a history of rangers goalies through the ages new york rangers fans have always loved their goaltenders and throughout their history the blueshirts have been blessed with some of the very best in the game through the first nine plus decades of their existence eighty eight men from canada the united states and europe have toiled between the pipes at madison square garden they all shared the same responsibility yet each brought their own style personality character and idiosyncrasies to the position and provided unique memories for those of us who watched them in guardians of the goal each one of these brave men is discussed in chronological order while providing an overview of their era and the general managers and coaches they played for such players highlighted in this book include mike richter ed giacomini john vanbiesbrouck henrik lundqvist davey kerr and many more regardless of whether they were a franchise goalie a flash in the pan or an emergency fill in each of these lone rangers or as steve baker once called them the few the proud and the very busy have one thing in common they all tried their best to keep that little one inch by three inch piece of frozen vulcanized rubber out of the gaping twenty four square foot chasm behind them some were more successful than others but as you will see although they may occasionally steal a game in most cases a goaltender is only as good as the team in front of him guardians of the goal is just that an ode to those blueshirts who laid it out night in and night out leaving it all out on the ice for our rangers

in the world library of psychologists series international experts present career long collections of what they judge to be their finest pieces extracts from books key articles salient research findings and their major practical theoretical contributions in this volume overweight and obesity rates have increased dramatically in most industrialized countries even though more and more people are chronically dieting dieters can manage to lose substantial amounts of weight while actively dieting but most regain it within a few years so why do most chronic dieters have such difficulty controlling their weight and why is there only a small minority of successful dieters to address these questions stroebe developed the goal conflict model of eating behavior a social cognitive theory that attributes the difficulty of chronic dieters to a conflict between two incompatible goals eating enjoyment and weight control although chronic dieters are motivated to pursue their weight control goal most fail in food rich environments surrounded by palatable food cues that activate thoughts of eating enjoyment incompatible weight control thoughts are inhibited and weight control intentions are forgotten for successful dieters probably due to past success in exerting self control tasty high calorie food has become associated with weight control thoughts for them exposure to palatable food makes weight control thoughts more accessible enabling them to control their body weight in food rich environments this book contains the key articles of a research program by stroebe and collaborators to assess the validity of this theory they succeeded in tracing the processes that lead from temptation to a breakdown of dieting intentions they also demonstrated that these theoretical principles can be used to develop effective weight loss interventions the book should be of value for all researchers students and clinicians involved in obesity research and treatment

knowledge based approaches to planning and control offer benefits over classical techniques in applications that involve large yet structured state spaces however knowledge bases are time consuming and costly to construct in this dissertation i introduce a framework for analytical learning that enables the agent to acquire generalizable domain specific procedural knowledge in the form of goal indexed hierarchical task networks by observing a small number of successful demonstrations of goal driven tasks i discuss how in contrast with most algorithms for learning by observation my approach can learn from unannotated input demonstrations by automatically inferring the purpose of each solution step using the background knowledge about the domain i discuss the role of hierarchical structure distributed applicability conditions and goals in the generalizability of the acquired knowledge i also introduce an approach for adaptively determining the structure of the acquired knowledge that strikes a balance between generality and operability and for making the algorithm robust to changes in the structure of background knowledge this involves resolving interdependencies among goals using temporal information i present experimental studies on a number of domains which demonstrate that the quality of acquired knowledge is comparable to handcrafted content in terms of both

coverage and complexity in closing i review related work and directions for future research
