this volume examines the specific gender roles in peace and security the authors analyse the implementation process of united nations security council resolution 1325 in various countries and discuss systemic challenges concerning the women peace and security agenda through in depth case studies the authors shed new light on topics such as the gender related mechanisms of peace processes gender training practices for police personnel and the importance of violence prevention the volume

studies the role of women in peace and security as well as questions of gender mainstreaming by adopting various theoretical concepts including feminist theories concepts of masculinity organizational and security studies it also highlights regional and transnational approaches for the implementation of the women peace and security agenda namely the perspectives of the european union nato the un bureaucracy and the civil society it presents best cases and political advice for tackling the problem of gender inequality in peace and security

over the past 20 years scholars policymakers and the media have increasingly recognized the links between both traditional and non traditional security issues and the changing condition of the global environment concepts such as environmental security and resource conflict have been used to hint at these significant linkages while there has been a good deal of scholarly work conducted that seeks to identify the ways that actors link these concepts there has been little examination of the intersection between approaches to environmental security and gender this book explores this intersection to provide an insight into the gendered nature of both global environmental politics and security studies it examines how the issues of security and the environment are linked to theory and practice and the extent to which gender informs these discussions by adopting a feminist environmental security discourse this book provides crucial redefinitions of key concepts and offers new insights into the ways we understand security environment connections case studies evaluate if and how environment and security discourses are being used to understand a range of environmental issues and how a feminist environmental security discourse contributes to our understanding of security environment connections this multidisciplinary volume draws on literature from the environmental sciences security studies and sociology to highlight the complex human insecurities that often accompany environmental change as conceptualizations of security continue to shift and broaden to include environmental issues and concerns it is imperative that gender informs the debate

this collection of essays by feminist scholar activists addresses the crucial problem of human security in a world of heavily armed militarized states it describes the gendered aspects of human security excluded from the realist militarism that dominates current security policy in most nation states the book deepens and broadens current security discourses encouraging serious consideration of alternatives to the present global security system that functions to advantage state security over human security a system the contributors perceive to be rooted in the patriarchal nature of the nation state this second edition will be of interest to academics and students of gender studies women s studies international studies development studies human rights security studies peace studies and peace education

through the integration of gender analysis into resilience thinking this book shares field based research insights from a collaborative integrated project aimed at improving food security in subsistence and smallholder agricultural systems the scope of the book is both local and multi scalar the gendered resilience framework illustrated here with detailed case studies from semi arid kenya is shown to be suitable for use in analysis in other geographic regions and across disciplines the book examines the importance of gender equity to the strengthening of socio ecological resilience case studies reflect multidisciplinary perspectives and focus on a range of issues from microfinance to informal seed systems the book s gender perspective also incorporates consideration of age or generational relations and cultural dimensions in order to embrace the complexity of existing socio economic realities in rural farming communities the issue of succession of farmland has become a general concern both to farmers and to researchers focused on building resilient farming systems building resilience here is shown to involve strengthening households and communities overall livelihood capabilities in the face of ongoing climate change global market volatility and political instability

this book examines how the security council has approached issues of gender equality since 2000 written by academics activists and practitioners the book challenges the reader to consider how women s

participation gender equality sexual violence and the prevalence of economic disadvantages might be addressed in post conflict communities

there is often a moment in time that acts as a rallying point around a particular issue 2015 was one of those moments for women peace and security as numerous landmark anniversaries were celebrated in the field africa has in many ways been the global laboratory for the gender peace and security agenda not only because of the number of conflicts occurring on the continent but also because african regional organisations governments and civil society organisations have been at the forefront of striving for gender equality and implementing united nations security council resolution 1325 this book explores gender peace and security in africa from multiple angles including the conceptual and implementation challenges and shifts around women peace and security in africa over the last 15 years women s role as combatants in national liberation forces in south africa the dynamics of gender in the military through the lens of kenyan women combatants food security through a feminist lens and a series of case studies on the nexus between gender and security in zimbabwe nigeria madagascar the democratic republic of congo kenya and somalia this book was previously published as a special issue of the african security review

the united nations security council in 2000 unanimously passed a resolution calling for women s increased participation in conflict prevention and peacebuilding as well as their protection during conflict this marked the first time that the un security council explicitly addressed gender issues in conflict and post conflict situations but what difference has this international agenda on women peace and security made to women s lives on the ground and to the governance of international peace and security this volume provides a critical evaluation of the mainstreaming of gender issues in matters of international peace and security resulting from the passage of resolution 1325 in 2000 it considers how this agenda actually plays out in different contexts and with what implications for women s activism and for peace and security the picture that emerges is not uniform obliging us to reconsider the links between gender

