after all the green beer has been poured and the ubiquitous shamrocks fade away what does it mean to be irish american besides st patrick s day who s your paddy traces the evolution of irish as a race based identity in the u s from the 19th century to the present day exploring how the irish have been and continue to be socialized around race jennifer nugent duffy argues that irish identity must be understood within the context of generational tensions between different waves of irish immigrants as well as the irish community s interaction with other racial minorities using historic and ethnographic research duffy sifts through the many racial class and gendered dimensions of irish american identity by examining three distinct irish cohorts in greater new york assimilated descendants of nineteenth century immigrants white flighters who immigrated to postwar america and fled places like the bronx for white suburbs like yonkers in the 1960s and 1970s and the newer largely undocumented migrants who began to arrive in the 1990s what results is a portrait of irishness as a dynamic complex force in the history of american racial consciousness pertinent not only to contemporary immigration debates but also to the larger questions of what it means to belong what it means to be american

this volume of ten essays discusses the pivotal role that letters have played in social economic and political history from the seventeenth to the twentieth century the recent scholarly interest in the history of reading has as yet yielded few studies which consider letters as a category of readable material the contributors to this book seek to redress this oversight viewing letters as texts which can reveal information not only about their writers and readers but about the wider historical context in which they were written

topics covered include the mercantile letter diplomatic correspondence and what these epistolary forms suggest about the rise of a polite literate culture in the eighteenth century the experience of immigration from europe to america during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries the relationship through the letter and the working of gender in the epistolary form rebecca earle provides an overview of how the study of letter writing can open up new avenues of historical as well as literary investigation this together with contributions from leading international scholars makes epistolary selves an essential text for those researching the letter genre

the migrant letter whether written by family members lovers friends or others is a document that continues to attract the attention of scholars and general readers alike what is it about migrant letters that fascinates us is it nostalgia for a distant yet desired past is it the consequence of the eclipse of letter writing in an age of digital communication technologies or is it about the parallels between transnational experiences in previous mass migrations and in the current globalized world and the centrality of interpersonal relations mobility and communication then and now influenced by methodologies from diverse disciplines the study of migrant letters has developed in myriad directions scholars have examined migrant letters through such lenses as identity and self making family relations gender and emotions this volume contributes to this discussion by exploring the connection between the practice of letter writing and the emotional economic familial and gendered experiences of men and women separated by migration it combines theoretical and empirical discussions which illuminate a variety of historical experiences of migrants who built transnational lives as they moved across europe africa latin america and the united states this volume was originally published as a special issue of the history of family

why have british and north american governments adopted illiberal social policies during this century in the name of liberalism investigates examples of social policy in britain and the united states that conflict with liberal democratic ideals the book examines the use of eugenic arguments in the 1920s and 1930s the use of work camps in the 1930s as a response to mass unemployment and the introduction of work for welfare programs since the 1980s the book argues that existing accounts of american and british political development neglect how illiberal social policies are intertwined in the creation of modern liberal democratic institutions such policies are paradoxically justified in terms of the liberal democratic framework itself in the light of the books research the author suggests that there is a need to know more about the internal workings of democracies to justify the claim that liberal democracy represents the most attractive set of political institutions

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
