interactions between the atmosphere land and water and the snowballing impact that human activity is having on the systemâ and presents perspectives on policies and programs that can both develop and protect our natural resources one earth one future discusses why such seemingly diverse issues as historical climate change species diversity and sea level rise are part of a single pictureâ and how human activity is the critical element in that picture the book concludes with practical examinations of economic security and development questions with a view toward achieving improvements in quality of life without further environmental degradation one earth one future is must reading for anyone interested in the interrelationship of environmental matters and public policy issues

originally published in 1987 this book showcases global examples of people and communities who are learning to use the world s resources without despoiling them for future generations it includes chapters on nomadic life in kenya food supply in a peruvian shantytown and a buddhist monk in sri lanka who advises about tree planting and watersheds amidst climate change and environmental destruction this book looks at the world through the eyes of the people who tend it and finds hope in their growing understanding of their environment and in their willingness to live within the earth s resources

forty years after the united nations conference on the human environment in stockholm the goal of sustainable development continues via the rio 20 conference in 2012 this book will enable a broad readership to understand what has been achieved in the past forty years and what hasn t it

shows the continuing threat of our present way of living to the planet it looks to the challenges that we face twenty years from the united nations conference on environment and development the earth summit in rio in particular in the areas of economics and governance and the role of stakeholders it puts forward a set of recommendations that the international community must address now and in the future it reminds us of the planetary boundaries we must all live within and what needs to be addressed in the next twenty years for democracy equity and fairness to survive finally it proposes through the survival agenda a bare minimum of what needs to be done arguing for a series of absolute minimum policy changes we need to move forward

in 2025 humanity finds itself at one of the most chaotic unstable and dangerous times since the end of world war ii the global governance structures created some 80 years ago rather prematurely proclaimed to have defeated fascism under the aegis of the united nations and the un charter these structures have been fundamental in preventing another global conflict and have facilitated immense developmental strides reductions in extreme poverty and unprecedented improvements in health and education however as is evidenced from current political and social events across the world the foundations on which the international order have been built are in crisis whether the emergence of authoritarian governments the dramatic and worsening economic inequality within and between nations or the rapidly worsening effects of climate change the present structures of global governance and the very elements of which this system is built nation states are proving incapable of structurally addressing the challenges facing the people of the world this timely book explores some of the attributes of a new political vision that shifts from today's world of nation states towards a democratic global polity comprised of world citizens it goes beyond addressing philosophical issues and examines a range of practical and innovative proposals including global voting through smartphones setting universal quality control criteria for aspiring politicians the establishment of a world parliament the creation of an official status of world citizen and many other related themes one earth one politics provides a series of concrete measures that can realistically be put into place to unify our world into a single democratic and equitable polity a process the authors believe will be vital if our civilization is to successfully navigate the global challenges of climate change and other existential threats

poor people in the south have every reason to protect their own environment they depend on it more directly than the rich and are more immediately affected by its destruction or deterioration yet in many places they are powerless to defend or improve it with full color case studies which draw on oxfam's experience one earth two worlds looks at environmental issues from the point of view of poor people what are the

pressures on the environment in the south what are people doing to solve their own problems are we in the north part of the problem or part of the solution

we have only one earth and how we choose to live in it matters this highly readable and challenging text sets out some important topical issues that tells us we are not making a very good job of it from the tropical rainforests to the teeming cities of the developing world and the energy hungry nations of europe and north america one world for one earth shows that many of today s environmental problems can only be understood in terms of both the physical and the social processes involved at present we are in a vicious circle uneven development creates problems of affluence in some areas and problems of poverty in others in both the environment suffers independent local action has a crucial part to play but to be really effective sustainable development needs a new context which can only be put in place by international government co operation this book by going beyond the conventional accounts of environmental problems provides a basis for action originally published in 1991

arthur walker jones presents an earth focused reading of the second book of psalms focusing upon the many nonhuman animals that appear

repeatedly within the text in the first commentary to explore the implications of the natural and cultural history of animals for the interpretation of psalms walker jones moves beyond the standard treatment of animals as mere metaphors for human concerns or background to human stories instead walker jones draws upon the interdisciplinary field of animal studies incorporating this into ecocritical analysis and arguing for the similarity between the two approaches including recognizing that the oppression and liberation of humans is interrelated with the oppression and liberation of earth and all its creatures walker jones looks at foxes sheep goats cattle doves snakes lions snails dogs and deer which all appear in psalms 42 72 taking into account that many of these animals co evolved with humans and created the particular ecological niche of the highlands east of the mediterranean perceiving earth in various ways as refuge as enemy as rock and as fertile and joyous this volume brings an entirely new ecological perspective to the psalms
