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this collection of essays is devoted to the diversity of the conceptual and terminological definitions of the notion of the absolute absolute comprises both the concepts of the western world related to god and the verbal constructions flowing from these ideas in the spheres of law philosophy linguistics politics medicine literature and arts over time absolute and its neologisms have undergone various modifications assuming the associated characteristics of syntactic ambiguity and inflation absolute can imply an increase in the degree of a quality attached to some object or phenomenon and can be used as either an adverbial modifier or a proper noun in its appearances as a procedural term absolute mostly conveys a negative connotation when evaluating some action the question posed in this book is not what absolute is but what possibilities exist with regard to perceiving and conceptualizing it in human terms both historically and in the present

architectures of existence proposes that philosophical thinking ecosophical thinking can inform the way we engage with our world and its inhabitants as architects designers and planners but also as individuals as people and as a society in art et existence maldiney states for us to inhabit is to exist this book aims to unfold extend articulate and thicken this postulate by interweaving architecture city landscape literature and philosophy it takes up the synergistic lines of long term research carried out from an ecosophical perspective such an attitude explores an art of existing in multiplicity singularity and openness manifesting the critical dimension through a reinterpretation of the knotting of the trajectories of time humanity and its becoming insisting on what is between things and beings as well as on what is happening regenerating recycling reviving saving diversifying sparing recreating meditating and so caring these are all eco rhythms of a different type between human and non human to consider ourselves in the world in an era of uncertainty and climate threats this book develops the margins of possibility offered by the subject of architecture this book will be of interest to researchers and students of architecture urban planning and philosophy

each bibliography lists and annotates the most important works published during the year they are arranged by topic and indexed by author subject and geographic location

this book aims to contribute to the overall integrated understanding of the processes of language contact and their evolution be they the result of political or economic dis integrations or migrations or for technological reasons via an interdisciplinary holistic approach it also aims to support the theoretical grounding of a unified common sociolinguistic paradigm based on an ecological and complexity perspective this approach built on the fact that linguistic structures do not live in isolation from their social functions and must be situated in relation to the sub and supra systems that determine their existence if we are to understand their fortunes it is a useful contribution to understanding and promoting the processes of linguistic revitalization in the world combining at the same time the maintenance and development of diversity while ensuring the intercommunication of human species

william paulson believes that as contemporary science extends its influence over areas of thought that have long been the province of the humanities scholars in literary disciplines may suffer for their lack of contact with work in the sciences of mind and information in the noise of culture he speculates on the role of literature in the post literary culture of the information age and proposes a vital reorientation of the study of literature both affirming its specificity and exploring its developing relationship with modern science paulson discusses literature in the context of information theory particularly the theory of self organizing and autonomous systems reviewing and building upon the work of such thinkers as michel serres henri atlan francisco varela and judith schlanger paulson offers a new kind of conceptual vocabulary for literary theory he concludes that literature functions as the noise of culture a source of variety in the circulation and production of ideas and a rich and indeterminate margin through which messages are sent and transformed

this volume is a collection of papers presented during methodological workshops organized by codesria its objective is to revitalize theory and methodology in field work in africa while contributing to the creation of a critical space hinged upon the mastery of epistemological bases which are indispensable to any scientific imagination

complex system studies are a growing area of central importance to a wide range of disciplines ranging from physics to politics and beyond adopting this interdisciplinary approach systems self organisation and information presents and discusses a range of ground breaking research in complex systems theory building upon foundational concepts the volume introduces a theory of self organization providing definitions of concepts including system structure organization functionality and boundary biophysical and cognitive approaches to self organization are also covered discussing the complex dynamics of living beings and the brain and self organized adaptation and learning in computational systems the convergence of peircean philosophy with the study of self organization also provides an original pathway of research which contributes to a dialogue between pragmatism semeiotics complexity theory and self organizing systems as one of the few interdisciplinary works on systems theory relating self organization and information theory systems self organisation and information is an invaluable resource for researchers and postgraduate students interested in complex systems theory from related disciplines including philosophy physics and engineering

