one of mexico's foremost social and political chroniclers and its most celebrated cultural critic carlos Monsivís has read the pulse of his country over the past half century the author of five collections of literary journalism pieces called crónicas he is perhaps best known for his analytic and often satirical descriptions of mexico city's popular culture this comprehensive study of Monsivís's crónicas is the first book to offer an analysis of these works and to place Monsivís's work within a theoretical framework that recognizes the importance of his vision of mexican culture linda Egan examines his ideology in relation to theoretical postures in latin america the united states and europe to cast

monsiv is as both a heterodox pioneer and a mainstream spokesman she then explores the poetics of the contemporary chronicle in mexico reviewing the genre's history and its relation to other narrative forms finally she focuses on the canonical status of monsiv is's work devoting a chapter to each of his five principal collections egan argues that the five books that are the focus of her study tell a story of ever renewing suspense we cannot know the end until monsiv is is through constructing his literary project despite this she observes his work between 1970 and 1995 documents important discoveries in his search for causes effects and deconstructions of historical obstacles to mexico's passage into modernity while anthropologists and historians continue to introduce new paradigms for the study of mexico's cultural space egan's book provides a reflexive twist by examining the work of one of the thinkers who first inspired such a critical movement more than an appraisal of monsiv is it offers a valuable discussion of theoretical issues surrounding the study of the chronicle as it is currently practiced in mexico it balances theory and criticism to lend new insight into the ties between mexican society social conscience and literature

using concepts from urban and cultural studies city fictions examines the representation of the city in the works of five important late twentieth century spanish american authors octavio paz julio cortazar christina peri rossi diamela eltit and carlos monsavaiz while each of these authors is influenced at least partially by a specific spanish american city be it mexico city buenos aires montevideo or santiago the element that brings them together is the way in which the city is fictionalized in their work they all equate both language and the body with urban space in these metaphors language breaks down and the body disintegrates creating a disturbing picture of violent decline the poetry of paz associates the urban surroundings with dissolving sentences and desensitized fingertips for cortazar characters walking through cities are seen as both creating and unraveling written texts

this book studies the role of subterranean spaces in literary works about mexico city it analyzes how underground spaces such as the subway the sewage system tunnels crypts and the subsoil itself relate to the whole of the city in a body of works published after 1985 the year of the deadliest earthquake in the capital's history the texts belong to the most important genres in urban literature the novel the short story and the crónica and demonstrate the crucial role played by the underground in contemporary imaginings of the megalopolis as it condenses and confronts the tensions that run through them this central idea is developed through four analytical chapters focusing on the political ecological historical and aesthetic dimension of subterranean imaginaries

on the zócalo the main square of Mexico City Mexico's entire musical history is performed every day Mexican percussionists drum and dance to the music of Aztec rituals on the open plaza inside the Metropolitan Cathedral choristers sing colonial villancicos outside the National Palace the Mexican Army marching band plays the himno nacional a vestige of the nineteenth century and all around the square people listen to the contemporary sounds of pop rock and música grupera in all some seven centuries of music maintain a living presence in the modern city this book offers an up to date comprehensive history and ethnography of musical rituals in the world's largest city Mark Pedelty details the dominant musical rites of the Aztec colonial national revolutionary modern and contemporary eras analyzing the role that musical ritual played in governance resistance and social change his approach is twofold historical chapters describe the rituals and their functions while ethnographic chapters explore how these musical forms continue to resonate in contemporary Mexican society as a whole the book provides a living record of cultural continuity change and vitality

the modern metropolis has been called the symbol of our times and life in it epitomizes for many modernity itself but what to make of inherited ideas of modernity when faced with life in Mexico City and São Paulo two of the largest metropolises in the world is their fractured reality their brutal social contrasts and the ever escalating violence faced by their citizens just an intensification of what Engels described in the first in depth analysis of an industrial metropolis nineteenth century Manchester or have post industrial and neo globalized economies given rise to new forms of urban existence in the so called developing world life in the megalopolis Mexico City and São Paulo investigates how such questions are explored in cultural productions from these two Latin American megalopolises the focus being on literature film popular music and visual arts this book combines close readings of works with a constant reference to theoretical anthropological and social studies of these two cities and builds on received definitions of the concept megalopolis life in the megalopolis is the first book to combine urban studies theories particularly Lefebvre Harvey and de Certeau with Benjaminian cultural analyses and theoretical discussions with close readings of recent cultural works in various media it is also the first book to compare Mexico City and São Paulo

