the ideal perfection called baqa by sufis is termed najat in islam nirvana in buddhism salvation in christianity and mukhti in hinduism this is the highest condition attainable and all ancient prophets and sages experienced it and taught it to the world baqa is the original state of god at this state every being must arrive some day consciously or unconsciously before or after death the beginning and end of all beings is the same difference only existing during the journey there are three ways in man s journey towards god the first is the way of ignorance through which each must travel it is like a person walking for miles in the sun while carrying a heavy load on his shoulder who when fatigued throws away the load and falls asleep under the shade of a tree such is the condition of the average person who spends his life blindly under the influence of his senses and gathers the load of his evil actions the agonies of his earthly longings creating a hell through which he must pass to reach the destination of his journey with regard to him the qur an says he who is blind in life shall also be blind in the hereafter the next way is that of devotion which is for true lovers rumi says man may be the lover of man or the lover of god after his perfection in either he is taken before the king of love devotion is the heavenly wine which intoxicates the devotee until his heart becomes purified from all infirmities and there remains the happy vision of the beloved which lasts to the end of the journey death is a bridge which unites friend to friend sayings of mohammed the third is the way of wisdom accomplished only by the few the disciple disregards life s momentary comforts unties himself from all earthly bondages and turns his eyes toward god inspired with divine wisdom he gains command over his body his thoughts and feelings and is thereby enabled to create his own heaven within himself that he may rejoice until merged into the eternal goal we have stripped the veil from thine eyes and thy sight today is keen says the qur an all must journey along one of these three paths but in the end they arrive at one and the same goal as it is said in the qur an it is he who multiplied you on the earth and to him you shall be gathered

this volume discusses the origin and structure of the universe in mystical islam sufism with special reference to parallel realms of existence and their interaction contributors address sufi ideas about the fate of human beings in this and future life under three rubrics 1 cosmogony and eschatology where do we come from and where do we go 2 conceptualizations of the world of the here and now where are we now and 3 visualizations of realms of existence their hierarchy and mutual relationships where are we in relation to other times and places contributors are christian lange alexander knysh noah gardiner stephen hirstenstein saeko yazaki jean jacques thibon leah kinberg sara sviri munjed m murad simon o meara pierre lory mathieu terrier michael ebstein binyamin abrahamov and frederick colby

this is a book on love integrating the human aspects of it with its divine essence spiritual liberty is a prerequisite for this integration it refers to a state where one is no longer

dependent on outer circumstances and on the fancies of one's mind therefore it is also a book on the spiritual path which leads man from imperfection to perfection from self consciousness to ever flowing sympathy it is the path of the unfoldment of the soul the soul is the lightning spark of the divine sun within ourselves it is the most original part of our being which will be the only part lasting forever ultimately unified in its divine origin thus it is a book on birth and death also on life here and in the hereafter on reincarnation and spiritism all these items are treated from both the philosophical and the psychological points of view and integrated by the mystical perspective

a sufi study of hadith originally titled *haqiqa al tariqa min as sunna al aniqā* is a unique work of commentary on a selection of over three hundred authentic hadith maulana ashraf ali thanawi one of the subcontinent's greatest spiritual leaders and an author of unequalled prolificacy translates interprets and then comments on each hadith from the perspective of tasawwuf whether to explain a fine point of theology or to discourse on morality etiquette behaviour or the customary practices of sufis in the pages of this volume one encounters a side of islam that is little known and less understood for all seekers of the truth and especially those keen to further their understanding of the teachings of the prophet upon him be peace on tasawwuf related subjects maulana thanawi's work is truly invaluable

the indian sufi master hazrat inayat khan 1882 1927 was the very first teacher to bring sufism to the western world this is the first representative collection of the master's teachings making it the perfect book for anyone who has been intrigued by his writings but unsure about where to start in his sixteen volume collected works newcomers will be inspired by just how delightful and useful inayat khan's teachings are for everyone regardless of religious background long time students will find the book a valuable reference to the essence of his teachings on a variety of subjects each chapter includes a wealth of material taken from inayat khan's work on a particular subject such as mysticism discipleship music children or divine intimacy followed by a selection of his short sayings and aphorisms on the same topic

ghouls ifrits and a panoply of other jinn have long haunted muslim cultures and societies these also include jinn doppelgangers *qarīn pl quranā* the little studied and much feared denizens of the hearts and blood of humans this book seeks out jinn doppelgangers in the islamic normative tradition philosophy folklore and sufi literature with special emphasis on akbarian sufism muḥyī al dīn ibn 'arabī d 1240 wrote on jinn in substantial detail uncovering the physiognomy culture and behavior of this unseen species akbarians believed that the good god assigned each human with an evil doppelganger ibn 'arabī's reasoning as to why this was the case mirrors his attempts to expound the problem of evil in islamic religious philosophy no other sufi ibn 'arabī claimed ever managed to get to the heart of this matter before him as well as offering the reader knowledge and safety from evil ibn 'arabī's writings on jinnealogy tackle the even larger

issues of spiritual ascension predestination and the human relationship to the divine

this book is a literary study tracing the roles and functions of angels as characters in sufi literature based on their functions outlined in the qur'ān if you pick up any book discussing islam or islamic theology you will probably find angels in it one never thinks much about them and they often seem marginal however whether real or a simple literary device what are the angels real functions in a text this study proposes to outline their functions and more specifically what classical sufi literature 7th 12th century ce makes of them

