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in bounded wilderness kathryn jasper focuses on the innovations undertaken at the hermitage
of fonte avellana in central italy during the eleventh century by its prior peter damian d 1072

the congregation of fonte avellana experimented with reforming practices that led to new ways of managing property and relations among clergy nobles and the laity jasper charts how damian s notion of monastic reform took advantage of the surrounding topography and geography to amplify the sensory aspects of ascetic experiences by focusing on monastic landscapes and land ownership jasper demonstrates that reform extended beyond abstract ideas rather reform circulated locally through monastic networks and addressed practical concerns such as property boundaries and rights over water orchards pastures and mills putting new sources both documentary and archaeological into conversation with monastic charters and damian s letters bounded wilderness reveals the interrelationship of economic practices religious traditions and the natural environment in the idea and implementation of reform

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a riveting account of the conquest of the vast american heartland that offers a vital reconsideration of the relationship between native americans and european colonists and the pivotal role of the mighty mississippi america s waterways were once the superhighways of travel and communication cutting a central line across the landscape with tributaries connecting the south to the great plains and the great lakes the mississippi river meant wealth knowledge and power for those who could master it in this ambitious and elegantly written account of the conquest of the west jacob lee offers a new understanding of early america based on the long history of warfare and resistance in the mississippi river valley lee traces the native kinship ties that determined which nations rose and fell in the period before the illinois became dominant with a complex network of allies stretching from lake superior to arkansas the illinois were at the height of their power in 1673 when the first french explorers fur trader louis jolliet and jesuit priest jacques marquette made their way down the mississippi over the next century a succession of european empires claimed parts of the midcontinent but they all faced the challenge of navigating native alliances and social structures that had existed for centuries when american settlers claimed the region in the early nineteenth century they overturned 150 years of interaction between indians and europeans masters of the middle waters shows that the mississippi and its tributaries were never simply a backdrop to unfolding

events we cannot understand the trajectory of early america without taking into account the vast heartland and its waterways which advanced and thwarted the aspirations of native nations european imperialists and american settlers alike

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between 2007 and 2012 the department for underwater archaeology of the croatian

conservation institute from zagreb and the department of humanistic studies of the ca foscari university of venice collaborated in the recording underwater excavation and analysis of the unusually well preserved wreck of a 16th century venetian merchantman in the svetti pavao shallow off the southern shore of the island of mljet croatia the shipwreck preserved many personal possessions of the crew as well as a number of bronze artillery pieces and the remains of a cargo of luxury and richly decorated ceramic material from iznik and other oriental workshops although the excavation is not complete this volume presents the results of the project so far the methodological and technical aspects of the underwater investigation of the site mainly by photogrammetry are described the historical and archaeological context of navigation in the late medieval period in the eastern mediterranean discussed and the recovered artefacts described and catalogued in detail together with the remains of the ship and its equipment that because of depth and of problems of conservation have been left in situ the conservation and restoration of the finds are described in an appendix