winner of the Victor Villaseñor Best Latino Focused Nonfiction Book Award English from the 2022 International Latino Book Awards what defines the boundary between fact and fabrication fiction and nonfiction literature and journalism Latin American documentary narratives unpacks the precarious testimonial relationship between author and subject where the literary journalist rather than the subject being interviewed can become the hero of a narrative in its recording and retelling Latin American documentary narratives covers a variety of

nonfiction genres from the 1950s to the 2000s that address topics such as social protests dictatorships natural disasters crime and migration in latin america this book analyzes and includes an appendix of interviews with authors who have not previously been critically read together from the early and emblematic works of gabriel garcía márquez and elena poniatowska to more recent authors like leila guerriero and juan villoro who are currently reshaping media and audiences in latin america in a world overwhelmed by data production and marked by violent acts against those considered others liliana Chávez Díaz argues that storytelling plays an essential role in communication among individuals classes and cultures

in the months leading up to the 1968 olympic games in mexico city students took to the streets calling for greater democratization and decrying crackdowns on political resistance by the ruling pri party during a mass meeting held at the plaza of the three cultures in the tlTelolco neighborhood paramilitary forces opened fire on the gathering the death toll from the massacre remains a contested number ranging from an official count in the dozens to estimates in the hundreds by journalists and scholars rereading the legacy of this tragedy through diverse artistic political interventions across the decades photopoetics at tlTelolco explores the state's dual repression both the massacre's crushing effects on the movement and the manipulation of cultural discourse and political thought in the aftermath examining artifacts ranging from documentary photography and testimony to poetry essays chronicles cinema literary texts video and performance samuel steinberg considers the broad photographic and photopoetic nature of modern witnessing as well as the specific elements of light gunfire flares camera flashes that ultimately defined the massacre steinberg also demonstrates the ways in which the labels of massacre and sacrifice inform contemporary perceptions of the state's blatant and violent repression of unrest with implications for similar processes throughout the rest of latin america from the 1960s to the present day photopoetics at tlTelolco provides a powerful new model for understanding the intersection of political history and cultural memory

rethinks the concepts of nation imperialism and globalization by examining the everyday writing of the newspaper chronicle and blog in spain and latin america in the everyday atlantic tania gentic offers a new understanding of the ways in which individuals and communities perceive themselves in the twentieth century atlantic world she grounds her study in first time comparative readings of daily newspaper texts written in spanish portuguese and catalan known as chronicles these everyday literary writings are a precursor to the blog and reveal the ephemerality of identity as it is represented and received daily throughout the text gentic offers fresh readings of well known and lesser known chroniclers cronistas including eugeni d'ors catalonia germán arciniegas colombia clarice lispector brazil carlos monsiváis

mexico and brazilian blogger ricardo noblat while previous approaches to the atlantic have focused on geographical crossings by subjects genetic highlights the everyday moments of reading and thought in which discourses of nation postcolonialism and globalization come into conflict critics have often evaluated in isolation how ideology ethics affect and the body inform identity however genetic skillfully combines these approaches to demonstrate how the chronicle exposes everyday representations of self and community

this landmark collection of illustrated essays explores the vastly underappreciated history of america's other cities the great metropolises found south of our borders in central and south america buenos aires so paulo mexico city caracas havana santiago rio tijuana and quito are just some of the subjects of this diverse collection how have desires to create modern societies shaped these cities leading to both architectural masterworks by the likes of luis barragan juan o'gorman lcio costa roberto burle marx carlos ral villanueva and lina bo bardi and the most shocking favelas how have they grappled with concepts of national identity their colonial history and the continued demands of a globalized economy lavishly illustrated cruelty and utopia features the work of such leading scholars as carlos fuentes edward burian lauro cavalcanti fernando oayrzn roberto segre and eduardo subirats along with artwork ranging from colonial paintings to stills from chantal akerman's film from the other side also included is a revised translation of spanish king philip ii's influential planning treatise of 1573 the laws of the indies which did so much to define the form of the latin american city

