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all people all times rethinking biblical authority in churches of christ explores the assumptions traditionally held in a cappella churches of christ regarding how one knows what in scripture is binding on all people at all times the development of the tripartite model for determining bible authority i e command example and implication is examined and critiqued while many in churches of christ advocate abandoning the model altogether others refuse to see its limitations in a postmodern culture all people all times offers a hermeneutical approach the transformational restoration hermeneutic or trh that sharpens the tripartite method by providing a biblically based grid to more accurately discern scripture s emphases as well it introduces a sorely needed means for the formational use of scripture in short the trh recognizes not only the need to take scripture seriously when it speaks authoritatively regarding external or doctrinal necessities but also when it speaks to the spiritual moral and relational priorities stressed in our postmodern era it is hoped the trh can provide a hermeneutical bridge between the widening streams of a fellowship historically devoted to speaking where the bible speaks for the last 18 of his 32 years in preaching jeffery s stevenson has served as the preaching minister for the church of christ at louisville ohio and the director of second wind christian counseling ministries jeff holds degrees from freed hardeman university bible the university of akron marriage and family therapy and a doctorate from ashland ohio theological seminary jeff has written on topics such as hermeneutics and biblical application in the restoration movement evangelism and christian counseling he has published articles in the gospel advocate christian standard and restoration quarterly jeff and his wife tonnie have three grown daughters micah meghann and mallory jeff s likes reading walking cycling and model railroading

more than any other book the bible offers an amazing collection of fascinating characters ranging from the holiest of the holy to some of the most depraved scoundrels imaginable many are mentioned only in passing yet history and archaeology can often fill in the blanks and flesh them out as exciting human beings for this reason we have in many cases been able to tell much more about them than the bible alone reveals richard r losch from the preface a comprehensive gathering of persons found in the bible including the apocrypha all the people in the bible really delivers on its title literally all of the bible s characters appear in this fascinating reference work from the first article on aaron to the final entry on zophar richard losch details each person in a lively narrative style the bulk of the book consists of losch s a z articles covering the familiar and the not so familiar figures in scripture names of people who are found only in genealogies or who had no significant effect on history are included solely in the alphabetical listing starting on page 452 that listing all the people in the bible and apocrypha includes pronunciations brief identifications and biblical references persons covered in greater detail in the main part of the book are identified in bold print losch s intriguing look at all the people in the bible is anything but a dry reference work this is a book to dip into and enjoy over and over

the end of apartheid in 1994 signaled a moment of freedom and a promise of a nonracial future with this promise came an injunction define yourself as you truly are as an individual and as a community almost two decades later it is clear that it was less the prospect of that future than the habits and horizons of anxious life in racially defined enclaves that determined postapartheid freedom in this book Thomas Blom Hansen offers an in depth analysis of the uncertainties dreams and anxieties that have accompanied postapartheid freedoms in Chatsworth a formerly Indian township in Durban exploring five decades of township life Hansen tells the stories of ordinary Indians whose lives were racialized and framed by the township and how these residents domesticated and inhabited this urban space and its institutions during apartheid and after Hansen demonstrates the complex and ambivalent nature of ordinary township life while the ideology of apartheid was widely rejected its practical institutions from urban planning to houses schools and religious spaces were embraced in order to remake the community Hansen describes how the racial segmentation of South African society still informs daily life notions of race personhood morality and religious ethics he also demonstrates the force of global religious imaginings that promise a universal and inclusive community amid uncertain lives and futures in the postapartheid nation state

