this highly amusing and unorthodox travel book resulted from a light hearted summer journey by the young poets auden and macneice in 1936 their letters home in verse and prose are full of private jokes and irreverent comments about people politics literature and ideas letters from iceland is one of the most entertaining books in modern literature from auden s letter to lord byron and macneice s eclogue

to the mischief and fun of their joint last will and testament the book is impossible to resist a 1930s classic

volume one of these remarkable letters and diaries opens with a letter from britten aged nine to his formidable mother edith music is already at the centre of his life and it accompanies him through prep and public school and then to london to the royal college of music where the phenomenally gifted but inexperienced young composer is plunged into metropolitan life and makes influential new friends among them w h auden and christopher isherwood this was a time of prodigious musical creativity a growing awareness of his sexuality and the dawning of his political convictions most importantly during this period britten met peter pears and established the musical and personal relationship that was to last a lifetime volume one comes to a close in may 1939 when britten accompanied by pears departs for north america the letters and diaries in this illuminating first volume and its successor are supplemented by the editors detailed commentary and by exhaustive contemporary documentation together they constitute a comprehensive portrait not only of the composer but of an age

in may 1939 britten and pears disembarked at montreal at the start of their american visit which was to be a period of intense musical activity and new personal relationships at the same time the relationship between britten and pears deepened into a partnership that was to endure for almost forty years their absence from england during the first years of the war led to sharp public comment and controversy much of it documented here on their return from america in 1942 hostility to their pacifist convictions and to their homosexuality resurfaced prejudice and subterfuge even affected the première of peter grimes in 1945 although it could not prevent the opera from being an unprecedented success the letters in this second volume from the years 1939 to 1945 are among the most fascinating of the correspondence and supplemented by the editors detailed commentary and by exhaustive contemporary documentation offer a unique insight into american history politics and culture during the second world war

the first of two volumes of the eagerly anticipated first complete edition of auden s poems including some that have never been published before w h auden 1907 1973 is one of the greatest poets of the twentieth century and his reputation has only grown since his death published on the hundredth anniversary of the year in which he began to write poetry this is the first of two volumes of the first complete edition of auden s poems edited introduced and annotated by renowned auden scholar edward mendelson this definitive edition includes all the poems auden wrote for publication in their original texts and all his later revised versions as well as poems and songs he never published some of them printed here for the first time this volume traces the development of auden s early career and contains all the poems including juvenilia that he published or submitted for publication from his first printed work in 1927 at age twenty through the poems he wrote during his first months in america in 1939 when he was thirty two the book also includes poems that auden wrote during his adult career with the expectation that he might publish them but which he never did song lyrics that he wrote to be set to music by benjamin britten but which he never put into print and verses that he wrote for magazines at schools where he was teaching the main text presents the poems in their original published versions the notes include the extensive revisions that he made to his poems over the course of his career and provide explanations of obscure references the second volume of this edition poems volume 2 1940 1973 is also available

letters from home consists of a collection of original letters the people who wrote the letters were americans most of them members of an extended family they were written during world war ii from 1943 to 1945 the letters in this book contain the thoughts concerns hopes dreams worries and anxieties of americans during world war ii in their own words there are many individual stories within the letters those stories describe not only events and places but people who endured and triumphed during a very difficult and historic time

this study investigates louis macneice in two major central strands exploring macneice's ambiguous positioning as an irish poet and the self consciousness in his writing

an island is a world out of time and place separated by literal and figurative oceans where the confines of reality are tenuous and magic may be possible iceland with its relative isolation enchanting mythologies creative people and the otherworldly wild beauty of its glaciers geysers volcanos and fjords encompasses this special magic in the minds of many including writer kurt caswell vividly illustrated by julia oldham iceland summer recounts caswell's journey traversing the country by foot and bus accompanied by his lifelong friend scott the pair set out from reykjavík and travel clockwise along the ring road stopping along the way for backcountry walking trips caswell immerses himself in the natural beauty and charming eccentricities of the tiny island nation with his drinking and hiking buddy by his side and fueled by a steady diet of brennivín fermented grain mash and pylsur icelandic hot dogs he explores the hornstrandir peninsula walks to the famed dettifoss waterfall waits for a glimpse of the lake monster lagarfljótsormurinn at egilsstaðir visits the world's only penis museum and pays homage to centuries of icelandic literary tradition at the Árni magnússon institute writing in the tradition of other pairs who have traveled in iceland like w g collingwood and jón stefánsson and w h auden and louis macneice caswell meditates on the value of wild places in the modern world travel as both pastime and occupation the nature of friendship and walking food and literature scott is the sancho panza to caswell's don quixote offering a ribald humor that grounds caswell's flights into the romantic the two travel well

together and together arrive at the understanding that what anchors them both is their lifelong friendship

the handbook ranges widely and in depth across 20th century war poetry incorporating detailed discussions of some of the key poets of the period it is an essential resource for scholars of particular poets and for those interested in wider debates contributors include some of the most important international poetry critics of our time

this is the first book length study foregrounding auden s sense of place as a means for enhancing our grasp of this crucial twentieth century poet proposing that auden had a remarkable spatial sensibility this book concentrates on his treatment of his homeland england as well as the north pennines and iceland both of which served as his good places holy grounds and sources of topophilic sentiment the readings draw on the scholarship of humanistic geography tracing patterns of mental constructs which emerge from spatial experience in a scholarly but engaging way this book argues that focusing on auden s poetics of place as it emerged and evolved can be instrumental to our understanding of this influential poet not only in relation to his epoch but also to the anglophone poetic tradition precisely because of his stature these elaborations on auden s preoccupation with places escapism borders and local identity promise to enrich our understanding of the cultural and intellectual climate of the interwar period when established notions of local places and cultures were beginning to be contested by internationalisation this study will be of interest to both academics and students in the field of anglophone literary studies while also appealing to those attracted to auden s poetry interwar culture and the literary representation of space

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
