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this work is a revealing chronicle of hip hop culture from its beginnings three decades ago to the present with an analysis of its influence on people and popular culture in the united states and around the world from grandmaster flash and the furious five s the message to jay z diddy and 50 cent hip hop culture is the first comprehensive reference work to focus on one of the most influential cultural phenomena of our time scholarly and streetwise backed by statistics documents and research it recounts three decades of hip hop s evolution highlighting its defining events recordings personalities movements and ideas as well as society s response how did an inner city subculture all but dismissed in the early 1980s become the ruler of the world s airwaves and ipods who are the players who moved hip hop from the record bins to the pinnacles of entertainment business and fashion who are the founders innovators legends and major players authoritative and authentic hip hop culture provides a wealth of information and insights for students educators and anyone interested in the ways pop culture reflects and shapes our lives

performing identity performing culture hip hop as text pedagogy and lived practice is the first book length ethnography of young people and their uses of hip hop culture originally published in 2001 this second edition is newly revised expanded and updated to reflect contemporary currents in hip hop culture and critical scholarship as well as the epochal social cultural and economic shifts of the last decade drawing together historical work on hip hop and rap music as well as four years of research at a local community center greg dimitriadis argues here that contemporary youth are fashioning notions of self and community outside of school in ways educators have largely ignored his studies are broad ranging how two teenagers constructed notions of a southern tradition through their use of southern rap artists like eightball mjjg and three 6 mafia how young people constructed notions of history through viewing the film panther a film they connected to hip hop

culture more broadly and how young people dealt with the life and death of hip hop icon tupac shakur constructing resurrection myths that still resonate and circulate today

essays examining the impact of hip hop music on pop culture and youth identity in post soviet central and eastern europe responding to the development of a lively hip hop culture in central and eastern european countries this interdisciplinary study demonstrates how a universal model of hip hop serves as a contextually situated platform of cultural exchange and becomes locally inflected after the soviet union fell hip hop became popular in urban environments in the region but it has often been stigmatized as inauthentic due to an apparent lack of connection to african american historical roots and black identity originally strongly influenced by aesthetics from the united states hip hop in central and eastern europe has gradually developed unique local trajectories a number of which are showcased in this volume on the one hand hip hop functions as a marker of western cosmopolitanism and democratic ideology but as the contributors show it is also a malleable genre that has been infused with so much local identity that it has lost most of its previous associations with the west in the experiences of local musicians audiences and producers contextualizing hip hop through the prism of local experiences and regional musical expressions these valuable case studies reveal the broad spectrum of its impact on popular culture and youth identity in the post soviet world the volume represents a valuable and timely contribution to the study of popular culture in central and eastern europe hip hop at europe s edge will not only appeal to readers interested in contemporary popular culture in central and eastern europe but also inspire future research on post socialism s unique local adaptations of global cultural trends the soviet and post soviet review the authors of this edited volume do not romanticize and heroize the genre by automatically equating it with political opposition a fate often suffered by rock before instead the book has to be given much credit for presenting a very nuanced picture of hip hop s entanglement or non entanglement for that matter with politics in this wide stretch of the world past and present the russian review

throughout the 1950s and 1960s the black church stood as the stronghold of the black community fighting for equality and economic self sufficiency and challenging its body to be self determined and self aware hip hop culture grew from disenfranchised urban youth who felt that they had no support system or resources impassioned with the same urgent desires for survival and hope that their parents and grandparents had carried these youth forged their way from the bottom of america s belly one rhyme at a time for many young people hip hop culture is a supplement or even an alternative to the weekly dose of sunday morning faith in this collection of provocative essays leading thinkers preachers and scholars from around the country confront both the black church and the hip hop generation to realize their shared responsibilities to one another and the greater society arranged into three sections this volume addresses key issues in the debate between two of the most significant institutions of black culture the first part from civil rights to hip hop explores the transition from one generation to another through the transmission or lack thereof of legacy and heritage part ii hip hop culture and the black church in dialogue explores the numerous ways in which the conversation is already occurring from sermons to theoretical examinations and spiritual ponderings part iii gospel rap holy hip hop and the hip hop matrix clarifies the perspectives and insights of practitioners scholars and activists who explore various expressions of faith and the diversity of locations where these expressions take place in the black church and hip hop culture pastors ministers theologians educators and laypersons wrestle with the duties of providing timely commentary critical analysis and in some cases practical strategies toward forgiveness healing restoration and reconciliation with inspiring reflections and