in mexico the participation of intellectuals in public life has always been extraordinary and for many the price can be high highlighting prominent figures that have made incursions into issues such as elections human rights foreign policy and the drug war this volume paints a picture of the ever changing context of mexican intellectualism

cultures of the city explores the cultural mediation of relationships between people and urban spaces in latin o'america and how these mediations shape the identities of cities and their residents addressing a broad spectrum of phenomena and disciplinary approaches the contributors to this volume analyze lived urban experiences and their symbolic representation in cultural texts individual chapters explore havana in popular music mexico city in art buenos aires recife and salvador in film and asuncion and buenos aires in literature others focus on particular events conditions and practices of urban life including the havana book fair mass transit in bogota the restaurant industry in los angeles the media in detroit andean festivals in lima and the photographic record of a visit by members of the zapatista liberation army to mexico city the contributors examine identity and the sense of place and belonging that connect people to urban environments relating

these to considerations of ethnicity social and economic class gender everyday life and cultural practices they also consider history and memory and the making of places through the iterative performance of social practices as such places are works in progress a condition that is particularly evident in contemporary latin o american cities where the opposition between local and global influences is a prominent facet of daily life these core issues are theorized further in an afterword by abril trigo who takes the chapters as a point of departure for a discussion of the dialectics of identity in the latin o american global city

containing roughly 850 entries about spanish language literature throughout the world this expansive work provides coverage of the varied countries ethnicities time periods literary movements and genres of these writings providing a thorough introduction to spanish language literature worldwide and across time is a tall order however world literature in spanish an encyclopedia contains roughly 850 entries on both major and minor authors themes genres and topics of spanish literature from the middle ages to the present day affording an amazingly comprehensive reference collection in a single work this encyclopedia describes the growing diversity within national borders the increasing interdependence among nations and the myriad impacts of spanish literature across the globe all countries that produce literature in spanish in europe africa the americas and asia are represented covering both canonical authors and emerging contemporary writers and trends underrepresented writings such as texts by women writers queer and afro hispanic texts children s literature and works on relevant but less studied topics such as sports and nationalism also appear while writings throughout the centuries are covered those of the 20th and 21st centuries receive special consideration

portraits of good battling evil in the geography of hell come in many forms in the hispanic world apocalyptic nightmares frightful images of chaos and death are inclusive and interrelated yet simultaneously project an exceptional quality never seen or experienced before the mother of all battles i am the only one who can fix it this investigation explores how narrative logic may challenge unified notions of finalities when images remain unfulfilled in a proscribed end by redeploying transglobal character and narrative potential the apocalypse suggests bewildering complexities as it trains its lens on new beginnings here analysis explores resilient formulas for combating the end through resistance in latin america spain and latin communities in the us whether revealed through gilded illustrations messianic chronicles poetry baroque letters racially motivated novels sexuality and spirituality in film or intimidating immigrant photos apocalyptic examples explode notions of final moments the resilient apocalypse ironically performs as both an internal defense a vehicle for mourning and a counter discourse to power a mechanism for resistance this study argues for a strategy that listens to and keeps the enemy in sight

and in mind a method for grappling with and engaging difference by decolonizing the politics of the end it reformulates an incomplete mythical and uncanny narrative into a poetics of resistance with communal solutions and obligations when the apocalypse is unremittingly sought after to impose social justice salvation and reason it paradoxically introduces future hope against itself in the works of beato de liébana sor juana inés de la cruz cirilo villaverde cristina garcía martín kohan jennifer maytorena taylor santiago roncagliolo alfonso cuarón etc rival traditions internalize competing apocalyptic worldviews and arrive at sustainable plans of action for negotiating the afterward by bracketing the finality of the end and proposing a tension between conflict archaeology and the transcendence of opposition through renovation salvation or hope this study reveals how plural competing viewpoints of the end go a long way to legitimizing each other ultimately the resilient apocalypse traces a compelling narrative theory of unfulfilled promise that forever changes the way we engage the other and value the self during intervals of fear

