seal warrior is a vivid action packed account of thomas h keith s vietnam tour of duty a highly decorated navy seal during the vietnam era many of the u s navy seals sea air land commandos never filed for a purple heart unless they were severely wounded thomas h keith master chief seal team 2 is living proof he carries a piece of shrapnel behind one lung a reminder of the day he called in 40 mm mortar fire on the enemy that was trying to catch up to his crew as the crew hauled ass out of the bush not only did he never report it it was never removed it just wasn t serious enough seal warrior is the vivid gritty transporting memoir of a man destined for combat a third generation soldier for whom serving his country was not only an honor it was tradition while his grandfathers fought in france and his father s position as a u s navy chief took him all around the world tom keith fought his first war in the jungles of vietnam fighting a guerilla war on foreign soil for the first time in american history the seals found that there were no front lines the enemy was an integral part of the entire society this atypical form of warfare demanded that new tactics new strategic applications of force and a new understanding of a complex social and cultural enmity be found seal warrior goes beyond the horror and bravado of battle

to offer a deeper insight into the ways in which the seals fought learned reacted and expanded their understanding of guerilla warfare during the vietnam war it s also a personal riveting account of how one young american survived and over time grew to trust and revere many of those who once had been his enemy with america again deeply involved in guerilla warfare there is no better time to honor the unique abilities understanding and courage of these warriors who sacrificed it all to fight for nothing less than peace

few united states citizens conceive of their country as an empire but as the contributors to masters of war convincingly argue the u s legacy of military power runs long and deep often mobilized in the name of spreading democracy maintaining international order and creating the conditions for economic self determination constantly expanding global u s military power is difficult to characterize as anything but an imperialism bent on global domination however at the same time that the u s government hawks rhetoric of human rights and national sovereignty its dominion has begun breeding widespread resistance and opposition likely to make the twenty first century an era marked by sustained and generally unanticipated blowback presenting a wide range of essays by some of the anti war movement s most vocal and incisive critics masters of war reminds us that worldwide economic and military dominance has its price both globally and domestically

together as it drifted toward the shore it looked like a clear oil spill with thousands of drops scattered across the surface of the lake slowly they began to move toward each other and eventually the creature was able to flow off of the surface of the lake and onto dry land on its way it encountered a young terimonian woman and her child playing in the water along the shore without slowing down it washed over them and continued on dragging their screaming bodies ashore in a bloody wake feeding as it went

giulio cesare brancaccio was a neapolitan nobleman with long practical experience of military life first in the service of charles v and later as both soldier and courtier in france and then at the court of alfonso ii d este at ferrara he was also a virtuoso bass singer whose performances were praised by both tasso and guarini he was even for a while the only male member of the famous ferrarese court concerto delle dame who established a legendary reputation during the 1580s richard wistreich examines brancaccio s life in detail and from this it becomes possible to consider the mental and social world of a warrior and courtier with musical skills in a broader context a wide ranging study of bass singing in sixteenth and early seventeenth century italy provides a contextual basis from which to consider brancaccio s reputation as a performer wistreich illustrates the use of music in the process of self fashioning and the role of performance of all kinds in the construction of male noble identity within court culture including the nature and currency of honour chivalric virtù and sixteenth century notions of gender and virility in relation to musical performance this fascinating examination of brancaccio s social world significantly expands our understanding of noble culture in both france and italy during the sixteenth century and the place of music making within it

w e can t come off as a bunch of angry white men robert bennett chairman of the ohio republican party one of the enduring legacies of the 2012 presidential campaign was the demise of the white american male voter as a dominant force in the political landscape on election night after obama was announced the winner a distressed bill o reilly lamented that he didn t live in a traditional america anymore he was joined by others who bellowed their grief on the talk radio airwaves the traditional redoubt of angry white men why were they so angry sociologist michael kimmel one of the leading writers on men and masculinity in the world today has spent hundreds of hours in the company of america s angry white men from white supremacists to men s rights activists to young students in pursuit of an answer angry white men presents a comprehensive diagnosis of their fears anxieties and rage kimmel locates this increase in anger in the seismic economic social and political shifts that have so transformed the american landscape downward mobility increased racial and gender equality and a tenacious clinging to an anachronistic ideology of masculinity has left many men feeling betrayed and bewildered raised to expect unparalleled social and economic privilege white men are suffering today from what kimmel calls aggrieved entitlement a sense that those benefits that white men believed were their due have been snatched away from them angry white men discusses among others the sons of small town america scarred by underemployment and wage stagnation when america s white men feel they ve lived their lives the right way worked hard and stayed out of trouble and still do not get economic rewards then they have to blame somebody else even more terrifying is the phenomenon of angry young boys school shootings in the united states are not just the work of misguided youth or troubled teens they re all committed by boys these alienated young men are transformed into mass murderers by a sense that using violence against others is their right the future of america is more inclusive and diverse the choice for angry white men is not whether or not they can stem the tide of history they cannot their choice is whether or not they will be dragged kicking and screaming into that inevitable future or whether they will walk openly and honorably far happier and healthier incidentally alongside those they ve spent so long trying to exclude

leonardo da vinci niccolò machiavelli and cesare borgia three iconic figures whose intersecting lives provide the basis for this astonishing work of narrative history they could not have been more different and they would meet only for a short time in 1502 but the events that transpired when they did would significantly alter each man's perceptions and the course of western history in 1502 italy was riven by conflict with the city of florence as the ultimate prize machiavelli the consummate political manipulator attempted to placate the savage borgia by volunteering leonardo to be borgia's chief military engineer that autumn the three men embarked together on a brief perilous and fateful journey through the mountains remote villages and hill towns of the italian romagna the details of which were revealed in machiavelli's frequent dispatches and leonardo's meticulous notebooks superbly written and thoroughly researched the artist the philosopher and the warrior is a work of narrative genius whose subject is the nature of genius itself

with the sudden and immature death of the author this work which was planned to comprise 21 volumes has had to end with the 18th from a number of students and art critics requests have reached the publisher and myself that an index should be made of the volumes which have been published herein their desire has been satisfied this general index is divided into two parts one for names of places so that with the greatest ease and without loss of time the student can find all the italian paintings from early christian times up to the end of the quattrocento which are scattered throughout the churches galleries and private collections of europe and america for the larger towns the material is divided into the following headings i churches and monasteries ii public collections iii public buildings and streets iv private collections and this order though not indicated has always been followed for the smaller localities the second division contains the names of artists each one accompanied by dates and where possible an indication of the site of his activity the chief aim of this index is to make it easier to consult the enormous amount of material treated in the 18 volumes for the traveller who desires to know what paintings are to be found in any town this index should be a valuable vade mecum

controversy about women in the military continues yet women's relations with the military go far beyond whether they serve in the ranks gender camouflage brings together a diverse array of authors to explore the controversy surrounding women's military service to examine the invisibility of civilian women who support the institution and to expose the military's efforts to camouflage their support and contributions contributors first consider nurses servicewomen military academy students female veterans and lesbians the focus then shifts to military wives women employed by the DoD and female civilian military instructors whose work is less visible but no less essential to the institution the book also examines the experiences of women outside of the military such as comfort women near U.S. bases women engaged in peace work and women workers affected by military spending in the federal budget analytic chapters are juxtaposed with first person narratives by women who have actually been there including a member of the first gender integrated class at West Point the first female civilian instructors at the U.S. Naval Academy and an African American Air Force Nurse Corps veteran contributors include Connie Reeves Georgia Clark Sadler Gwyn Kirk and Joan Furey
