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hymns as a potential tool of theological contextualisation have never been fully explored this study looks at this function of hymnody in relation to mexican culture a sample of hymnody used by evangelicals of different traditions was selected to examine its theology and to compare which kind of hymns or songs were more reliable and appropriate to communicate the evangelical faith in the mexican context

cuban studies has been published annually by the university of pittsburgh press since 1985 founded in 1970 it is the preeminent journal for scholarly work on cuba each volume includes articles in both english and spanish a large book review section and an exhaustive compilation of recent works in the field

a case study of why third world countries are still poor the premise of this book is that while some progress has been made in transforming the political economy of ecuador certain behaviors beliefs and attitudes have kept the country from developing in ways that otherwise would have been possible as the author asserts for almost five centuries the cultural habits of ecuadorian citizens have constituted a stumbling block for individual economic success still he concludes people s cultural values are not immutable inconvenient customs can be changed or influenced by the economic success of immigrants this is the challenge that ecuador faces in the twenty first century

images and accounts of the mexican us migration process and the border region abound representations of border crossers plans for the construction of a security fence the shifting economic relationship between the us and its southern neighbors and the changing character of the rio grande area have played a pivotal role in shaping contemporary political discourse the politics economics and culture of mexican us migration which has attracted contributors from four different countries offers multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary evaluations of these developments it also considers the impact of migration in both the us and mexico some of the contributions are case studies while others have a broad survey character all place the current debate about migration and the changing nature of the north american continent within its wider context in a way that is of relevance and interest to both the specialist and the more general reader

explores laura esquivel s critical reputation contextualizes her work in literary movements and considers hers four novels and the film based on like water for chocolate from various perspectives this book assesses the twenty years of esquivel criticism

dramatic photographs capture the people and places along the mexican american border those living in wealth and poverty in hope and in despair and the mexicans who attempt to cross the border and the patrol out to stop them

john ross has been living in the old colonial quarter of mexico city for the last three decades a rebel journalist covering mexico

and the region from the bottom up he is filled with a gnawing sense that his beloved mexico city s days as the most gargantuan chaotic crime ridden toxically contaminated urban stain in the western world are doomed and the monster he has grown to know and love through a quarter century of reporting on its foibles and tragedies and blight will be globalized into one more mccity el monstruo is a defense of place and the history of that place no one has told the gritty vibrant histories of this city of 23 million faceless souls from the ground up listened to the stories of those who have not been crushed deconstructed the monstruo s very monstrosity and lived to tell its secrets in el monstruo ross now does

a comprehensive account of recent developments in the relationship between mexico and the u s and the ways in which internal developments in each country have affected the other

some forty scholarly works written by historians on both sides of the border form the basis for this non scholarly attempt to provide a short simple story of events between the spanish conquest of mexico five centuries ago and mexicos dominance of itself since its independence of two hundred years better analysis of events here described in a factually chronologic way can be found in the writers historical sources a reader knowing little of mexicos history can get a good start with this writers try to show what the large and beautiful land to the south has met and overcome on the way to what it has and what it will become

in a variety of narrative voices poems and a play set at different times in history the author presents a journey to the maya lowlands of chiapas on a quest for his indio heritage and a vision of the multicultural identity emerging in america envisioning the disappearance of borders and evoking a fluid american self that needs no fixed identity or location
