from anonymous to the dark a dizzying account of hacking past present and future brilliantly researched and written jon snow channel 4 news a comprehensive and intelligible account of the elusive world of hacking and cybercrime over the last two decades lively insightful and often alarming ewen macaskill guardian on may 4 2000 an email that read kindly check the attached loveletter was sent from a computer in the philippines attached was a virus the love bug and within days it had been circulated across the globe paralyzing banks broadcasters and businesses in its wake and extending as far as the uk parliament and reportedly the pentagon the outbreak presaged a new era of online mayhem the age of crime dot com in this book investigative journalist geoff white charts the astonishing development of hacking from its conception in the united states hippy tech community in the 1970s through its childhood among the ruins of the eastern bloc to its coming of age as one of the most dangerous and pervasive threats to our connected world he takes us inside the workings of real life cybercrimes drawing on interviews with those behind the most devastating hacks and revealing how the tactics employed by high tech crooks to make millions are being harnessed by nation states to target voters cripple power networks and even prepare for cyber war from anonymous to the dark

ashley madison to election rigging crime dot com is a thrilling dizzying and terrifying account of hacking past and present what the future has in store and how we might protect ourselves from it

probably the biggest story in football of the last decade reads like a cold war thriller best football books of 2019 fourfourtwo one anonymous football fan 18 6 million confidential documents this is the explosive story of the biggest leak in sporting history and the shady underworld of modern football in 2016 a whistle blower known only as john started to leak a treasure trove of top secret files to german newspaper der spiegel these documents reveal the clandestine dealings of clubs players and agents at the highest echelons of international football and the story they tell is astonishing from the eye popping details of player transfers including neymar jr pogba and coutinho to the loopholes and opaque tax structures that ensure maximum earnings for players and agents alike this is a tale rife with rapacious greed and questionable deals at the same time it is the gripping story of a fan who wanted to free football from its corrupt overlords and now finds himself on the run

analyzing the political consequences of the most extensive corruption investigation in recent latin american history operação lava jato media leaks and corruption in brazil answers two central questions about the contradictory effects news media has on political systems first how can political actors in a seemingly well functioning democracy quickly override checks and balances and replace a head of state with a corrupt vice president second how can very active news media while ostensibly performing the role of the watchdog still fail to deliver media accountability to the public combining a quantitative view of the media sphere with case studies of the leaks legal actions and alliances forming and breaking in the brazilian congress mads bjelke damgaard demonstrates that the media s attention to leaks and investigations of corruption paved the way for dilma rousseff s impeachment by timing the disclosure of information in scandals actors with inside information were able to drive the media agenda and let some scandals escape from the limelight the book delivers an in depth study of how scandals become political weapons in a time of media personalities and post politics this book will interest scholars of latin american studies and brazil and the broader fields of media studies democracy studies and journalism studies

this book analyses the compatibility of data retention in the uk with the european convention on human rights echr the increase in the use of modern technology has led to an explosion of generated data and with that a greater interest from law enforcement and intelligence agencies in the early 2000s data retention laws were introduced into the uk and across the european union eu this was met by domestic challenges before national courts until a seminal ruling by the court of justice in the european union cjeu ruled that indiscriminate data retention was incompatible with eu law since then however the cjeu has revised its position and made certain concessions particularly under the guise of national security this book focuses on data retention in the uk with the principal aim of examining compatibility with the echr this is explored through a variety of ways including providing an account of democracy and why secret surveillance poses a threat to it a history of data retention assessing the seriousness that data retention poses to fundamental rights the collection of rights that are affected by data retention which are crucial for a functioning democracy the implications of who can be obligated to retain and what to retain the idea that data retention is a form of surveillance and ultimately with all things considered whether this is compatible with the echr the work will be an

