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intelligence has never been a more important factor in international affairs than it is today since the end of the second world war vast intelligence bureaucracies have emerged to play an increasingly important role in the making of national policy within all major states one of the biggest problems within the contemporary thinking about intelligence and international relations is a lack of historical context observers routinely comment on the challenges facing intelligence communities without reflecting on the historical forces that have shaped these communities over the past two centuries as presented in this volume new perspectives on the evolution of intelligence services and intelligence practice over the past 200 years can only enrich ongoing debates over how best to reform national intelligence structures the practices of war and international politics were transformed by the conflicts of the french revolution and the napoleonic era one of the most important outcomes of this transformation was the gradual emergence of permanent and increasingly professionalized intelligence services within the military and foreign policy establishments of the great powers the contributions in this volume consider the causes and consequences of this trend as well as its impact on war strategy and statecraft the rise of permanent intelligence bureaucracies has combined with technological progress to transform practices of intelligence collection and analysis that have remained essentially unchanged since the roman era ultimately however the nature and limits

of intelligence have remained constant rendering intelligence little or no more effective in reducing uncertainty at the opening of the 21st century than in centuries past

contrary to longtime assumptions about the insular nature of imperial china s legal system circulating the code demonstrates that in the qing dynasty 1644 1911 most legal books were commercially published and available to anyone who could afford to buy them publishers not only extended circulation of the dynastic code and other legal texts but also enhanced the judicial authority of case precedents and unofficial legal commentaries by making them more broadly available in convenient formats as a result the laws no longer represented privileged knowledge monopolized by the imperial state and elites trade in commercial legal imprints contributed to the formation of a new legal culture that included the free flow of accurate information the rise of nonofficial legal experts a large law savvy population and a high litigation rate comparing different official and commercial editions of the qing code popular handbooks for amateur legal practitioners and manuals for community legal lectures ting zhang demonstrates how the dissemination of legal information transformed chinese law judicial authority and popular legal consciousness

this book by maaïke okano heijmans makes an important contribution to the concept of economic diplomacy a conceptual study mode of economic diplomacy is combined with applied analysis of japan s economic diplomacy practice the two approaches reinforce one another yielding a conceptualization of economic diplomacy that is grounded in practical insights a comprehensive approach a core argument in the book is that economic diplomacy strategically affirms that economic commercial interests and political interests reinforce one another and should thus be seen in tandem this contrasts with the predominant approach in
