionals in the field

Horace's book of sermons also called satires was his first published work rather than a collection of satirical sideswipes as the genre might have dictated the book is a wiry tight muscular interlaced hexameter artwork of enormous originality and as far removed from the legacy of satirical writing he inherited

as one can imagine it is the work of a 29 year old grappling with issues of personal and poetic identity during one of the most important and pivotal times in european history geographically socially and genetically an outsider horace earned himself a seat at rome s top creative table close to the heart of the political engine that was to change rome forever his book details a transformational journey from nobody to somebody and is a simultaneous invention of poet and reinvention of poetic genre horace s sermones have floated in and out of fashion ever since they first appeared regularly eclipsed by his odes today rehabilitated they find space in the higher levels of the school curriculum this book provides unique insights and will be of interest to all classicists as well as students studying core influences on european literature

reading and textual interpretation are ordinary human activities performed inside as well as outside academia but precisely how they function as unique sources of knowledge is not well understood in this book rené van woudenberg explores the nature of reading and how it is distinct from perception and attending to testimony which are two widely acknowledged knowledge sources after distinguishing seven accounts of interpretation van woudenberg discusses the question of whether all reading inevitably involves interpretation and shows that although reading and interpretation often go together they are distinct activities he goes on to argue that both reading and interpretation can be paths to realistically conceived truth and explains the conditions under which we are justified in believing that they do indeed lead us to the truth along the way he offers clear and novel analyses of reading meaning interpretation and interpretative knowledge

if a treaty from the 1850s regulating commerce or forbidding degrading treatment of persons is to be interpreted 150 years later does commerce or degrading treatment of persons have the same meaning at the time of interpretation as they had when the treaty was agreed the evolutionary interpretation of treaties has proven one of the most controversial topics in the practice of international law indeed it has been seen as going against the very grain of the law of treaties and has been argued to be contrary to the intention of the parties breaching the principle of consent this book asks what the place of evolutionary interpretation is within the understanding of treaties at a time when many important international legal instruments are over 50 years old it sets out to place the evolutionary interpretation of treaties on a firm footing within the general rule of interpretation as codified in article 31 of the vienna convention on the law of treaties the book demonstrates that the evolutionary interpretation of treaties in common with all other types of interpretation such as good faith the text of the treaty context object and purpose is in fact based upon an objective understanding of the intention of the parties in order to marry intention and evolution in this way the book argues that on the one hand evolutionary interpretation is the product of the correct application of article 31 and on the other that article 31 is geared towards the establishment of the intention of the parties the evolutionary interpretation of treaties is therefore shown to represent an intended evolution

this book reassesses the academic field of political theory and brings into sharp relief its problems and opportunities here for the first time diverse theorists coordinate their arguments through a common focus this focus is the writing of john g gunnell gunnell attacks a set of myths said to plague almost every recent theory about politics the myth of the given the myth of science myths of theory the myth of tradition and the myth of the political he argues that these all alienate political theory from substantive inquiry and actual practice contributors include richard e flathman russell l hanson george kateb paul f kress j donald moon john s nelson j g a pocock herbert g reid ira l strauber nathan tarcov and sheldon s wolin they respond on behalf of projects in the new history of political theory epic theory phenomenology traditional theory and political deconstruction these discussions also address the

theories of hans georg gadamer jürgen habermas karl marx leo strauss alain touraine and ludwig wittgenstein at the conclusion of the volume gunnell reconsiders his arguments in light of the respondent's remarks his challenges thus provide a series of confrontations both exciting and provocative among major theorists the result is a lively debate about what political theory is how it relates to political history and practice and how it involves epistemology the authors probe a broad range of questions about practices of politics and traditions of discourse and they identify priorities for the future of the field

in the aftermath of the discoveries in foundations of mathematics there was surprisingly little effect on mathematics as a whole if one looks at standard textbooks in different mathematical disciplines especially those closer to what is referred to as applied mathematics there is little trace of those developments outside of mathematical logic and model theory but it seems fair to say that there is a widespread conviction that the principles embodied in the zermelo fraenkel theory with choice zfc are a correct description of the set theoretic underpinnings of mathematics in most textbooks of the kind referred to above there is of course no discussion of these matters and set theory is assumed informally although more advanced principles like choice or sometimes replacement are often mentioned explicitly this implicitly fixes a point of view of the mathematical universe which is at odds with the results in foundations for example most mathematicians still take it for granted that the real number system is uniquely determined up to isomorphism which is a correct point of view as long as one does not accept to look at unnatural interpretations of the membership relation