the volume brings together approaches to different elements of arabic islamic civilization mainly in the areas of linguistics literature literary theory and prosody but also including religion ritual economics and zoology contributions also touch upon the adjacent areas of the old iranian persian greek and byzantine written traditions some take as their points of departure specific arabic words cat giraffe or morphemes others explore literary genres subgenres oration ode macaronic poem travel narrative or figures within them the trickster the devil cultural concepts such as wishing gift giving or discourse are treated as are aspects of broader phenomena such as the role of gender in dream interpretation or the relative merits of luxury goods and mass produced commodities

this ethnographic research project examines the generation of post tariqa tasavvuf sufism a spiritual practice and philosophy recognised as the inner dimension of islam in a variety of private semi public public secular and sacred urban spaces in present day turkey through extensive field research in minority sufi communities this book investigates how devotees of specific orders maintain adapt mobilise and empower their beliefs and values through embodied acts of their sufi followers using an ethnographic methodology and theories derived from performance studies esra Çizmeçi examines the multiple ways in which the post tariqa mevlevi and rifai practice is formed in present day turkey such as through the authority of the spiritual teacher the individual and collective performance of sufi rituals nefs self training and most importantly the practice of sufi doctrines in everyday life through the production of sacred spaces drawing on the theories of performance she examines how the sufi way of living and spaces are created anew in the process of each devotee's embodied action this book is informed by theories in performance studies anthropology religious studies and cultural studies and places current sufi practices in a historical perspective

through the lips of man he has done this all through the history of man every great teacher of the past having been this guiding spirit living the life of god in human guise in other words their human guise consists of various coats worn by the same person who appeared to be different in each shiva buddha rama krishna on the one side abraham moses jesus muhammad on the other and many more known or unknown to history always one and the same person those who saw the person and knew him recognized him in whatever form or guise those who could only see the coat went astray to the sufi therefore there is only one teacher however differently he may be named at different periods of history and he comes constantly to awaken humanity from the slumber of this life of illusion and to guide man onwards towards divine perfection as the sufi progresses in this view he recognizes his master not only in the holy ones but in the wise in the foolish in the saint and in the sinner and has never allowed the master who is one alone and the only one who can be and who ever will be to disappear from his sight the persian word for master is murshid the sufi recognizes the murshid in all beings of the world and is ready to learn from young and old educated and uneducated rich and poor without questioning from whom he learns then he begins to see the light of risalat the torch of truth which shines before him in every being and thing in the universe thus he sees rasul his divine message bearer a living identity before him thus the sufi sees the vision of god the worshipped deity in his immanence manifest in nature and life now becomes for him a perfect revelation both within and without

this book will present close readings of three contemporary arabic novelists an egyptian

gamal al ghitany an algerian taher ouettar and a touareg libyan ibrahim al koni who have all turned to sufism as a literary strategy aimed at negotiating i

based on a critical study of a large number of contemporary persian texts court chronicles epistolary collections and biographies of sufi mystics the mughals and the sufis examines the complexities in the relationship between mughal political culture and the two dominant strains of islam s sufi traditions in south asia one centered around orthodoxy the other focusing on a more accommodating and mystical spirituality muzaffar alam analyses the interplay of these elements their negotiation and struggle for resolution via conflict and coordination and their longer term outcomes as the empire followed its own political and cultural trajectory as it shifted from the more liberal outlook of emperor akbar the great r 1556 1605 to the more rigid attitudes of his great grandson aurangzeb alamgir r 1658 1701 alam brings to light many new and underutilized sources relevant to the religious and cultural history of the mughals and reinterprets well known sources from a new perspective to provide one of the most detailed and nuanced portraits of indian islam under the mughal empire available today

everyday faith in sufi senegal explores the historical religious cultural and economic contexts of islam in senegal through the narrative first hand accounts of people s everyday lives drawing on rich ethnographic fieldwork conducted by the author over a period of seven years the result is a critical look at senegal s religious diversity within islamic beliefs and practices containing interviews from men and women in both rural and urban locations this book is an important contribution to the literature on islamic practices providing a much needed perspective from ordinary practitioners of the faith it is essential reading for scholars of the anthropology of religion islamic studies mysticism african studies and development studies

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sufism in ottoman damascus analyzes thaumaturgical beliefs and practices prevalent among muslims in eighteenth century ottoman syria the study focuses on historical beliefs in baraka which religious authorities often interpreted as allah s grace and the alleged sufi ulamaic role in distributing it to ottoman subjects this book highlights considerable overlaps between sufis and 'ulamā with state appointments in early modern province of damascus arguing for the possibility of sociologically defining a muslim priestly sodality a group of religious authorities and wonder workers responsible for sunni orthodoxy in the ottoman empire the sufi 'ulamā were integral to ottoman networks of the holy networks of grace that comprised of hallowed individuals places and natural objects sufism in ottoman damascus sheds new light on the appropriate scholarly approach to historical studies of sufism in the ottoman empire revising its position in official early modern versions of ottoman sunnism this book further reapproaches early modern sunni beliefs in wonders and wonder working as well as the relationship between religion

thaumaturgy and magic in ottoman sunni islam historical themes comparable to other religions and other parts of the world

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
