alan j pakula's political thriller all the president's men 1976 was met with immediate critical and commercial success upon its release finishing second at the box office and earning seven academy award nominations through a close reading of key scenes performances and stylistic decisions christian keathley and robert b ray show how the film derives its narrative power through a series of controlled oppositions silence vs noise stationary vs moving camera dark vs well lit scenes and shallow vs deep focus tracing how these elements combine to create an underlying formal design crucial to the film's achievement they argue that the film does not fit the auteurist model of new hollywood film makers such as coppola and scorsese instead all the president's men more closely resembles a studio era film the result of a collaboration between a producer robert redford multiple scriptwriters a skilful director important stars robert redford and dustin hoffman a distinctive cameraman gordon willis an imaginative art director george jenkins and ingenious sound designers who together created an enduringly great film

archaeologist matt packard unearths a tomb in utah containing fifteen ancient skeletons the sixteenth has a bullet in its wingbone and packard is plunged into a web of vicious killers and people in high places desperate to prevent his discovery of the truth about jfk's assassination

screen writing is a unique literary form screenplays are like musical scores in that they are intended to be interpreted on the basis of other artists performances rather than serving as finished products for the enjoyment of their readers they are written using technical jargon and tight spare prose to describe set directions unlike a novella a script focuses on describing the literal visual aspects of the story rather than on its characters internal thoughts in screen writing the aim is to evoke those thoughts and emotions through subtext action and symbolism prominent hollywood script doctors include steve zaillian william goldman robert townes mort nathan quentin tarantino etc while many up and coming screenwriters work as ghost writers this book is a modest catalogue of some of the most prominent screenwriters listed from a to z the good are sometimes bad and they can be even ugly many comments herein included were googled in deference to the multiplicity of information available today yet they reflect exactly or almost what i thought an amazing thing today is how anonymous commentators on the internet rival and even surpass the poor quality of professional media and specialised literature it all comes down to watching the truth 24 times per second to quote jean luc godard s phrase not to mention that such truth may include sex scenes violence pedophilia etc we know that a literary masterpiece like henry james portrait of a lady became a film of very poor quality as scripted by laura jones we know conversely that a mediocre writer like mickey spillane inspired at least one film as remarkable as kiss me deadly thanks to a i bezzerides script asa former screenwriter mr correa must avow that he found the job most gratifying writing that looks effortless is often hellish to write and revise it was something he did have to slog through but it proved particularly pleasing editing discussing finishing your work is particularly gratifying identifying your flaws and working to mitigate them is also gratifying it is a general perception that creative careers are more interesting and fun than others but the privilege of earning money through imagination and creativity is effectively hard won please comment at will please disagree at will be facetious in your remarks but please be neither vicious nor mean spirited

enter the psyche of a serial killer a desperate man trapped in a treacherous maze of murder lies love and suspense the violent love story justified murder defines destiny accepting that which is written versus fighting for control of one s life it is the classic battle between good and evil only the thin line

separating them is not so distinct this thriller introduces david hawthorne a killer who must choose between true love and embracing the dark desires buried in his soul raised by a zealot catholic preacher david is betrayed by a treacherous woman after his release from a mental hospital for her killing a chance encounter leads to murder once the flood gates are open david is compelled to kill again david uses his dynamic personality as a tv reporter to manipulate viewers into feeling compassion for the killer and his popularity soars unaware of his crimes district attorney melanie hunter begins a romantic relationship with david investigating the murder case is a well respected detective harold thompson as the cat and mouse game between them begins the detective learns that he and david have much in common meanwhile david struggles to keep his three lives separate his peaceful life with melanie his dark life as a serial killer and his glamorous life as a tv reporter will david tame the monster within and live happily ever after with melanie or will harold bring the killer to justice

private eyes is the complete map to what raymond bandler called the mean streets the exciting world of the fictional private eye it is intended to entertain current pi fans and to make new ones

during the summer of 1800 slaves in and around richmond conspired to overthrow their masters and abolish slavery this book uses gabriel s conspiracy and the evidence produced during the repression of the revolt to expose the processes through which virginians of african descent built an oppositional culture sidbury portrays the rich cultures of eighteenth century black virginians and the multiple and sometimes conflicting senses of identity that emerged among enslaved and free people living in and around the rapidly growing state capital the book also examines the conspirators vision of themselves as god s chosen people and the complicated african and european roots of their culture in so doing it offers an alternative interpretation of the meaning of the virginia that was home to so many of the founding fathers this narrative focuses on the history and perspectives of black and enslaved people in order to develop gabriel s virginia as a counterpoint to more common discussions of jeffersonian virginia
