use and abuse of history has become a key text of current historiography this is a book that poses fundamental and disturbing questions about the use and abuse of history engaging and challenging this book confronts the reader with the many histories that exist and have existed around the world from the zulu kingdoms to communist china this title has now been extensively revised by marc ferro a well respected historian and presents the different narratives that constitute the histories of countries as diverse as india iran trinidad and the united states makes for fascinating reading in their own right what makes this book so valuable though is what these narratives tell us about the societies which create them how much is history distorted in order to condition the minds of those who are taught it use and abuse of history appeals to anyone with a general interest in history

part history part political analysis and part memoir mexifornia is an intensely personal work by one of our most important writers victor davis hanson known for his military histories and his social commentary is a fifth generation californian who lives on a family farm in the central valley and has written eloquent elegies on the decline of agrarianism fields without dreams and the land was everything here too he ponders what has changed in california over the past quarter century examining how the state and the southwest more broadly indeed the entire nation have been altered by hemorrhaging borders hanson admires the ambition and vigor of immigrants who have helped make california strong but he indicts the disordered immigration policies that led to the present mess he also illuminates the ways those policies are harmful to people who have come from mexico and central america seeking a better life in the united states nearly twenty years after the first publication of mexifornia hanson offers an update on the continuing tragedy of illegal immigration at the same time he remains hopeful that our traditions of integration assimilation and intermarriage may yet remedy a predicament created by politicians and ideologues

first published in 1998 writing about chicano professionals in los angeles proves timely for many reasons anthropologists now venture into the ethnic borderlands of their own western countries rather than encroach on the flexing ethnicities of the third world as they have traditionally done the story of this ethnic elite begins in the 1960 s and 1970 s when mexican american students from blue collar backgrounds first entered california colleges and universities in significant numbers this generation of mexican american students is important however not merely for its increased numbers but rather for the culture it
