across the british empire and the world the 1920s and 1930s were a time of unprecedented social and cultural change girls and young women were at the heart of many of these shifts which included the aftermath of the first world war the enfranchisement of women and the rise of the flapper or modern girl out of this milieu the girl guide movement emerged as a response to popular concerns about age gender race class and social instability the british based guide movement attracted more than a million members in over forty countries during the interwar years its success however was neither simple nor straightforward using an innovative multi sited approach kristine alexander digs deeper to analyze the ways in which guiding sought to mold young people in england canada and india she weaves together a fascinating account that connects the histories of girlhood internationalism and empire while asking how girls and young women understood and responded to guiding's attempts to lead them toward a service oriented useful feminine future

hospitalized for months at a time for each of six corrective surgeries at the newly opened shriners hospital for crippled children in winnipeg in these days before medicare carol was fortunate that this state of the art hospital offered free medical support to families in financial need carol takes us through a frightening and lonely childhood into an adulthood thought to be cured of the deadly disease and its after effects but had the experience coloured her adult life her marriage and her career or had the after effects of polio helped her her last challenge was the diagnosis of post polio syndrome despite her medical trials carol s memoir is one of hope with frank insights into the challenges of pps this book offers the possibility of managing it successfully through careful exercise a determination to never give up and a positive attitude polio child will prove an invaluable resource for those living with or care giving for someone with post polio syndrome or other disabilities

when eight year old amy erdman farrell moved with her family to akron ohio in 1972 she found herself adrift in a sea of taunting boys and mean girls shy by nature she dreaded her long unhappy days at school but a few years later farrell found an escape from bullying the promise of sisterhood a rising sense of confidence adventure and best of all lifelong friendship when she joined a girl scout troop decades later award winning author farrell returns to those formative experiences to explore the complicated and surprising history of the girl scouts of the usa drawing from extensive archival research visits to iconic girl scout sites around the world and vivid personal reflections farrell uncovers the girl scouts intricate history revealing how the organization has shaped the lives of more than 50 million girls and women since its founding in 1912 with farrell as our own intrepid guide we travel to american indian boarding schools japanese american incarceration centers segregated african american communities middle class white neighborhoods and outposts throughout the globe intrepid girls unpacks how the girl scouts navigated tensions over feminism race class and political differences carving out extraordinary opportunities for girls and women even as it participated in the very discrimination it promised to transcend for anyone who has ever worn a uniform or wondered about the hidden history behind this iconic american institution intrepid girls will surprise inspire and challenge what we think we know about the girl scouts

american girls and global responsibility brings together insights from cold war culture studies girls studies and the history of gender and militarization to shed new light on how age and gender work together to form categories of citizenship jennifer helgren argues that a new internationalist girl citizenship took root in the country in the years following world war ii in youth organizations such as camp fire girls girl scouts ywca y teens schools and even magazines like seventeen she shows the particular ways that girls

identities and roles were configured and reveals the links between internationalist youth culture mainstream u s educational goals and the u s government in creating and marketing that internationalist girl thus shaping the girls sense of responsibilities as citizens

arising in the first decades of the twentieth century the boy scout and girl guide movements came into existence in britain in an era of social and political unrest and were initially the center of intense controversy through the years guiding and scouting broke down class race and gender distinctions and helped youth cope with an emerging mass culture and allowed boys and girls to stretch gender and generational boundaries using official documents logbooks diaries and oral histories tammy proctor explores the formation of the scouts and guides and their transformation during and after world war i the interwar period marked a departure for the two organizations as they emerged as large multinational organizations that

targeted not only adolescents but also smaller children and young adults
