expected to generate by increasing the accuracy of economic efficiency conclusions exceed the predicted allocative cost of its execution and public financing the book also uses the protocol to analyze the economic efficiency of specific policies so as to illustrate both how it differs from the protocols that most applied welfare economists continue to use and how its conclusions differ from those produced by standard analysis
