ornithologies of desire develops ecocritical reading strategies that engage scientific texts field guides and observation focusing on poetry about birds and birdwatching this book argues that attending to specific details about the physical world when reading environmentally conscious poetry invites a critical humility in the face of environmental crises and evolutionary history the poetry and poetics of don mckay provide ornithologies of desire with its primary subject matter which is predicated on attention to ornithological knowledge and avian metaphors this focus on birds enables a consideration of more broadly ecological relations and concerns since an awareness of birds in their habitats insists on awareness of plants insects mammals rocks and all else that constitutes place the book s chapters are organized according to apparatus that is science as ecocritical tool flight and song

queer lives across the wall examines the everyday lives of queer berliners between 1945 and 1970 tracing private and public queer life from the end of the nazi regime through the gay and lesbian liberation movements of the 1970s andrea rottmann explores how certain spaces including homes bars streets parks and prisons facilitated and restricted queer lives in the overwhelmingly conservative climate that characterized both german postwar states with a theoretical toolkit informed by feminist queer and spatial theories the book goes beyond previous histories that focus on state surveillance and the persecution of male homosexuality

this book probes occluded depictions of queerness in early english drama ranging from medieval morality plays to reformation interludes and beyond

the instability of modernist form has everything to do with the social political and economic shakeups of the nineteenth century that left masculinity a site of contestation racial anxiety homophobic paranoia performative display and queer desire refusing to take white masculinity for granted daniel hannah considers how the canonical novels of modernist fiction explore the ways that privilege is propped up and driven by factors of race place gender and sexuality queer atlantic examines the work of established writers herman melville robert louis stevenson henry james joseph conrad and ford madox ford to reveal that anxieties surrounding white masculine privilege and queer potential helped broaden the novel s formal possibilities demonstrating how masculine mobility and often specifically transatlantic mobility both enacts and queerly disorients male privilege hannah places these writers in the context of debates about naval impressment piracy emigration colonization and the new imperialism in the process he raises important questions about the current field of queer ethics highlighting the strange companionship of queer openness to otherness and imperialist thought in modernist writing arguing for the surprising resilience of such fictional structures queer atlantic provides a new understanding of modernism s emergence from a troubling of masculine privilege mobility and desire
