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intended for the beginner this book examines some of the ways linguists can express what native speakers know about the sound system of their language

intended for the absolute beginner introducing phonetics and phonology requires no previous background in linguistics phonetics or phonology starting with a grounding in phonetics and phonological theory the book provides a base from which more advanced treatments may be approached it begins with an examination of the foundations of articulatory and acoustic phonetics moves on to the basic principles of phonology and ends with an outline of some further issues within contemporary phonology varieties of english particularly received pronunciation and general american form the focus of consideration

but aspects of the phonetics and phonology of other languages are discussed as well this new edition includes revised exercises and examples additional coverage of typology autosegmental phonology and articulatory and acoustic phonetics broader coverage of varieties that now features Australian English and an extended chapter 7 that includes more information on the relationship between phonetics and phonology introducing phonetics and phonology 4th edition remains the essential introduction for any students studying this topic for the first time

this book is an investigation of the basic concepts of phonological theory in particular it is concerned with the concepts of sameness and difference each a sine qua non of classification it is assumed that all academic disciplines operate with these two basic concepts when classification is involved since phonology is the area of linguistics that deals with the interface between the abstract system of native speaker knowledge and physical entities in the world the linguistic classification of those physical entities needs to be guided by clear and rigorously applied criteria for deciding what constitutes the same sound and what not during the development of modern linguistics over the past hundred years or so it has generally been assumed that the criteria for classification are to be found in a segmented version of the phonetic continuum of spoken language this is still largely the case today even though the system of native speaker knowledge of language is seen as a highly abstract mental representation of that knowledge this book questions the basis of such assumptions in particular segmentation abstractness monosystemicity and

this book is designed to provide students of phonology with an accessible introduction to the phonological architecture of words it offers a thorough discussion of the basic building blocks of phonology in particular features sounds syllables and feet and deals with a range of different theories about these units colin ewen and harry van der hulst present their study within a non linear framework discussing the contributions of autosegmental phonology dependency phonology government phonology and metrical phonology among others their coherent integrated approach reveals that the differences between these models are not as great as is sometimes believed the book provides a more detailed analysis of this subject than previously available in introductory textbooks and is an invaluable and indispensable first step towards understanding the major theoretical issues in modern phonology at the word level

this book reviews the history of the interface between morpho syntax and phonology roughly since world war ii structuralist and generative interface thinking is presented chronologically but also theory by theory from the point of view of a historically interested observer who however in the last third of the book distills lessons in order to assess present day interface theories and to establish a catalogue of properties that a correct interface theory should or must not have the book also introduces modularity the rationalist theory of the human cognitive system that underlies the generative approach to language from a cognitive science perspective modularity is used as a referee for interface theories in the book finally the book locates the interface debate in the landscape of current minimalist syntax and phase theory and fosters intermodular argumentation how can we use properties of morpho syntactic theory in order to argue for or against competing theories of phonology and vice versa

this volume is the first to provide an up to date and comprehensive history of phonology

from the earliest known examples of phonological thinking through the rise of phonology as a field in the twentieth century and up to the most recent advances the volume is divided into five parts part i offers an account of writing systems along with chapters exploring the great ancient and medieval intellectual traditions of phonological thought that form the foundation of later thinking and continue to enrich phonological theory chapters in part ii describe the important schools and individuals of the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries who shaped phonology as an organized scientific field part iii examines mid twentieth century developments in phonology in the soviet union northern and western europe and north america it continues with precursors to generative grammar and culminates in a chapter on chomsky and halle s the sound pattern of english spe part iv then shows how phonological theorists responded to spe with respect to derivations representations and phonology morphology interaction theories discussed include dependency phonology government phonology constraint and repair theories and optimality theory the part ends with a chapter on the study of variation finally chapters in part v look at new methods and approaches covering phonetic explanation corpora and phonological analysis probabilistic phonology computational modelling models of phonological learning and the evolution of phonology this in depth exploration of the history of phonology provides new perspectives on where phonology has been and sheds light on where it could go next

traditionally investigations into speech and pronunciation have relied on the unaided skills of the phonetician in recognising and reproducing speech sounds but many practitioners are now using instruments to gain a greater understanding of speech and to be able to analyse speech patterns in situations when speaking and hearing would otherwise be inaccessible without the use of these instruments this new book looks at how this form of investigation has developed and considers the types of data that can be used and which questions can be solved using experimental phonetics

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
