witnessing comes in as many forms as the trauma that gives birth to it the holocaust undeniably one of the greatest traumatic events in recent human history still resonates into the twenty first century the echoes that haunt those who survived continue to reach their children and others who did not share the experience directly in what ways is this massive trauma processed and understood both for survivors and future generations the answer as deftly illustrated by nancy goodman and marilyn meyers lies in the power of witnessing the act of acknowledging that trauma took place coupled with the desire to share that knowledge with others to build a space in which to reveal confront and symbolize it as the contributors to this book demonstrate testimonial writing and memoir artwork poetry documentary theater and even the simple recollection of a memory are ways that honor and serve as forms of witnessing each chapter is a fusion of narrative and metaphor that exists as evidence of the living mind that emerges amid the dead spaces produced by mass trauma creating a revelatory transformational space for the terror of knowing and the possibility for affirmation of hope courage and endurance in the face of almost unspeakable evil additionally the power of witnessing is extended from the holocaust to contemporary instances of mass trauma and to psychoanalytic treatments proving its efficacy in the dyadic relationship of everyday practice for both patient and analyst the holocaust is not an easy subject to approach but the intimate and personal stories included here add up to an act of witnessing in and of itself combining the past and the present and placing the trauma in the realm of knowing sharing and understanding contributors harriet basseches elsa blum bridget conley zilkie paula ellman susan elmendorf george halasz geoffrey hartman renee hartman elaine neumann kulp shabad dori laub clemens loew gail humphries mardirosian margit meissner henri parens arlene kramer richards arnold richards sophia richman katalin roth nina shapiro perl myra sklarew erwin staub

this stunning graphic history tells the story of juan bautista tupac amaru a descendant of the last inca rulers after participating in his half brother s massive rebellion that stretched across peru from 1780 to 1783 juan bautista spent forty years imprisoned by the spanish on an odyssey that took him from cusco to lima to rio de janeiro to cádiz to ceuta the african presidio and back to south america

the term witness has become synonymous with evangelism but true witnessing is usually found in dissenting it refuses to bow to idols or to take the easy road or deny christ and all he died for this collection is rooted in that belief that having the mind of christ means we will do things differently it offers practical resources for pastoral care that celebrates people on the margins of the church and provides liturgies for those who suffer racism or injustice who experience tragedy and loss who raise their voices in protest or lament and more these texts do not carry the stamp of approval of any church body but will bring the light of the gospel where it is needed arranged in six sections it includes contributions from well known and new voices covering the themes of witness in ordinary time communion birth and baptism united in love suffering presence death and resurrection

the centenary of the world missionary conference held in edinburgh in 1910 is a suggestive moment for many people seeking direction for christian mission in the twenty first century since 2005 an international group has worked collaboratively to develop an intercontinental and multidenominational project now known as edinburgh 2010 and based at new college university of edinburgh essential to the work of the edinburgh 1910 conference and of abiding value were the findings of the eight think tanks or commissions these inspired the idea of a new round of collaborative reflection on christian mission but now focused on nine themes identified as being key to mission in the twenty first century the study process is intended to contribute from a research perspective to the aim of edinburgh 2010 witnessing together to christ in the twenty first century and to the development of a new vision in terms of god s purposes for creation in christ and a renewed spirituality and mission ethos in the life of churches worldwide witnessing to christ today contains a summary of what has been achieved through the study process up to the end of 2009 and forms the preparatory volume for the centenary conference to be held in edinburgh on 2 6 june 2010 there the material will be subjected to rigorous critique from various transversal perspectives and engaged with by church and mission delegates from around the world

this book examines the concept of witness protection which is still at an early developmental stage in several african countries including nigeria from a legal and institutional perspective recent developments in nigeria highlight the need to clarify legal and conceptual issues within the existing legal framework for protecting witnesses using the nigerian case study the book illustrates some obscurities inherent in the concept of witness protection these are highlighted around five critical areas the definition of witness protection the scope of beneficiaries requiring protection the nature of crimes necessitating protection the nature of protective measures and the administrative control of witness protection specifically this book draws from the existing literature and practices of witness protection and adopts two distinct perspectives the criminal justice perspectives and human rights perspectives as heuristic tools for analysing the concept and to separate the disparate influences that shape how it is construed these distinctions are utilised throughout the book as an integrated way of conceptualising the concept of witness protection by discussing the practice of witness protection within the nigerian context the book contributes to african conversations on the topic of witness protection the clarifications made in this book are utilised in making normative proposals for developing a legal framework for witness protection in nigeria they are also useful for other african countries interested in developing a witness protection framework as part of criminal justice reform this book will serve as a reference point for legal scholars researchers academics postgraduate students and policy makers interested in the concept of witness protection it would also be useful for courses concerned with comparative criminology where there is an interest in developments in the global south
