in the first book to take d h lawrence s last poems as its starting point bethan jones adopts a broadly intertextual approach to explore key aspects of lawrence s late style the evolution and meaning of the poems are considered in relation to lawrence s prose works of this period including sketches of etruscan places lady chatterley s lover and apocalypse more broadly jones shows that lawrence s late works are products of a complex process of textual assimilation as she uncovers the importance of lawrence s reading in mythology cosmology primitivism mysticism astronomy and astrology the result is a book that highlights the richness and diversity of his poetic output also prioritizing the masterpieces of lawrence s mature style which are as accomplished as anything produced by his modernist contemporaries

this selection brings together the most beautiful and powerful of czeslaw milosz s poems spanning his writing life in verses such as café he considers the upheaval revolutions and two world wars that he had witnessed while my faithful mother tongue reflects the loyalty he felt to his native polish language he also remembers his schooldays in the world and in bypassing rue descartes recalls the paris streets of his student years displaying both tenderness and tough minded fury towards those who shaped his experiences writing not about abstract emotions but about the horrors and beauty that he directly observed milosz opens our eyes to the joy bringing potential of

the poetry to which he gave his life winner of the nobel prize for literature

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lawrence first put together the collection of his poems in 1928 they are arranged
chronologically to make up a biography of an emotional and inner life

a selection of poems by contemporary american author anne sexton drawn primarily
from eight previously published collections

emily dickinson poet of the interior life imagined words swords hurling barbed
syllables piercing nothing about her adult appearance or habitation revealed such a
militant soul only poems written quietly in a room of her own often hand stitched in
small volumes then hidden in a drawer revealed her true self she did not live in time
but in universals an acute sensitive nature reaching out boldly from self referral to a
wider imagined world dickinson died without fame only a few poems were published in
her lifetime her legacy was later rescued from her desk an astonishing body of work
much of which has since appeared in piecemeal editions sometimes with words altered
by editors or publishers according to the fashion of the day now ralph franklin the
foremost scholar of dickinson s manuscripts has prepared an authoritative one volume
edition of all extant poems by emily dickinson 1 789 poems in all the largest number
ever assembled this reading edition derives from his three volume work the poems of
emily dickinson variorum edition 1998 which contains approximately 2 500 sources for
the poems in this one volume edition franklin offers a single reading of each poem
usually the latest version of the entire poem rendered with dickinson s spelling
punctuation and capitalization intact the poems of emily dickinson reading edition is a
milestone in american literary scholarship and an indispensable addition to the
personal library of poetry lovers everywhere

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comfortably intimate classically adroit in its formal wit and invention altogether unique
yet in no way excluding this meticulously edited edition of a master poet s collected
works gives us the defining bridge from the new american poetry of the 50s to that
poetry now contemporary on both coasts and in all conditions no one ever recognized
the people with whom he lived more particularly than did ted berrigan and no one ever
brought them home to a reader with such unaggressive and persistent power this is a
great great book for all seasons of the mind and heart robert creeley ted berrigan was
a leader of the new york school his crazy energy embodied that movement and the city
itself it is wonderful to have his collected poems in print john ashbery a comprehensive
and carefully chronicled volume that puts ted berrigan in historical context as one of
the most influential poets of his generation his poems deft light definitely humorous
irreverent poignant marvelous and tough the truth doing its work the great man doing
the ordinary thing with a quick ear and a quick tongue revealing the personal in the
universal he gives you his full attention about to be born again thinking of you joanne
kyger in a life devoted to experimental art ted berrigan shaped his poetry and the
space he occupied with a bold artistry based on his playful but powerfully skeptical

view of the world he wondered what might actually be captured within the pages of a book but the collected poems allows us to again enjoy ted berrigan's delightfully demanding presence lorenzo thomas a singular balance of personal historical vision and sentiment both sweet and sour developed within the fractured verbalism of the late twentieth century found lyric creates in ted berrigan's poems the unique colors of a particularly lived and still intensely living ensemble of moments tom clark author of late returns a memoir of ted berrigan some people are just more real than others i don't know another way to say it ted berrigan is totally real and he has fashioned an important sound for all of us to listen to he put it all together just before everyone else in his time our time got going america is lucky to count him as one of its great poets peter gizzi

this selection of the works of w b yeats includes the final book from the unfairly neglected narrative poem the wanderings of oisín and a number of lyrics from yeats's work as poetic dramatist it breaks new ground by allowing the reader to engage with a dozen poems in alternative versions in many other cases it provides significant variants so that yeats's struggle to revise his poetry can be experienced with unusual immediacy

the poems of robert browning is a multi volume edition of the poetry of robert browning 1812 1889 resulting from a completely fresh appraisal of the canon text and context of his work the poems are presented in the order of their composition and in the text in which they were first published giving a unique insight into the origins and development of browning's art annotations and headnotes in keeping with the traditions of longman annotated english poets are full and informative and provide details of composition publication sources and contemporary reception volumes one 1826 1840 and two 1841 1846 presented the poems from his browning's early years while volume three 1847 61 covered the period of his marriage to elizabeth barrett and residence in italy volume four 1862 71 deals with the decade following elizabeth's death and browning's return to england these years saw the appearance of some of his most significant work and a steady rise in his critical reputation in dramatis personae 1864 browning uses his characteristic dramatic mode to expose predicaments of thought and feeling in characters ranging from shakespeare's caliban to the cheating medium mr sludge other poems dramatize browning's complicated feelings about the deceptions and self deceptions of romantic love balaustion's adventure 1871 is an engaging reworking of euripides alceste whose theme the resurrection of a beloved lost wife has poignant personal resonance for browning while prince hohenstiel schwangau published in the same year offers a thinly veiled account of the life and actions of napoleon iii the recently deposed emperor of france over whom browning and elizabeth had quarrelled in these two long poems browning can be seen engaged in the dialogue with elizabeth that was to shape much of his work during the remainder of his writing life

basil bunting's work was published haphazardly throughout most of his life and in many cases he did not oversee publication this is the first critical edition of the complete poems and offers an accurate text with variants from all printed sources don share annotates bunting's often complex and allusive verse with much illuminating quotation from his prose writings interviews and correspondence he also examines bunting's use of sources including persian literature and classical mythology and explores the northumbrian roots of bunting's poetic vocabulary and use of dialect

a constellation of essays that reanimates the work of this pivotal twentieth century american poet for a new century this volume is the first to reconsider roethke's work in terms of the expanded critical approaches to literature that have emerged since his death in 1963 editor william barillas and over forty contributors including highly respected literary scholars critics and writers such as peter balakian camille paglia jay

parini and david wojahn collectively make a case for roethke s poetry as a complete unified and evolving body of work the accessible essays employ a number of approaches including formalism ecocriticism reader response and feminist critique to explicate the poetics themes and the biographical historical cultural and literary contexts of roethke s work

through readings of elegies self elegies war poems and the blues this book covers a wide range of poets including thomas hardy wilfred owen wallace stevens langston hughes w h auden sylvia plath and seamus heaney it is grounded in genre theory and in the psychoanalysis of mourning

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
