allusions to mi kmaq tradition and to kluska played an important role in the struggle against a planned superquarry on cape breton this study discusses the eco cosmology that has been formulated by modern reserve inhabitants which could be labelled a sacred ecology focusing on how the mi kmaq are rebuilding their traditions and environmental relations in interaction with modern society hornborg illustrates how environmental groups pan indianism and education play an important role but so does reserve life by anchoring their engagement in reserve life the mi kmaq traditionalists have to a large extent been able to confront both external and internal doubts about their authenticity

grant illuminates how today s scientific culture originated with the religious thinkers of the middle ages