using interdisciplinary performance studies and cultural studies frameworks laura g gutiérrez examines the cultural representation of queer sexuality in the contemporary cultural production of mexican female and chicana performance and visual artists in particular she locates the analytical lenses of feminist theory and queer theory in a central position to interrogate mexican female dissident sexualities in transnational public culture this is the first book length study to wed performance studies and queer theory in examining the performative performance work of important contemporary mexicana and chicana cultural workers it proposes that the creations of several important artists chicana visual artist alma lópez the mexican political cabareteras astrid hadad jesusa rodríguez liliana felipe and regina orozco the chicana performance artist nao bustamante and the mexican video artist ximena cuevas unsettle heterosexual national culture in doing so they are not only challenging heterosexist and nationalist discourses head on but are also participating in the construction of a queer world making project treating the notion of dis comfort as a productive category in these projects advances feminist and queer theories by offering an insightful critical movement suggesting that queer worlds are simultaneously spaces of desire fear and hope gutiérrez demonstrates how arenas formerly closed to female performers are now providing both an artistic outlet and a powerful political tool that crosses not only geographic borders but social sexual political and class boundaries as well and deconstructs the relationships among media hierarchies of power and the cultures of privilege

these texts represent both the formation of visual culture and the ways in which it has transformed and continues to transform our understanding and experience of the world as a visual domain

in the wake of its early twentieth century civil wars mexico strove to present itself to the world as unified and prosperous the preparation in mexico city for the 1968 summer olympics was arguably the most ambitious of a sequence of design projects that aimed to signal mexico's arrival in the developed world in spectacular mexico luis m castañeda demonstrates how these projects were used to create a spectacle of social harmony and ultimately to guide the nation's capital into becoming the powerful megacity we know today not only the first latin american country to host the olympics but also the first spanish speaking country mexico's architectural transformation was put on international display from traveling exhibitions of indigenous archaeological artifacts to the construction of the mexico city subway spectacular mexico details how these key projects placed the nation on the stage of global capitalism and revamped its status as a modernized country surveying works of major architects such as félix candela pedro ramírez vázquez ricardo legorreta and graphic designer lance wyman castañeda illustrates the use of architecture and design as instruments of propaganda and nation branding forming a kind of image economy mexico's architectural projects and artifacts were at the heart of the nation's economic growth and cultivated a new mass audience at an international level through an examination of one of the most important cosmopolitan moments in mexico's history spectacular mexico positions architecture as central to the negotiation of social economic and political relations

worldwide environmental crisis has become increasingly visible over the last few decades as the full scope of anthropogenic climate change manifests itself and large scale natural resource extraction has expanded into formerly remote areas that seemed beyond the reach of industrialization scientists and popular culture alike have turned to the term anthropocene to capture the global scale of environmental and even geological transformations that humans have carried out over the last two centuries the chapters in ecological crisis and cultural representation in latin america examine the dynamics and interplay between local cultures and the expansion of global capitalism in latin america emphasizing the role of art in bearing witness to and generating awareness of environmental and social crises but also its possibilities for formulating solutions they take particular care to draw out the ways in which local environmental crises in latin american nations are witnessed and imagined as part of a global system focusing on the problems of time scale and complexity as key terms in conceiving the dimensions of crisis at the same time they question the notion of the anthropocene as a species wide human historical project making visible the colonality of natural resource extraction in latin america and its dire effects for local people cultures and environments taking an ecocritical approach to latin american cultural production including literature film performance and digital artwork the chapters in this volume develop a notion of ecological crisis that captures not only its documentary sense in the representation of environmental destruction the degradation of the oikos but also the crisis in the modern worldview logos that the acknowledgment of crisis provokes in

this sense crisis is also the promise of a turning point of the possibilities for change latin american representations of ecological crisis thus create the conditions for projects that decolonize environments developing new sustainable ways of conceiving of and relating to our world or returning to old ones

this book reveals how boxing and boxers became sources of national pride and sparked debates on what it meant to be mexican masculine and modern

historically los angeles and its exhibition market have been central to the international success of latin american cinema not only was los angeles a site crucial for exhibition of these films but it became the most important hub in the western hemisphere for the distribution of spanish language films made for latin american audiences cinema between latin america and los angeles builds upon this foundational insight to both examine the considerable ongoing role that los angeles played in the history of spanish language cinema and to explore the implications of this transnational dynamic for the study and analysis of latin american cinema before 1960 the volume editors aim to flesh out the gaps between hollywood and latin america american imperialism and latin american nationalism in order to produce a more nuanced view of transnational cultural relations in the western hemisphere

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
