language is a system of communication in which grammatical structures function to express meaning in context while all languages can achieve the same basic communicative ends they each use different means to achieve them particularly in the divergent ways that syntax semantics and pragmatics interact across languages this book looks in detail at how structure meaning and communicative function interact in human languages working within the framework of role and reference grammar rrg van valin proposes a set of rules called the

linking algorithm which relates syntactic and semantic representations to each other with discourse pragmatics playing a role in the linking using this model he discusses the full range of grammatical phenomena including the structures of simple and complex sentences verb and argument structure voice reflexivization and extraction restrictions clearly written and comprehensive this book will be welcomed by all those working on the interface between syntax semantics and pragmatics

this work first published in 1985 is an analysis of the syntax of the albanian verb complex the term verb complex is defined here as the verb stem and its conjugational endings together with the perfect auxiliaries and verb clitics in a wider sense the verb includes the verb and its central arguments subject direct object and indirect object the analysis is presented in a somewhat expanded version of the relational grammar framework of perlmutter and postal 1977 it is argued that by assuming the existence of multiple levels in the syntactic structure of a clause it is possible to account for the distribution of active and non active verb forms over the various constructions of albanian with a single generalisation this title will be of interest to students of language and linguistics

this study argues that the domain traditionally covered by coordination and subordination in english can be subdivided into four distinct construction types the constructions are defined on the basis of differences in their interpersonal structure i e the grammatical encoding of speaker attitude and speaker interlocutor interaction it is shown that the four types constitute syntactically semantically and pragmatically coherent categories with differences in interpersonal structure defining and motivating distinct syntactic behaviour distinct pragmatic functions and distinct semantic classes of clause linkage the validity of the analysis is demonstrated in three ways first it is shown that the analysis can make sense of the wide range of apparently conflicting criteria found in the literature on complex sentences which can now be explained as reflections of four different construction types rather than as alternative perspectives on one single contrast between coordination and subordination second it is shown how the analysis can deal with two specific problems in the more general area of clause combining viz the syntactic basis of the distinction between content epistemic and speech act levels of clause linkage and the distinct discursive functions associated with initial and final position of adverbial clauses finally it is also shown that the proposed analysis is useful beyond the analysis of english with parallels in a number of cross linguistically recurrent phenomena of clause linkage the book is mainly of interest to linguistics researchers in the areas of syntax semantics and pragmatics as well as to graduate students with a focus on these fields

This book offers reconstructions of various syntactic properties of Proto-Germanic including verb position in main clauses the syntax of the *wh* system and the non occurrence of null pronominal subjects and objects although previous studies have looked at the lexical and phonological reconstruction of Proto-Germanic little is currently known about the syntax of the language and it has even been argued that the reconstruction of syntax is impossible Dr Walkden uses extensive evidence from the early Germanic languages Old English Old High German Old Saxon Old Norse and Gothic to show that syntactic reconstruction is not only possible but also profitable he argues that while the reconstruction of syntax differs from lexical phonological reconstruction due to the so called correspondence problem this is not insurmountable in fact the approach taken in current minimalist theories in which syntactic variation is attributed to the properties of lexical items opens the door for syntactic reconstruction as lexical reconstruction the book also discusses practical solutions for circumventing the correspondence problem in particular the use of both distributional properties of lexical items and the phonological forms of such items in order to establish cognacy the book will be of interest to historical linguists working on syntactic reconstruction and the Germanic languages from graduate level upwards as well as to advanced students of syntactic change more generally