conflict different visions of peace and consequently different projects of peacebuilding consequently the book poses new questions for transnational feminist scholars and activists this book was based on a special issue of the international feminist journal of politics

this book investigates competing modes of thought about gender security and aims to understand the policy implications of personal political imaginations the work draws upon extensive research conducted by the author in serbia to develop a comprehensive picture of how feminist and women s organising relates to the broader national and international contexts surrounding gender security through an innovative analytical framework of personal political imaginations the book explores the role that memories perceptions and hopes about conflict and post conflict have upon the logics of gender security it investigates how contrasting and competing modes of thought about gender security are made paying attention to how the dynamics of gender politics in serbia shape the security discourse and narratives of activists the volume explores in detail how feminist and women s organisations have responded to UNSC 1325 by analysing two policy debates and campaigns that seek to achieve its goals and gender security in serbia 1 feminist antimilitarism and 2 connecting domestic violence to the abuse of small arms and light weapons ultimately the book argues that the configuration of gender security discourse is intimately linked to personal political imaginations of conflict and post conflict this book will be of much interest to students of gender politics conflict studies critical security studies european politics and in general

fifteen years after the adoption of UN Security Council Resolution 1325 which establishes the women peace and security agenda there is now a need to assess the impacts of gender equality efforts and to

understand why and how gender equality reforms have advanced to the extent that they have this book examines how international peace and security is re envisioned from a gender perspective by mostly focusing on the nuances presented by the asia pacific region it argues that despite the diversity of political socio cultural and economic systems in the asia pacific women and girls in the region continue to experience similar forms of insecurities several countries in the asia pacific have demonstrated relative peace and stability in addition women s leadership and participation in peacebuilding are and continue to be increasingly recognized in the region too however as the chapters in this book demonstrate applying a critical gender analysis allows for the interrogation of veneers of political order which can then mask or normalise everyday gendered insecurities the analysis of country cases such as myanmar cambodia and fiji underscores a rethinking of the political order in the asia pacific which leaves existing gender inequalities intact the chapters in this book were originally published in a special issue in the international feminist journal of politics

this book examines the relationship between women gender and the international security agenda exploring the meaning of security in terms of discourse and practice as well as the larger goals and strategies of the global women s movement today many complex global problems are being located within the security logic from the environment to hiv aids state and non state actors have made a practice out of securitizing issues that are not conventionally seen as such as most prominently demonstrated by the un security council resolution 1325 2001 activists for women s rights have increasingly framed women s rights and gender inequality as security issues in an attempt to gain access to the international security agenda particularly in the context of the united nations this book explores the nature and implications of the use of security language as a political framework for women tracing and analyzing the organizational dynamics of women s activism in the united nations system and how women have come to embrace and been impacted by the security framework globally and locally the book argues that

from a feminist and human security perspective efforts to engender the security discourse have had both a broadening and limiting effect highlighting reasons to be sceptical of securitization as an inherently beneficial strategy four cases studies are used to develop the core themes 1 the campaign to implement un security council resolution 1325 2 the strategies utilized by those advocating women s issues in the security arena compared to those advocating for children 3 the organizational development of the un development fund for women and how it has come to securitize women and 4 the activity of the un peacebuilding commission and its challenges in gendering its security approach the work will be of interest to students of critical security gender studies international organizations and international relations in general natalie florea hudson received her phd in political science from the university of connecticut and is an assistant professor at the university of dayton she specializes in gender and international relations human rights international security studies and international law and organization

master s thesis from the year 2011 in the subject politics topic development politics grade 1 7 university of duisburg essen course politikwissenschaften internationale beziehungen und entwicklungspolitik language english abstract the ambition of this thesis is to investigate the significance of gender issues for reforming the security sector further on it will be analyzed which gender strategies are crucial for police reform and to which extent gender sensitive police reform gspr can contribute to a reduction of violence against women the case study shall examine to which extent gender issues were integrated in gspr in sierra leone based on these findings this analysis will develop recommendations how gender can be integrated successfully into security sector reform the theoretical part of this paper illustrates the concept of security sector reform and its meaning for peace building and development in addition relevant dimensions and actors are introduced combined with the exemplification of influencing factors and potential obstacles afterwards the concept of gender is discussed including its relevance for development cooperation as well as a description of gender based violence and its consequences the theoretical part concludes by merging these two concepts and illustrates the relevance and strategies of gender sensitive

