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in the final years of the weimar republic benjamin emerged as the most original public intellectual in the german speaking world here benjamin is represented by two of his greatest literary essays surrealism and on the image of proust as well as by an article on goethe and a selection of his wide ranging commentary for german newspapers

comprising more than 65 pieces journal articles reviews extended essays sketches aphorisms and fragments this volume shows the range of walter benjamin s writing his topics here include poetry fiction drama history religion love violence morality and

the selected works of andrew lang volume 1 anthropology fairy tale folklore the origins of religion psychical research edited by andrew teverson alexandra warwick and leigh wilson this is the first critical edition of the works of andrew lang 1844 1912 the scottish writer whose enormous output spanned the whole range of late nineteenth century intellectual culture neglected since his death partly because of the diversity of his interests and the volume of his writing his cultural centrality and the interdisciplinary nature of his work make him a vital figure for contemporary scholars this volume covers lang's wide and influential engagement with the central areas of late nineteenth century anthropology lang made decisive interventions in debates around the meaning of folk tales and the origins of religion as well as being an important figure in the investigation of spiritualist claims through psychical research the work reproduced here includes journalism essays extracts from books and previously unpublished letters which together articulate and challenge some of the central ideas and discussions of the period including evolution the relation between modern and non modern cultures the nature of scientific claims to truth and the consequences of materialism the volume will provide new and illuminating ways of understanding and assessing the period for scholars across a range of disciplines including those interested in the histories of the fairy story of science of the occult of colonialism and of anthropology key features unpublished archival material critical introductions to the major areas of his work full explanatory notes andrew teverson is professor of english literature and associate dean for the faculty of arts and social sciences at kingston university london his research centres on the use and meaning of fairy tales and he has published both on the employment of them in contemporary writing and on the historical development of the form he is the author of *fairy tale* routledge 2013 alexandra warwick is professor of english studies and head of the department of english linguistics and cultural studies at the university of westminster her research is on victorian culture in particular the fin de siècle leigh wilson is reader in modern literature in the department of english linguistics and cultural studies at the university of westminster her research focuses on modernism on the place of supernatural and occult beliefs and practices in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries and on the contemporary british novel she is the author of *modernism and magic experiments with spiritualism theosophy and the occult* eup 2013

collected writings by joseph j goodman a book found a life revealed a legacy

preserved enlightening and touching long lost book takes readers on an amazing emotional and historical journey in 2008 Leah Hammer found her grandfathers book collected writings at the Yiddish Book Center in Amherst Massachusetts. *Gezamelte Shriften* published entirely in Yiddish in 1919 has now been translated into English and presented in this bilingual edition. Collected writings turned out to be a remarkable collection of poetry, essays and stories not only about the author Joseph J. Goodman but also about the Canadian Jewish immigrant experience. The editor of collected writings, Harriet Goodman Hoffman, also a granddaughter of Joseph Goodman, is a professional genealogist realizing a treasure had been discovered that would give his descendants an incredible opportunity to know their ancestor. She has researched and written an extensive chronology about Goodman's life, a biography of his Russian years, information about people and places mentioned in the text, the growth of the Canadian Jewish community and the Yiddish language. Hoffman's work is a model of how to prepare and publish literary works discovered during genealogical research. Bilingual edition translated for the first time into English from the original Yiddish. For more than a thousand years Yiddish was the language of Ashkenazi Jews. Unlike most languages spoken in particular areas, Yiddish at the height of its usage was spoken by millions of Jews of different nationalities. This side-by-side Yiddish-English format of collected writings maintains the authors' intention to preserve the Yiddish language. This presentation allows the authors' work to be shown as it appeared in the original 1919 publication. Harriet Goodman Hoffman, Joseph Goodman's granddaughter, is a professional genealogist. She has appended an extensive chronology of Joseph's life, biographical information about his Russian and young adult years, sections about some of the people and places mentioned in the book, and a brief discussion about the Yiddish language. Hannah Berliner Fischthal, PhD, is an adjunct professor of English at St. John's University, New York. In addition to having published widely about Yiddish and Jewish literature, she serves as a Yiddish translator for JewishGen.org and is co-book review editor of *Studies in American Jewish Literature*. *Sajl Dr. H. B. Fischthal* has provided a comprehensive translators' introduction for the text. Collected writings by J. J. Goodman is a remarkable text. The author probably valued his poetry the most, yet I believe that it is as a Jewish settler in Canada, as an intellectual and a writer, as a reporter of the provinces in the early twentieth century that he reaches his greatest heights. For over three decades, Michael Nyman's music has succeeded in reaching beyond the small community of contemporary music aficionados to a much wider range of listeners. An important element in unlocking the key to Nyman's success lies in his writings about music, which preoccupied him for over a decade from the late 1960s to

