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the middle ages provide us with one of the richest repositories of art in the west yet the rise in the production of art made for and by jews especially in the form of illuminated manuscripts is often neglected in general surveys or viewed as a mere emulation of christian art during this period in people of the image marc michael epstein demonstrates how medieval jews transformed their visual art into a vital site of critical commentary through bold speculation and radical interpretation epstein considers how viewers might have empathized with depicted emotions how they envisioned the relationship between the monstrous and the human and how they could effectively perpetrate subversive acts merely by anticipating what might occur next in a given image were it to be set in motion examining these artworks and imagining the circumstances of their production and reception epstein uncovers otherwise inaccessible social political and theological perceptions among europe s major medieval minority he goes on to illuminate the afterlives of medieval jewish art in its reimaginings by postmodern jews struggling to establish a conceptual as well as a political space for themselves as a minority in majority christian society bringing together diverse currents from various fields and bodies of literature people of the image reveals how medieval jews understood themselves the world and god provocative and engagingly written the book will appeal to audiences across medieval studies cultural studies art history and jewish studies

stephens sees in video s complexities simultaneities and juxtapositions new ways of understanding and perhaps even surmounting the tumult and confusions of contemporary life

this book explores the persona of the artist in archaic and classical greek art and literature guy hedreen argues that artistic subjectivity first expressed in athenian vase painting of the sixth century bce and intensively explored by euphronios developed alongside a self consciously constructed persona of the poet he explains how poets like archilochos and hipponax identified with the wily homeric character of odysseus as a prototype of the successful narrator and how the lame yet resourceful artist god hephaistos is emulated by archaic vase painters such as kleitias in lyric poetry and pictorial art hedreen traces a widespread conception of the artist or poet as socially marginal sometimes physically imperfect but rhetorically clever technically peerless and a master of fiction bringing together in a sustained analysis the roots of subjectivity across media this book offers a new way of studying the relationship between poetry and art in ancient greece

all religions make statements about god or the absolute and about the beginning about the beginning of the world and the beginning and nature of the human person propositions about god the human person and the world statements about god s eternity or process of becoming about the status and nature of the human person as the image of god and about the beginning of the world are woven into religious speculations about the beginning the theology anthropology and cosmology of the world religions determine the image of the human person and the image of the world in the world cultures shaped by the different religions they stand in a tense relationship with the anthropologies and cosmologies of modern science which in turn challenge the religions to deepen their image of the human person with this volume leading thinkers of hinduism buddhism judaism christianity and islam provide the reader with a first hand source for understanding the five world religions and their teaching about god the human person and the origin of the world

this book discusses the significance of cultural symbols images in the nation building of eurasian states that emerged out of the former soviet union it particularly focuses on the cases of uzbekistan and kazakhstan in the post soviet era and argues that the relationship between nation and image building has been particularly relevant for eurasian states in an increasingly globalized world nation state building is no longer an activity confined to the domestic arena the situating of the state within the global space and its image in the international community nation branding becomes in many ways as crucial as the projection of homogeneity within the state the relationship between politics and cultural symbols images therefore acquires and represents multiple possibilities it is these possibilities that are the focus of symbols and the image of the state in eurasia it argues that the relationship between politics and cultural symbols images became particularly relevant for states that emerged in the wake of the disintegration of the soviet union in central asia it extends the argument further to contend that the image that the state projects is largely determined by its legacy and it attempts to do this by taking into account the uzbek and kazakh cases in the shaping of the post soviet future these legacies and projections

as well as the policy implications of these projections in terms of governmentality and foreign policy have been decisive

la celestina a spanish literary masterpiece second only in importance to don quixote in spanish literature has been shaped by the inclusion of images from its very first edition in 1499 the subsequent five centuries were punctuated by many illustrated editions imaginary portraits of the eponymous procuress celestina by painters such as murillo goya and picasso and more recently screen and stage adaptations celestina became the prototype from which later representations of procuresses and bawds derived the image of celestina sheds light on the visual culture that developed around la celestina including paintings illustrations and advertisements enrique fernández examines la celestina as a mixed media text incorporating methods from disciplines such as art history and women s and cinema studies and considers a variety of images including promotional posters lobby pictures and playbills of theatrical and cinematic adaptations of the book using a visual studies approach the image of celestina ultimately illuminates the culture of celestina a mythical figure who surpasses the literary text in which she originated

heinrich wölfflin 1864 1945 who represents a step toward an understanding of consciousness by using pictures as cognitive tools konrad fiedler 1841 1895 the saxon philosopher who considered the possibility that some kinds of images are made and viewed not for what they show but for their visibility's sake alone maurice merleau ponty 1908 1961 responsible for taking up the connections between the problems of reducing the range of potential meanings and contexts of a given image down to just the picture surface charles william morris 1901 1979 who set out to establish whether a picture with no objective reference such as an abstract painting still counts as a sign and if so in what sense bringing these thinkers together and interlinking their ideas lambert Wiesing presents an engaging history of formal aesthetics while reconstructing the philosophical foundations for the appearance of new image forms in the 20th century including the video clip abstract collage digital simulation and virtual reality using this original approach the visibility of the image introduces the rise of modern image theory and provides a valuable account of our engagement with pictures in the 21st century
