longlist 2023 edwards book award rodel institute from nineteenth century abolitionism to black lives matter today progressive social movements have been at the forefront of social change yet it is seldom recognized that such movements have not only engaged in political action but also posed crucial philosophical questions about the meaning of justice and about how the demands of justice can be met michele moody adams argues that anyone who is concerned with the theory or the practice of justice or both must ask what can be learned from social movements drawing on a range of compelling examples she explores what they have shown about the nature of justice as well as what it takes to create space for justice in the world moody adams considers progressive social movements as

wellsprings of moral inquiry and as agents of social change drawing out key philosophical and practical principles social justice demands humane regard for others combining compassionate concern and robust respect successful movements have drawn on the transformative power of imagination strengthening the motivation to pursue justice and to create the political institutions and social policies that can sustain it by inspiring political hope making space for justice contends that the insights arising from social movements are critical to bridging the gap between discerning theory and effective practice and should be transformative for political thought as well as for political activism

we've come to view love as being nice yet the kind of love modeled by Jesus Christ has nothing to do with manners or unconditional acceptance rather it is disruptive courageous and socially unacceptable in bold love Dr Dan Allender and Dr Tremper Longman III draw out the aggressive unrelenting passionate power of genuine love far from helping you get along with others bold love introduces the outlandish possibility of making a significant life-changing impact on family friends coworkers even your enemies learn more about forgiveness maturity and seeing others through Jesus eyes

this book examines the growing transgender rights movement and the issues surrounding the transgender community discussion of topics related to increased legal protection military service and the many ethical as well as financial issues surrounding health care it includes primary and secondary sources from a variety of perspectives eyewitnesses scientific journals government officials and many others an extensive bibliography and annotated list of relevant organizations to contact offer a gateway to future research

this book challenges the assumption that self-interest is the basis of our actions it does so through examining two Platonic characters Thrasymachus in Plato's Republic and Callicles in Plato's Gorgias both of whom attack justice and champion thoroughgoing selfishness the author argues that by following the subtleties of Plato's presentation we see that both characters unwittingly display a kind of devotion to their selfish principles and more broadly a combination of contempt for justice and unselfconscious attachment to it they thereby offer surprising support for the proposition that human beings are not simply self-interested moreover the author argues that the attachment to justice that Thrasymachus and Callicles display is in many respects akin to the attachment to justice that most people feel the book also presents a distinctive approach to reading Platonic dialogues taking questionable arguments offered by Socrates not as indicating his or Plato's views nor as tricks by which Socrates refutes his interlocutors but as revealing beliefs held by those interlocutors finally the author considers tough guys portrayed by Dostoevsky Gide and Shakespeare and finds that these portrayals suggest similar conclusions regarding self-interest and attachment to justice

calls on Christians in the Western world to follow Christ more fully and focus on more than personal piety by engaging in the cause of global justice

the spirit of the reformation is often expressed in the well known slogan that reformed churches are always being reformed according to god s word *ecclesia reformata semper reformanda secundum verbum dei* over the last century the spirit of this slogan motivated someone like dietrich bonhoeffer to argue that the visible form and life of the church should reflect the truth and message of the church already in his doctoral dissertation called *sanctorum communio* the communion of the saints the young bonhoeffer combined theological claims and traditions with social theory and analysis in this spirit in an innovative way to study the nature and integrity and witness of the church at the time this was a radical claim with major consequences and challenges for protestant churches their life which meant their order structure actions statements convictions public presence and role was to be measured by their gospel which meant their message proclamation convictions claims they could no longer proclaim one truth yet live a different life it was this spirit which led to the well known theological declaration of barmen in 1934 and to the formation of the confessing church in nazi germany many called this a moment of truth a *status confessionis* it was this same spirit which later inspired the struggle in south africa for the integrity and faithfulness of the church and for the credibility of its message proclamation and witness the contributions in this volume 52 papers essays sermons studies were all produced in this spirit most of them have not been published before they were all occasional pieces written over several decades in different contexts and for different purposes and audiences yet they all breathe this self critical spirit of the reformation considering whether the real church the concrete every day actual living church that people know and experience and perhaps belong to truly strives to embody the gospel itself the message which it claims and proclaims they all inquire under different circumstances and in diverse ways about different social forms of the real church from worship to congregation from denomination to ecumenical church from individual believers to movements and organisations whether and how they embody the truth of the church or not together these contributions tell a story the story of this spirit in south african circles over several decades but also in the ecumenical church in our globalizing world they offer one small glimpse into different concrete moments in the story of this spirit in the life of this tradition and community of faith hopefully some of these accounts may resonate with others who also shared the same spirit and still share it today in new and ongoing ways

this study evaluates whether surprise and intelligence failure leading to mass casualty terrorism are inevitable it explores the extent to which four factors failures of public policy leadership analytical challenges organizational obstacles and the inherent problems of warning information contribute to intelligence failure the study applies existing theories of surprise and intelligence failure to case studies of five mass casualty terrorism incidents world trade center 1993 oklahoma city 1995 khobar towers 1996 east african embassies 1998 and september 11 2001 a structured focused comparison of the cases is made using a set of thirteen probing questions based on the factors above the study concludes that while all four factors were influential failures of public policy leadership contributed directly to surprise psychological bias and poor threat assessments prohibited policy makers from anticipating or preventing attacks policy makers mistakenly continued to use a law enforcement approach to handling terrorism and failed to provide adequate funding guidance and oversight of the intelligence community the study has implications for intelligence reform information sharing congressional oversight and society's expectations about the degree to which the intelligence community can predict or prevent surprise attacks

there is a very strong association between women animals and activism in women social justice and animal advocacy activist lisa a kemmerer presents the narratives of fourteen ecofeminist activists who describe their own experiences in the field often from the perspective of discovering the extent of a particular kind of animal oppression and resolving to do something about it the narratives are bold and gripping sometimes horrifying and cover a range of topics relating to animal rights and liberation the writers discuss contemporary cockfighting factory farming orphaned primates in africa the wild bird trade scientific experimentation on animals laws against dangerous dogs and violence against baby seals sister species provides a wide survey of what women are doing in the animal activism movement the writers ask readers to rethink how we view animals in our daily lives and how we can take action to protect them kemmerer s introduction explains why she collected these particular stories and how she views the relationship between feminism and animal suffering the foreword is by carol j adams author of the sexual politics of meat 1990 neither man nor beast feminism and the defense of animals 1994 the feminist care tradition in animal ethics a reader 2007 and many other books none of these essays has been previously published