the early 1980s during this time nyman produced over 100 articles covering almost every conceivable musical style and genre from the early music revival and the west s interest in world music or from john cage and minimalism to rock and pop nyman initiated a number of landmark moments in the course of late twentieth century music along the way he was one of the first to critique the distinction between the european avant garde and the american experimental movement he was the first to coin the term minimalism in relation to the music of then largely unknown steve reich and terry riley and later philip glass the first to seriously engage with the music of the english experimental tradition and the importance of cornelius cardew and to identify the importance of art colleges in nurturing and developing a radical alternative to modernism and one of the first writers to grasp the significance of post minimalists such as brian eno and harold budd and to realize how these elements could be brought together into a new aesthetic vision for his own creative endeavours which was formulated during the late 1970s and early 80s much of what transformed and defined nyman s musical character may be found within the pages of this volume of his writings comprehensively edited and annotated for the first time and including previously unpublished material from nyman s second interview with steve reich in 1976 there is also much here to engage the minds of those who are interested in pre twentieth century music from early and baroque music handel and purcell in particular to innovative features in haydn spatial elements in berlioz or bruckner and mahler s symphonic works

riveting and eloquent the collected writings of a key figure and one of the first female leaders of the eighteenth century evangelical movement sarah osborn 1714 1796 was one of the most charismatic female religious leaders of her time and one of relatively few colonial women whose writings have been preserved this volume reprints selections from osborn s fascinating manuscripts including her memoir letters and diaries an evangelical christian who led popular revival meetings at her own home osborn was also a gifted writer who recorded the story of her life in thousands of pages of manuscripts osborn chronicled her personal struggles alongside the great events of her age including the great awakening the french and indian war the moral crisis posed by slavery and the american revolution a rare opportunity to hear an early american woman speak about her faith and her religious leadership this masterfully edited work is also an invaluable resource for understanding the rise of evangelical christianity

in this series of short stories and poems freda bernstein langbert looks into new worlds a virtuoso of the macabre she hits literary notes that are elicited and unexplored often with shocking emotions and insights her short story precious plant describes a futuristic world that is an extension of our own her poems are dark and unforgettable

this collection of mostly previously unpublished works awakens the reader to new states of consciousness and color

god's word has always had enemies but in recent years the inspiration and authority of scripture have been attacked with renewed vigor respected scholar d a carson has written widely on the nature of scripture over the past thirty years and here presents a timely collection of his work in two parts in part 1 carson selects essays written on such themes as how to interpret the bible recent developments in the doctrine of scripture unity and diversity in the new testament and redaction criticism presenting a theologically balanced and confessional perspective carson defines the terms of a number of debates critiques interpretive methods and theories and suggests positive guidelines for future action part 2 presents critical reviews of nine books dealing with the inspiration and authority of scripture though substantial in content carson's detailed reviews will foster careful thought and perspective in those who are relatively new to the debates surrounding biblical inspiration and authority this volume is a diverse collection that will prove to be a helpful resource to both seasoned pastors and scholars and those who are just starting serious study of the bible

