in art and representation john willats presents a radically new theory of pictures to do this he has developed a precise vocabulary for describing the representational systems in pictures the ways in which artists engineers photographers mapmakers and children represent objects his approach is derived from recent research in visual perception and artificial intelligence and willats begins by clarifying the key distinction between the marks in a picture and the features of the scene that these marks represent the methods he uses are thus closer to those of a modern structural linguist or psycholinguist than to those of an art historian using over 150 illustrations willats analyzes the representational systems in pictures by artists from a wide variety of periods and cultures he then relates these systems to the mental processes of picture production and displaying an impressive grasp of more than one scholarly discipline shows how the greek vase painters chinese painters giotto icon painters picasso paul klee and david hockney have put these systems to work but this book is not only about what systems artists use but also about why artists from different periods and cultures have used such different systems and why drawings by young children look so different from those by adults willats argues that the representational systems can serve many different functions beyond that of merely providing a convincing illusion these include the use of anomalous pictorial devices such as inverted perspective which may be used for expressive reasons or to distance the viewer from the depicted scene by drawing attention to the picture as a painted surface willats concludes that art historical changes and the developmental changes in children s drawings are not merely arbitrary nor are they driven by evolutionary forces rather they are determined by the different functions that the representational systems in pictures can serve like readers of ernst gombrich s famous art and illusion still available from princeton university press on which art and representation makes important theoretical advances or rudolf arnheim s art and visual perception willats s readers will find that they will never again return to their old ways of looking at pictures

an exploration of the interaction between art and politics in early modern germany this work focuses on art political in content produced by the augsburg artist jörg breu the elder during the second and third decodes of the sixteenth century the book argues for the function of the art as fashioning political identities the artist jörg breu is first introduced his work for the city of augsburg and for habsburg and wittelsbach rulers are examined these works are placed within their historical context and analyzed according to how they articulate themes of warfare ceremony and history in order to construct political identity the analysis of breu s city chronicle and of the

response of his art to political contest is particularly useful for historians of art and of politics

despite having become marginalized on the map of contemporary art since the wars of the 1990s the regions of former yugoslavia continue to be a hub of creative activity especially noteworthy is the strong presence of women artists scholars and activists whose deeply personal yet highly political artwork is rooted in a long legacy of female artistic agency building on existing scholarship as well as original research this book highlights how female figures through art and exhibition making writing mentorship and activism have shaped the alternative art scene in former yugoslavia and placed the region firmly on the map of the international post avantgarde using the founding of the student cultural center belgrade in 1971 as a starting point the book details the pioneering work of women in the realm of curation where they developed radical exhibition concepts and programs that furthered the development of the new art practice and embedded yugoslavia firmly on the map of the international postwar avantgardes it highlights the agency of female artists in the then novel realms of performance art video art and new media art and shows how their work has helped these disciplines to gain the impact they retain until the present day what is more it shows how female cultural workers have courageously used their work to further the discourse on gender sexuality and the female body and at a time when they saw themselves stripped of basic rights by the chauvinist nationalist regimes emerging after yugoslavia s breakup formed a strong artistic and activist opposition highlighting the role of women in the diversification of the ex yugoslavia states and its highly unique cultural and political landscape this book addresses the noticeable gap in art historical scholarship that exists not only around yugoslavia and its successor states but especially on its female representatives

establishing a missed link between the work of piero manzoni and hélio oiticica and their respective cultural contexts this book sheds new light on overlooked aspects of these two artists practices particularly focusing on the shift from painting to performance in the long 1960s lara demori envisions a transnational juxtaposition a conceptual dialogue that discloses overlooked resonances between the work and the modus operandi of both artists repositioning claims of national exceptionalism within a web of constellated practices this book proposes their oeuvre as heterogeneous

critical models to unpack categories of thought used to analyse the postwar decades tabula rasa anti art open work and self marginalisation and freedom these in turn are charged with specific histories and offer new paradigms for the formal and social inventions perpetuated by the art of manzoni oiticica and fellow artists in the context of the détournements that crossed the 1960s on a global scale this book will be of interest to scholars working in art history modernism and post modernism italian studies and brazilian studies

i offer this black white version so that for all those art enthusiasts who would rather have a book in hand than an electronic e book version almost all color images and representations can also be found on social media see additional sources in the appendix i have been in the arts since i was 6 years old but i did not dare call myself an artist till i was about 35 many artists feel this way art cannot reveal more of its properties and consequently its genuine values because art s concluding evaluation is always tied to success money and fame over 95 of artists lead an existence around the poverty level it is obvious to me we lost our inherent understanding of art s purpose by expanding our awareness just a little we could realize how much we are dependent on our creativity this book shows our way back to art s initial functions for humans by presenting alternatives to the way art works for example art that uses creativity for the joy of creativity s sake trains the inborn human creative muscle to allow us to recognize new observations art reminds us of our strength of what it

means to be human and reflects our human potential a fair value creation model for creativity can only emerge when we gain understanding of the essence of art that governs all the arts we have to start comprehending the function of its patterns its higher aesthetics and the artist s creative voice as assessable parts values by opening our awareness of art the content of this book allows us to gain a new art consciousness that realigns us with our human potential s biggest asset creativity the more i walk on this path toward understanding the essence of art and its functions the more i feel blessed to recognize more of my potential and be human michaell a self aware artist this book is for anyone in the art community and those who are interested in how art works for all that want to know how to become an artist being an artist want to be a better artist how to get better at art or how to become a famous artist
