rooted in everyday communities the voice of say it with me is wry candid and knowing offering poems that playfully record the foibles of domestic life there are curious stories a parrot flies away but always returns to its master a school bully becomes their victim s acupuncture patient in adulthood and a donor finds new kinship with the woman who