the practice of jungian psychoanalysis is the fourth volume in the collected writings of murray stein it includes works by the author with special relevance to analytic practice among them are the ghost ranch papers from 1983 1992 essays on transference and types of countertransference the problem of sleepiness in analysis sibling rivalry and envy the aims of analysis the faith of the analyst and reflections on spirituality in analysis

from his arrival in britain in the 1950s and involvement in the new left to founding the field of cultural studies and examining race and identity in the 1990s and early 2000s stuart hall has been central to shaping many of the cultural and political debates of our time essential essays a landmark two volume set brings together stuart hall's most influential and foundational works spanning the whole of his career these volumes reflect the breadth and depth of his intellectual and political projects while demonstrating their continued vitality and importance volume 1 foundations of cultural studies focuses on the first half of hall's career when he wrestled with questions of culture class representation and politics this volume's stand out essays include his field defining cultural studies and its theoretical legacies the prescient the great moving right show which first identified the emergent mode of authoritarian populism in british politics and encoding and decoding in the television discourse one of his

most influential pieces of media criticism as a whole volume 1 provides a panoramic view of hall's fundamental contributions to cultural studies

text this is the first time the writings of flora belle jan the chinese american flapper and writer are assembled into a single volume the book consists of some one hundred pieces of prose and poetry available from microfilm of newspapers and magazines that ceased publication prior to 1950 a native of fresno california flora belle jan was born in 1906 she lived above yet far low a restaurant owned by her parents at 1007 china alley her world at home was chinese her world at school with teachers and classmates was american many of her classmates were also children of immigrant parents her own parents jan chong and jan yom had separately emigrated from southern china in the late 1800s her classmates parents included immigrants from ireland italy russia england mexico and armenia in her early years the country of origin of the parents did not hinder the formation of close friendships among girls with shared interests and activities flora jan and her friends enjoyed writing poems and stories and aspired to careers in literature and journalism she received encouragement from grace may north editor of the sunnyside club column in the fresno herald jans earliest works appeared in this column her topics were typically american involving for example a selfish prince a faithful dog a poor newsgirl and poems about patriotism in only two stories the chinese girls valentine and the contest did she introduce a chinese connection another important person in flora jans life was amy purcell superintendent of the baptist chinese mission in fresno she recognized floras talents with miss purcells help the chinese students club of fresno published the trailmaker flora jan the only female member of the club played a major role in the publication flora jans parents did not support her desire to further her education she worked at various jobs and at age 18 earned money for college by writing feature stories for the san francisco examiner for several of these stories jan invented the female character ming toy among eight children in her family flora jan was the only one to earn a college degree and to pursue a career in journalism although flora jan attended the university of california berkeley for only one semester in the autumn of 1925 she left a strong impression on those who knew her her reputation as a prolific young writer as well as her beauty and flamboyant flapper life style was remembered forty years later your mother was the belle of berkeley was the remark said to my sister fiore wang who attended the university of california berkeley and there from graduated flora jan transferred to the university of chicago where she studied english literature and graduated with honors in 1927 the impetus for her transfer to chicago was due to professor robert e park he directed the survey of race relations project and believed that jan would succeed in assimilation into main stream white society an analysis of parks project and jans participation may be found in the treatise thinking

orientals by henry yu most of jans writings during her years in chicago appeared in the chinese students monthly a magazine founded in 1904 and published by the chinese students alliance in the united states of america in her fictional works romance on the roof and transplanted flower blossoms flora jan created humorous and delicate inter racial romances she served in the capacity of a contributing editor at first and later became an associate editor of the monthly she also sold stories to the chicago daily news and to the magazine real detective tales in 1932 flora jan and her husband charles wang left chicago to go to china probably the most compelling reason for their move was financial although charles had earned a ph d degree in psychology at the university of chicago he could not obtain