Para was barely five years old when civil war erupted in Sri Lanka nearly three decades later it ended in appalling horror and bloodshed tens of thousands of innocent civilians died survival required courage ingenuity and the kindness of strangers this is Para's story of survival against all odds in May 2009 Sri Lanka's long and dreadful civil war was finally brought to an horrific end ruthlessly driven to a small strip of land on the tip of the island's north east coast tens of thousands of innocent civilians died smashed by artillery killed by snipers denied medical treatment and starved to death beneath the baking sun this ferocious battle consolidated and highlighted the terrors of the preceding twenty six years of war characterised by vicious murders and desperate acts from both sides where civilians were bombarded kidnapped raped and tortured with impunity in such a vicious war was there any room for humanity Para Pabeer's story could be one of tens of thousands except that he lived to tell the world of the horrors but more importantly to record and pay tribute to those courageous people without whom he would probably not be alive I know that I would not have survived without help from many people many put themselves in danger and at least one person died for me it's time for me to remember them and to thank them all the good people who helped me through those terrifying times when life was hard and survival often only a matter of chance while in Christmas Island detention centre Para became penfriends with Alison Corke a member of the Apollo Bay branch of Rural Australians for Refugees in Victoria on his release from detention in 2011 Para moved in with the Corke family from our first letters exchanged while Para was in detention and trying to improve his English I knew he was an exceptional young man with an astonishing tale to tell I am proud to be helping him share his story and to find and thank those people who helped him survive often against massive odds time and again Para and I agreed that it is the little things that matter most those small often unremembered acts of kindness that can change someone's world we all have the power to do something only we can choose whether to use that power for the good

the village of Middlewapping a small and ancient rural backwater of southern England forms a stage upon or within which the characters in

this tale live out their various lives each has come to the village via a very different road for some such as sally who works in a bank in the town to own a house around the village green has fulfilled a lifetimes ambition whilst others such as rose a prostitute from one of the less salubrious parts of london arrive here quite by chance and not of their own volition and each brings to the tale the manifestation their own experience and how they now see the world they are as disparate in age as they are in background from will and emily who are on the cusp of adulthood to daphne in the twilight years of her life in their middle years are percival a former city banker and drug addict who has come to seek refuge from his former life and keith who with his lady meadow lives on a bus on the outskirts of the village and yet all are or become in their own way dependant upon one another to gain passage through the business of life and alliances are formed which would seem unlikely unless one knew the story and so from the very mundane to the very significant ordinary people attempts to chart the progress of these people their loves their ambitions and their own very individual ways of living out their lives there may be irony in the book title the reader will decide this for themselves but however this may be perceived the author has done his best to bring each character to life and to present them in their stark manifestation and in their collective manifestation of the human spirit

what was antebellum life like for the two communities of people one white and one black who lived and worked on a plantation on the eastern shore of maryland thomas marsh forman was in his early twenties when he returned from the revolutionary war to take over the proprietorship of rose hill plantation from his father the estate lay alongside the sassafras river in cecil county on maryland s eastern shore rose hill was a product of its historical moment a moment in which men like forman acted on their belief that the future prospects of the country required a continuation not only of their energy their skills and their desire to improve the lives of americans but also of the slave economy they had done so much to shape a focused study of this one plantation the people of rose hill illuminates the workings of the entire plantation system in the border region between the end of the revolution and the approach of the civil war lucy maddox looks closely at the public and private lives of the people of rose hill who labored together in a profitable agricultural enterprise while maintaining relationships with one another that were cautious distant sometimes secretive and often explosive making extensive use of the letters of wife martha ogle forman maddox places the experiences of rose hill s inhabitants enslaved and free within the context of the cultural economic and political history of the state piecing together the scattered information in these documents she offers readers fascinating insights into life and labor on the plantation from grueling daily work schedules to menus for elaborate dinners and teas her account includes comparative analyses of family structures and social practices within the forman family and in the community of enslaved workers individual sections profile thirty eight of the fifty enslaved people at rose hill identifying as far as possible that person s primary work responsibilities family connections and history at the plantation thus giving each a recognized place in the larger history of plantation slavery in the upper south maddox s discussion of rose hill extends to the places around it where the slave culture of the plantation found confirmation and support churches law courts social gatherings agricultural fairs and societies the parlors and sitting rooms of the eastern shore elite the people of rose hill is a fascinating look at the intersection of the constricted world of the plantation with the larger world of early america
