

The Football Factory

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the football factory centres on tom johnson a reasoned chelsea hooligan who represents a disaffected society operating by brutal rules we are shown the realities of life social degradation unemployment racism casual violence excessive drink and bad sex and perhaps more importantly how they fall into a political context of surveillance media manipulation and division graphic

and disturbing sometimes very funny and deeply affecting throughout the football factory is a vertiginous rush of adrenaline the most authentic book yet on the so called english disease

fever pitch with testosterone and eight pints of lager like fever pitch it is not exclusively a novel about football this is a chronicle of a lost tribe the white anglo saxon heterosexual who is fed up with being told he is crap it is the story of a flight from fear by a group of londoners who have seen the present and know it does not work king writes powerfully with a raw realism and clear grasp of a culture which has been denied but cannot be ignored glasgow herald

sport offers everything a good story should have heroes and villains triumph and disaster achievement and despair tension and drama consequently sport makes for a compelling film narrative and films in turn are a vivid medium for sport yet despite its regularity as a central theme in motion pictures constructions and representations of sport and athletes have been marginalised in terms of serious analysis within the longstanding academic study of films and documentaries in this collection it is the critical study of film and its connections to sport that are examined the collection is one of the first of its kind to examine the ways in which sport has been used in films as a metaphor for other areas of social life among the themes and issues explored by the contributors are morality tales in which good triumphs over evil the representation and ideological framing of social identities including class gender race and nationality the representation of key issues pertinent to sport including globalization politics commodification consumerism and violence the meanings spoken by films and the various readings which audiences make of

them this is a timely collection that draws together a diverse range of accessible insightful and ground breaking new essays this book was published as a special issue of sport in society

white trash is a liminal figure that dramatizes the intersection of race and class contemporary british novelists like irvine welsh niall griffiths and john king use this originally us american stereotype to interrogate the racializing discourse of class in british society their novels are interdiscursive reflections of the figurations of race and class that still haunt the british cultural imaginary british white trash is the first analysis to comprehensively examine the adaptation of the white trash stereotype in major british novels the study thus contributes to a critical understanding of racism and classism its cultural representations and its underlying social processes

fiction that london most especially north london has no real working class in comparison to a more authentic working class in a place called the north in doing so it offers a history and a portrait of north london s working class from the 1950s to the 21st century based on a wide and original range of sources including personal memoirs autobiographies collected oral histories and new interviews conducted by the author the result is an important social history and a rich panorama of working class life its struggles work celebrations events triumphs tragedies and the occasional nice little earner for good or ill from the start of post war affluence in the 1950s to the economic crash of 2008 north london s working class had a life experience like almost no other part of the british working class one not just of poverty racism and exploitation but also of bold new housing schemes in the heart of the city of great opportunity and diversity and enjoyment its about time to tell that story

howells medal of the american academy of arts and letters he died in january 2009 christopher carduff the editor of this volume is a member of the staff of the library of america