this edited volume proposes key contributions addressing the connections between two important themes dialogue and representation these connections were approached or interpreted in three possible ways 1 dialogue as representation 2 normative perspectives on dialogue representation issues and 3 representations of dialogue the first interpretation dialogue as representation consists of exploring dialogue as an activity where many things beings or voices can be made present whether we think in terms of ideologies cultures situations collectives roles etc the second interpretation normative perspectives on dialogue representation issues leads scholars to explore questions of normativity which are often associated with the notion of dialogue when conceived as a morally stronger form of conversation finally the third interpretation representations of dialogue invites us to address methodological questions related to the representation of this type of conversation echoing bakhtin contributors were invited to explore the polyphonic heteroglot or dialogic character of any text discourse or interaction

the future of the human posture is in the spotlight the 200 year old locomotion paradigm can no longer resist the advancement of knowledge yet 2 500 years of thinking on the place of verticalized human anatomy and its reflexive consciousness in the natural history of life and the earth is more relevant than ever this book retraces these reflections from pre socratic philosophers focusing on the link between verticality and the most complex and consciously reflexive nervous system on the top rung of the ladder of living beings the origin of animated forms or animals was considered metaphysical until the 19th century but reflection on their inception from fertilization paved the way for mathematics of infinitesimal geometry and dynamics the simian filiation was inconceivable until jean baptiste de lamarck bridged the gap in 1802 with the locomotion postulate to explain the transition from quadrupedal to bipedal posture sustained by the hypothesis of inheritance of acquired characteristics this doctrine was overturned in 1987 by the discovery of the embryonic origins of the straightening specific dynamics linked to neurogenesis confirming the natural place of human verticality and nervous system complexity with its psychomotor and cognitive consequences sapiens find themselves at the physical limit of the straightening while mechanisms of gametogenesis have never ceased in making neurogenesis exponentially more complex is the future exclusively terrestrial or does intrauterine hominization open up new perspectives for space exploration posturologists oclusodontics osteopaths cognisciences all anthropological sciences exposed to human verticality are concerned with this discovery which allows sapiens to face their natural destiny

historians from around the world explore new trends movements conceptualizations in history as a discipline profession this volume offers innovative approaches to historians attempting to redefine their discipline relative to the global society of the 21st century

this book has its origins in a special issue of the journal science education volume 18 numbers 6 7 2009 the essay by costas skordoulis science and worldviews in the marxist tradition did not appear in that special issue due to a mistake in production scheduling it was published in an earlier issue of the journal volume 17 number 6 2008 but has been included in this book version of the special issue as explained in the introduction the catalyst for the journal special issue was the essay on science worldviews and education submitted to the journal by hugh g gauch jr this was circulated to the other contributors who were asked to write their own contribution in the light of the arguments and literature contained in the paper hugh made brief responses and clarifications after the papers were written however the tanis edis article on islam and my own article on priestley were processed too late to benefit from hugh s appraisal the journal is associated with the international history philosophy and science teaching group which was formed in 1987 the group stages biennial international conferences and occasional regional conferences details can be found at ihpst.org the group though the journal conferences and its electronic newsletter at ihpst

systems such as climate society economies and cities the book is specifically concerned with cities the aim of the authors is to promote a new operative approach to the study of urban systems through an integrated systemic view of their components and relations with the outside evolutionary science opens new development prospects for cities in the framework of sustainability book jacket

ecopolitics is a study of environmental awareness or non awareness in contemporary french theory arguing that it is now impossible not to think in an ecological way verena andermatt conley traces the roots of today s concern for the environment back to the intellectual climate of the late 50s and 60s the author considers key texts by influential figures such as michael serres paul virilio gilles deleuze and felix guattari michel de certeau h   ne cixous and luce irigaray ecopolitics rehabilitates some ecological components of french intellectual thought of the past thirty years and reassesses french poststructural thinkers who explicitly deal with ecology in their work