police reform the second part of this analysis focuses on gender and police reform in sierra leone this chapter begins with a brief description of the civil war in sierra leone as well as the prevalence of gender based violence afterwards the chapter analyses to which extent gender sensitive strategies were integrated in police reform the paper concludes with recommendations for further gender sensitive strategies in the security sector and argues if effective police reform can reduce the emergence of gender based violence

this handbook provides a comprehensive look at the study of gender and security in global politics the volume is based on the core argument that gender is conceptually necessary to thinking about central questions of security analytically important for thinking about cause and effect in security and politically important for considering possibilities of making the world better in the future contributions to the volume look at various aspects of studying gender and security through diverse lenses that engage diverse feminisms with diverse policy concerns and working with diverse theoretical contributions from scholars of security more broadly it is grouped into four thematic sections gendered approaches to security including theoretical conceptual and methodological approaches gendered insecurities in global politics including the ways insecurity in global politics is distributed and read on the basis of gender gendered practices of security including how policy practice and theory work together or do not gendered security institutions across a wide variety of spaces and places in global politics this handbook will be of great interest to students of gender studies security studies and ir in general

this volume explores the implementation of key gender policies in international peace and security following the adoption of un security council resolution 1325 in october 2000 the first thematic resolution on women peace and security how should we understand women s participation in peace processes and in peace operations and what forms of gendered security dynamics are present in armed conflict and international interventions these questions represent central themes of protection and participation that the international community has to address in order to implement unscr 1325 thus far

the implementation has often employed varying approaches related to gender mainstreaming a third theme of the resolution yet there is a dearth of systematic data which until recently has restricted the ability of researchers to evaluate the progress in implementation and impact of unscr 1325 by engaging with both empirics and critical theory the authors of this edited volume make important contributions to the gender peace and security agenda they identify some of the problems of implementing unsc 1325 and offer a sobering assessment of progress of implementation and insights into how to advance our understanding through systematic research many of the chapters are focused on operational aspects of unscr 1325 but all also engage with the theoretical underpinnings of unscr 1325 to bring forth central debates on more fundamental challenges to the development of knowledge in the fields of gender peace and security this book will be of much interest to students of gender studies peace and conflict studies security studies and ir in general

how do understandings of the relationships between gender violence security and the international inform policy and practice in which these notions are central what are the practical implications of basing policy on problematic discourses in this highly original poststructural feminist critique the author maps the discursive terrains of institutions both ngos and the un which formulate and implement resolutions and guides of practice that affect gender issues in the context of international policy practices the author investigates un security council resolution 1325 passed in 2000 to address gender issues in conflict areas in order to examine the discursive construction of security policy that takes gender seriously in doing so she argues that language is not merely descriptive of social political reality but rather constitutive of it moving from concept to discourse and in turn to practice the author analyses the ways in which the resolution s discursive construction had an enormous influence over the practicalities of its implementation and how the resulting tensions and inconsistencies in its construction contributed to its failures the book argues for a re conceptualisation of gendered violence in conjunction with security in

order to avoid partial and highly problematic understandings of their practical relationship drawing together theoretical work on discourses of gender violence and international security sexualised violence in war gender and peace processes and the domestic international dichotomy with her own rigorous empirical investigation the author develops a compelling discourse theoretical analysis that promises to have far reaching impact in both academic and policy environments

peace and security offers both a broad overview of what is being done in conflict affected countries to advance women s participation in peace processes peacebuilding and decision making the authors examine the implementation of un security council resolution 1325 on women peace and security and present evidence based case studies from timor leste fiji and sri lanka to suggest key actions needed five fundamental aspects flow through the book a specifically feminist methodology a priority on gender equality and women s empowerment and broad notions of human security and peacebuilding while identifying obstacles the emphasis is on articulating best practices in numerous contexts and outlining key actions to be taken by development agencies women s ngos and policy makers peace and security explores ways to protect women and girls from violence ensure gender perspectives in peacekeeping and increasing participation of women in decision making

gender and peacebuilding offers a comprehensive and up to date analysis of how and why gender matters in contemporary peace operations it draws on a wide range of examples from across the world to offer a nuanced account of the uns attempts to mainstream gender into peace operations via security council resolution 1325 and assesses the successes and failures of this effort to enhance the participation and protection of women and girls in peacebuilding operations in presenting this mixed picture of progress and ongoing challenges the book argues for bold steps forward that will enable peacebuilding to contest the current neoliberal order address structural inequalities and bring about feminist visions of peace and security it is only by focusing attention on the economic empowerment of women and its ability to

temper the dangers of neo liberalism in post conflict contexts that feminists can hope to achieve these aims timely critical and engaged this book provides an invaluable guide to the issues for students of peace and conflict studies and sets the agenda for future scholarship and advocacy

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
