in the turbulent decade which produced the canadian confederation of 1867 a group of seasoned veterans of the american civil war turned their attention to the conquest of canada they were irish american revolutionaries unique because they fought under their own flag they were know as the fenians and they believed that the first step on the road to the liberation of ireland was to invade canada the last invasion of canada vividly recaptures the drama of the decade it recounts the fledgling nation s rag tag but patriotic defence against an enemy committed to a glorious cause but with only scattered resources it is a story of courage espionage and petty crime and of mismatched motivations and goals

what kind of a country is canada beyond quebec with a referendum on quebec sovereignty looming on the horizon this is a question Canadians are being forced to ask in beyond quebec scholars from a wide variety of disciplines examine the current political cultural economic and social situation of Canada outside Quebec and speculate on the nature of a Canada that does not include Quebec on the present terms

more than a quarter of a century has passed since Canada promised to recognize and respect the rights of children under the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child ratification of the convention cannot however guarantee that everyone will abandon proprietary notions about children or that all children will be free to enjoy the substance of their rights in every social and institutional context in which they find themselves including and perhaps especially within families this disconnect remains one of the most important challenges to the recognition of children's rights in Canada the authors argue that social toxins are as harmful to children's independent welfare and developmental interests as environmental toxins and that both must be eradicated if Canada is to fulfill its commitments under the convention they also argue that if Canada wishes to ensure the substance of the rights outlined in the convention are socially guaranteed an attitudinal or cultural shift is required concerning the moral and legal status of children this revised expanded and updated edition of the bestselling *Challenge of Children's Rights for Canada* will be of interest to academics policymakers parents teachers social workers and human service professionals indeed to anyone who cares about and for children

the Rowell-Sirois Commission and the Remaking of Canadian Federalism investigates the groundbreaking inquiry launched to reconstruct the federal system and reveals its legacy for Canadian federalism today in 1937 the Canadian Confederation was broken as the depression ground on the provinces faced increasing obligations but limited funds while the Dominion had fewer responsibilities but lucrative revenue sources the commission was struck to review the system overcoming a process beset by conflicts the report proposed a bold new form of federalism based on the national collection of major tax revenues and unconditional transfers of these revenues to provinces based on

fiscal need robert wardhaugh and barry ferguson dig through the evidence and counter misconceptions to demonstrate that even though the report was at first rejected it provided a storehouse of innovative ideas that redefined the nature of federal government and shaped policy and thinking about federalism for decades

while translation history in canada is well documented the history of the translation of canadian fiction outside the nation remains obscure les belles Étrangères examines the translation of canadian english language fiction in france this book considers the history of this practice the reasons for the move away from quebec translators as well as the process and perils involved in this detour within a theoretical framework and drawing on primary sources this study considers the historical theoretical and concrete aspects of this practice through the study of the translations of authors such as robertson davies carol shields margaret atwood michael ondatje ann marie macdonald and alistair macleod the book also includes a comprehensive bibliography of english language novels poetry and plays published and translated in france over the past 240 years