architectural projects which expose the hidden contradictions of our everyday reality in a lively yet challenging way franois roche born in 1961 in paris and his partner stephanie lavaux born in 1966 on the reunion island are radical advocates of an architecture which is to be perceived as a tool for increasing critical awareness as a discipline which provokes thought and inspires the imagination their buildings and projects which include the new art museum in bangkok and the glacier museum in switzerland both of which would have been unthinkable without the latest it methods of design strive towards designs which are unique and unmistakeable in both function and appearance franois roche is guest professor at the london bartlett school and the technical university of vienna and has made a name for himself internationally as a pioneer of a new architecture through his lecture activities and his participation in many exhibitions this monograph is the first complete overview of his work and will be published to coincide with the exhibition no standard architecture which opens in november at the centre pompidou in paris where r sie architects are one of the 12 invited architectural firms

the need to take the spiritual experience during illness into account is part of a broader trend in western societies a fascination with the practical uses of spirituality and its contribution to individual wellbeing whether through a religious or a humanist tradition this understanding of spirituality differs from traditional views embedded in religious traditions this book takes a critical point of view at the biomedical representation of the function of spirituality in care medicine reorders notions such as life death health sickness and spirituality this process is called here sapientialization i e the spiritual experience is expressed and understood under the auspices of and in terms of wisdom this view tends to identify spirituality and ethics i propose an alternate understanding of spirituality grounded on its subversive power inspired by the work of the theologian john d caputo it is critical of some problems that are associated with the sapientialization of spirituality in biomedicine such as the medicalization of spiritual experiences or the instrumentalization of spirituality it provides an understanding of spirituality that honours both the medical interest in it and its capacity to resist to instrumentalization

it has become increasingly apparent that humanity s complex social political and economic systems are incompatible with the finite capacity of the earth to replenish resources and absorb wastes if the planet is to continue to be habitable for the myriad web of other creatures that make life possible humans must transform their systems so that they are aligned with natural systems one thing is sure it will not be nature s laws the delicate interdependence that characterizes earth s ecosystems that change the change must begin within each person and from there permeate throughout our social political and economic structures the contributors to this volume believe that such transformations are urgently needed and possible and they offer specific examples they suggest solutions that call for new perspectives in our ethics beliefs traditions economy business gender relations education and technology they show that human beings have the power to implement changes in all natural and social environments the chapters in this book have been organized around three keywords reconnecting reframing and rethinking the contributors argue that we need to reconnect with the earth and nature as well as with each other and parts of ourselves that we have ignored for too long we need to reframe the way in which people prioritize choices in the economy the way we do business and pursue development and we need to rethink the mission of education and the roles of technology

this book represents a philosophical and scientific journey that will proceed according to three stages of increasing levels of complexity beginning with the atom then moving to macromolecules and finally moving to the threshold of life the first stage analyzes the transition from the qualitatively undifferentiated atom to differentiated atoms the second stage analyzes the passage from atoms to molecule and the third stage examines the passage from molecule to macromolecule

thinking about the enlightenment looks beyond the current parameters of studying the enlightenment to the issues that can be understood by reflecting on the period in a broader context each of the thirteen original chapters by an international and interdisciplinary team of contributors illustrates the problematic legacy of the enlightenment and the continued ramifications of its thinking since the eighteenth century together they consider whether modernity can see its roots in the intellectual revolution of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries the collection is divided into six sections preceded by a comprehensive introduction to the field and the most recent scholarship on the period across the sections the contributors consider modern day encounters with enlightenment thinking including kant's moral philosophy the conflict between reason and faith the significance of the enlightenment of law and the gender inequality that persisted throughout the eighteenth century by examining specific encounters with the problematic results of enlightenment concerns the contributors are able to illuminate and offer new perspectives on topics such as human nature race politics gender and rationality drawing from history philosophy literature and anthropology this book enables students and academics alike to take a fresh look at the enlightenment and its legacy in the modern world

few questions exert such a great fascination on human conscience as those related to the meaning of life history and death the belief in the resurrection of the dead constitutes an answer to a real challenge what is the meaning of life and history in the midst of a world in which evil injustice and ultimately death exist this book seeks to understand the idea of resurrection not only as a theological but also as a philosophical category as expression of the collective aspirations of humanity combining historical theological and philosophical analyses in dialogue with some of the principal streams of contemporary western thought

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