in screening the fleet prof jonathan rayner explores the representation of the modern royal navy on british television over a fifty year period from 1973 to 2023 contextualising his subject with significant aspects of earlier naval representation in recruiting documentary and public information films from the 1940s to the 1960s rayner then brings his focus forward to 1973 2023 the 1970s were a significant decade for naval representation on television and saw the broadcast of two definitive series the bbc s drama series warship and the acclaimed documentary series sailor these landmark series set the benchmark for naval representation in both realist and in fictional portrayals they also set precedents for audience perceptions and these have affected the production and the reception of the series on the royal navy that have followed rayner s work investigates how advances in technology allow programme makers to use new techniques in the spheres of naval drama and documentary more recent series also need to balance the required conventions for any portrayal of the navy on television with the revelatory or iconoclastic approaches now expected by modern audiences in focussing on the changing portrayal of the royal navy on television however rayner also surfaces how the navy itself has evolved in the post world war ii world the series analysed in screening the fleet also evidence the changing nature and increasing diversity of the naval community as a reflection of changing notions of britishness offering the first study of its type this volume highlights evolving and emerging trends in factual and fact based television programmes through their portrayal of a highly popular patriotic and persistent subject over a fifty year period it debates developments in television and documentary approaches using the representation of the royal navy and its changing position in perceptions of british identity

a story of big tech censorship and bias and the fight to save our country the madness of google s attempt to mold our reality into a version dictated by their corporate values has never been portrayed better than in this chilling account by google whistleblower zach vorhies as a senior engineer at zach watched in horror from the inside as the 2016 election of donald trump drove google into a frenzy of censorship and political manipulation the american ideal of an honest hard fought battle of ideas when the contest is over shaking hands and working together to solve problems was replaced by a different darker ethic alien to this country s history as wave after of censorship destroyed free speech and entire market sectors working with new york times bestselling author kent heckenlively plague of corruption vorhies and heckenlively weave a tale of a tech industry once beloved by its central figure for its innovation and original thinking turned into a terrifying woke church of censorship and political intolerance for zach an intuitive counter thinker brought up on the dystopian futures of george orwell aldous huxley and ray bradbury it was clear that google was attempting nothing less than a seamless rewriting of the operating code of reality in which many would not be allowed to participate using google s own internal search engine zach discovered their real ai censorship system called machine learning fairness which he claims is a merging of critical race theory and ai that was secretly released on their users of search news and youtube he collected and released 950 pages of these documents to the department of justice and to the public in the summer of 2019 through project veritas with james o keefe which quickly became their most popular whistleblower story which started a trend of big whistleblowing from google re writing their news algorithms to target trump to using human tragedy emergencies to inject permanent blacklists zach and kent provide a you are there perspective on how google turned to the dark side to seize power they finish by laying out a solution to fight censorship read this book if you care to know how google tries to manipulate censor and downrank the voice of its users

this book provides a definitive overview of the relationships of influence between civil society and intelligence elites the secrecy surrounding intelligence means that publication

of intelligence is highly restricted barring occasional whistle blowing and sanitised official leaks these characteristics mean that intelligence if publicised can be highly manipulated by intelligence elites while civil society's ability to assess and verify claims is compromised by absence of independent evidence there are few studies on the relationship between civil society and intelligence elites which makes it hard to form robust assessments or practical recommendations regarding public oversight of intelligence elites addressing that lacuna this book analyses two case studies of global political significance the intelligence practices they focus on contemporary mass surveillance and bush era torture intelligence policies have been presented as vital in fighting the global war on terror enmeshing governments of scores of nation states while challenging internationally established human rights to privacy and to freedom from torture and enforced disappearance the book aims to synthesise what is known on relationships of influence between civil society and intelligence elites it moves away from disciplinary silos to make original recommendations for how a variety of academic disciplines most likely to study the relationship between civil society and intelligence elites international relations history journalism and media could productively cross fertilise finally it aims to create a practical benchmark to enable civil society to better hold intelligence elites publicly accountable this book will be of great interest to students of intelligence studies surveillance media journalism civil society democracy and ir in general