empowering discourse this collection demonstrates why and how the black church must re engage in the lives of those who comprise the hip hop generation

hip hop culture is experiencing a sea change today that has implications for evangelism worship and spiritual practices yet christians have often failed to interpret this culture with sensitivity sociologist preacher pop culture expert and dj ralph watkins understands that while there is room for a critique of mainstream hip hop and culture by listening more intently to the music s story listeners can hear a prophet crying out sharing the pain of a generation that feels as though it hasn t been heard his accessible balanced engagement reveals what is inherently good and redeeming in hip hop and rap music and uses that culture as a lens to open up the power of the bible for ministry to a generation

visual art has been tied to hip hop culture since its emergence in the 1970s commentary on these initial connections often emphasizes the importance of graffiti and fashion during hip hop s earliest days forty years later hip hop music has grown into a billion dollar global industry and its influence on visual art and society has also expanded this book length printed edition of arts collects essays by scholars who explore this evolving influence through their work in art education cultural theory and visual culture studies the topics covered by these authors include discussions on identity and cultural appropriation equity and access as represented in select works of art creativity and copyright in digital media and the use of fine art tropes within the sociocultural history of hip hop as a collected volume these essays make potentially important contributions to broadening the narrative on art education and hip hop beyond the topics of graffiti fashion and the use of cyphers in educational contexts

college campuses have become rich sites of hip hop culture and knowledge production despite the attention that campus personnel and researchers have paid to student life the field of higher education has often misunderstood the ways that hip hop culture exists in college students lives based upon in depth interviews observations of underground hip hop spaces and the author s own active roles in hop hop communities this book provides a rich portrait of how college students who create hip hop both male and female and of multiple ethnicities embody its principles and aesthetics on campuses across the united states the book looks beyond rap music school curricula and urban adolescents to make the empirical argument that hip hop has a deep cultural logic habits of mind and worldview components that students apply to teaching learning and living on campus hip hop culture in college students lives provides critical insights for researchers and campus personnel working with college students while pushing cultural observers to rethink the basic ways that people live hip hop

in the world of hip hop keeping it real has always been a primary goal and realness takes on special meaning as rappers mold their images for street cred and increasingly measure authenticity by ghetto centric notions of who s badder in this groundbreaking book jeffrey o g ogbar celebrates hip hop and confronts the cult of authenticity that defines its essential character that dictates how performers walk talk and express themselves artistically and also influences the consumer market hip hop revolution is a balanced cultural history that looks past negative stereotypes of hip hop as a monolith of hedonistic unthinking noise to reveal its evolving positive role within american society a writer who s personally encountered many of hip hop s icons ogbar traces hip hop s rise as a cultural juggernaut focusing on how it negotiates its own sense of identity he especially explores the lyrical world of rap as artists struggle to define what realness means in an art

where class race and gender are central to expressions of authenticity and how this realness is articulated in a society dominated by gendered and racialized stereotypes ogbar also explores problematic black images including minstrelsy hip hop s social milieu and the artists own historical and political awareness ranging across the rap spectrum from the conscious hip hop of mos def to the gangsta rap of 50 cent to the underground sounds of jurassic 5 and the roots he tracks the ongoing quest for a unique and credible voice to show how complex contested and malleable these codes of authenticity are most important ogbar persuasively challenges widely held notions that hip hop is socially dangerous to black youths in particular by addressing the ways in which rappers critically view the popularity of crime focused lyrics the antisocial messages of their peers and the volatile politics of the word nigga hip hop revolution deftly balances an insider s love of the culture with a scholar s detached critique exploring popular myths about black educational attainment civic engagement crime and sexuality by cutting to the bone of a lifestyle that many outsiders find threatening ogbar makes hip hop realer than it s ever been before
