william terry couch 1901 1988 began his four decade publishing career building the
 university of north carolina press into one of the nation s leading university presses his
 editorial attacks on the social ills of the south earned him a reputation as a southern
 liberal by the 1940s his disaffection with new deal politics turned him toward the right
 resulting in his 1950 firing as director of the university of chicago press as a conservative
 couch sought books and articles that would sway general readers from what he saw as
 an intellectual torpor that accepted the growing role of government in american life the
 liberals who controlled the presses found him dogmatic and irascible when he tried to
 turn collier s encyclopedia into a journal of conservative opinion he was fired as editor
 in chief in 1959 he ended his career as publisher for the libertarian william volker fund
 which collapsed in the 1960s under charges of nazism couch was committed to
 publishing as a social cause and strove to disturb american complacency this is the first
 book length biography of couch a publisher who brought academic scholarship to the
 reading public to effect social political and economic change

in this in depth look at the heated debates over paying college athletes ronald a smith starts at the beginning the first intercollegiate athletics competition a crew regatta between harvard and yale in 1852 when both teams received an all expenses paid vacation from a railroad magnate this striking opening sets smith on the path of a story filled with paradoxes and hypocrisies that plays out on the field in meeting rooms and in courtrooms and that ultimately reveals that any insistence on amateurism is invalid because these athletes have always been paid one way or another from that first contest to athletes attempts to unionize and california s 2019 fair pay to play act smith shows that throughout the decades undercover payments hiring professional coaches and breaking the ncaa s rules on athletic scholarships have always been part of the game he explores how the regulation of male and female student athletes has shifted how class race and gender played a role in these transitions and how the case for amateurism evolved from a moral argument to one concerned with financially and legally protecting college sports and the ncaa timely and thought provoking the myth of the amateur is essential reading for college sports fans and scholars

we tend to think of contemporary concern for reform in education as unprecedented in its intensity and scope but as this book about mid nineteenth century educational ideology shows the urge to improve society through its schools has been with us a long time the author examines the attitudes that shaped the ontario public school system during its formative years when upper canadians first explored and the provincial government finally adopted the principle of compulsory mass schooling under the auspices and control of the state

this collection addressing a topic of ongoing interest and debate in american archaeology examines the evolution of ranked chiefdoms in the midwestern and southeastern united states during the period a d 700 1200 the volume brings together a

renaissance lawman the education and deeds of eliot h lumbard details the life education and public service career of eliot howland lumbard a lawyer who most of his life lived and worked in manhattan and whose legal career spanned more than fifty years beginning in the early 1950s lumbard is easily identified as a renaissance lawman for having gained considerable expertise in the operations of the political and justice systems and for proceeding to capitalize on this knowledge to become both an advocate and initiator of progressive reforms for criminal justice his contributions on behalf of public safety have been largely forgotten but throughout this intriguing biography martin alan greenberg successfully juxtaposes many of lumbard s professional activities with many of the major historical developments and challenges of his time the chronicled events emphasize what motivated the people in his generation to behave as they did since the world today is a much different place than what americans were experiencing in the first three decades after ww ii cultural and technological changes have combined to make our present day world quite different from over a half century ago renaissance lawman proves to be especially rewarding to a wide range of readers interested in police work criminal justice history public service leadership and legal ethics there are no other comparable books on the market lumbard certainly had a unique legal career and his impactful contributions have seldom if ever been duplicated even if his contributions on behalf of public safety have been largely forgotten

in the wake of world war ii anatomist and anthropologist mildred trotter left the midwest for a temporary post as the forensic anthropology expert for the army in the territory of hawaii her formidable task was to identify the remains of war dead in order to return them to their families in a national effort that continues to this day mildred trotter and the invisible histories of physical and forensic anthropology is the first long overdue biography on this woman of immense stature in her field she was the first woman to serve as president of the american association of physical anthropologists and the first woman to be full professor at the washington university school of medicine in st louis while primarily a biography of trotter this book also examines aspects that are so often left out of retrospectives of science and scientific figures this includes scientific error the historical experiences of the few women and individuals from other marginalized groups active in the discipline sexism and scientific and social racism this book also provides novel historical context regarding her major and now well known tibia mismeasurement mildred trotter and the invisible histories of physical and forensic anthropology is a must read for anyone interested in the history of science and women in science and for all practicing and aspiring biological and forensic anthropologists

james clerk maxwell 1831 1879 was one of the most important mathematical physicists of all time in scientific terms his immortality is enshrined in electromagnetism and maxwell s equations but as this book shows there was much more to maxwell than electromagnetism both in terms of his science and his wider life
