this book offers a new approach to the use of linguistic data to reconstruct prehistory the author shows how a well studied language family in this case uto aztecan can be used as an instrument for reconstructing prehistory the main focus of shaul s work is the mapping of uto aztecan by presenting various models of uto aztecan prehistory by assessing multiple models simultaneously and by guiding readers through areas where the evidence is not so clear shaul helps nonspecialists develop the tools needed for evaluating various historical linguistics models themselves he evaluates both archaeological and genetic evidence as well placing it carefully alongside the linguistic evidence he knows best shaul s thorough treatment provides many new avenues for future research on the historical anthropology of western north america

for the same reasons that explorers of the early twentieth century strove to reach the poles and their modern counterparts journey to outer space most people want to visualize the contours of the human experience the peaks of adaptive success that led to the expansion of civilization and the troughs in which human presence ebbed the backbone of history defines the emerging field of macrobioarchaeology by gathering skeletal evidence on seven basic indicators of health to assess chronic conditions that affected individuals who lived in the western hemisphere from 5000 bc to the late nineteenth century signs of biological stress in childhood and of degeneration in joints and in teeth increased in the several millennia before the arrival of columbus as populations moved into less healthy ecological environments thus pre colombian native americans were among the healthiest and the least healthy groups to live in the western hemisphere before the twentieth century

taking a bioarchaeological approach this book examines the ancestral pueblo culture living in the four corners region of the united states during the late pueblo i through the end of the pueblo iii period ad 850 1300 during this time a vast system of pueblo villages spread throughout the region creating what has been called the chaco phenomenon named after the large great houses in chaco canyon that are thought to have been centers of control through a bioarchaeological analysis of the human skeletal remains this volume provides evidence that key individuals within the hierarchical social structure used a variety of methods of social control including structural violence to maintain their power over the interconnected communities

pueblo bonito is the largest and most famous ruin in new mexico s chaco culture national historical park built by the ancestral puebloan people some 1 000 years ago the ruin testifies to one of the oldest and most complex societies ever discovered in north america study of the large corpus of data continues to generate new ideas about the people who lived their and

their way of life this extensively illustrated volume commemorates the recent centennial of the first large scale excavations at pueblo bonito with leading experts writing on various aspects of the site including its setting construction sequence and labor requirements possible astronomical orientations and related rituals and burials the book probes deeply for answers to these and other perplexing questions about pueblo bonito and its people

archaeologists use the artifacts and fauna they found to examine the lives and activities of the inhabitants of pueblo bonito as well as to further interpret current models of chaco archaeology

the archaeological remnants of the first americans tell a story of advanced civilization and culture from the pueblo dwellings of the southwest to the buffalo jumps of the great plains to the coastal villages of the northwest the author combines the latest field research with accounts of tribal life to offer a new perspective on native american history culture and ritual using a chronological and regional framework thomas describes each of the prehistoric early native cultures including paleoindians of the north the moundbuilding mississippian cultures and the ancient anasazi peoples of the southwest covering nine million square miles and 25 000 years exploring ancient native america suggests more than four hundred accessible sites where individuals can observe the remains of prehistoric american cultures today thomas also includes relevant contributions from native american scholars poets and activists on topics such as language oral tradition contact and sacred sites the most comprehensive guide available exploring ancient native america is an excellent primer on early native american cultures in every region of the country for both the intrepid explorer and the armchair traveler

michael e whalen and paul e minnis have worked extensively in the casas grandes area and now offer new research arguing that it was not as similar to the highly developed complex societies of mesoamerica as has been thought in the first book of its kind in 25 years the authors analyze settlement pattern data from more than 300 communities in the area surrounding casas grandes to show that its medio period culture was a local development book jacket

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
