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The Upwelling
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excerpt from the editorial in the journal of new historical perspectives vol 3 4 2011 on the night of july 15 1903 nikola tesla powered up his 190 foot tower in wardencllyffe on long island s north shore the bolts of energy radiating from the apical dome were visible as far away as new haven connecticut this was the first and last time anyone would witness such a display three years later broke and unable to secure further funding tesla abandoned the wardencllyffe tower and his dream of worldwide wireless power he returned to manhattan where he promptly suffered a nervous breakdown so say the history books but new evidence has surfaced that a shadowy fraternal order stepped in and provided generous funding after j p morgan reneged witnesses state that testing of the tower continued but only on foggy days when the discharges would not be noticed the final test took place on april 18 1906 around dawn in heavy fog the tower was charged to maximum capacity across the atlantic in abereiddy wales two copper prongs attached to a 50 watt lightbulb were thrust into the ground the bulb lit tesla had proved that worldwide wireless power was possible why then at the moment of his greatest vindication did nikola tesla abandon his project what could possibly have transpired at wardencllyffe that day to so rattle him that he would deny the world his transformative technology we may never know

help i can't breathe he's trying to kill me please oh god he's killing me margery harris's last words gasped in a hoarse rasping voice on the county's 911 line for marge's doctor they weren't merely the last words of a patient they were a desperate cry for help from an old friend but they're puzzling because marge died from a fatal allergic reaction to peanuts was it possible murder by peanut her doctor noreen marconi md a 30 something family practitioner in a suburban town outside baltimore feels she owes it to marge to get to the truth a dozen years ago norrie left town as a size twenty after college medical school and residency she's back as a size ten and she wants some answers she enlists the help of sheriff's deputy travis lawton her big crush as a teen and their investigation leads them along a twisty turny path to a totally unexpected conclusion also unexpected are the feelings that begin to spark between them as they work together in the middle of all this her apartment floods and she has to move back into the old family home with her mother a house that's now haunted by the ghost of her father rx murder is the first of a series blending romance murder mystery and the paranormal

oh mrs sirman there's a problem with your husband's cremation what sort of problem it's his body what about it it won't burn and so it begins for pam sirman the first step toward learning that everything she thought she knew about her husband is wrong perhaps even his humanity but if he's not human what is he pam is one of three lives that will be drawn together by the apocalypse of the upwelling the other two are chan and dannii but their worlds are already in chaos a few weeks ago a fierce storm accompanied by an upwelling from the atlantic abyssal plain tore into atlantic city when it receded the city and its 25 000 inhabitants were gone without a trace chan and dannii remember being in the city that day but the ten hours during which the upwelling occurred have been wiped from their memories they want those memories back or do they did they witness something so unspeakably ghastly that their minds can't face it or worse was that ghastly thing something they did and worst yet were they responsible for the upwelling

darrell schweitzer's third collection of essays and reviews a successor to the well received windows of the imagination and the fantastic horizon is a balanced mixture of scholarship and entertainment ranging over the entire spectrum of imaginative literature from the oldest novel in the world 1st century b c to classic and not so classic pulp fiction to childhood reading to examinations of the works of such masters as h p lovecraft m r james robert bloch stanley weinbaum john w campbell and thomas m disch in between we encounter such surprising topics as a proposal for an h p lovecraft biopic the whole wide lovecraft the eccentricities of william beckford the author of vathek and even a report from blobfest an annual street fair devoted to the famous 1958 cult film at which schweitzer as a member of the press was allowed to touch the original blob many of these pieces have been published in the prestigious the new york review of science fiction schweitzer writes in an informative style that's knowledgeable witty and high accessible this is the finest kind of criticism it makes you want to read more both of the critic's own prose and that of the writers he's discussing highly recommended robert reginald darrell schweitzer is a novelist short story writer and critic a former editor of the legendary weird tales magazine and a four time world fantasy award finalist and one time winner his previous book of essays the fantastic

horizon was a finalist for the mythopoeic award

twilight has come night will follow it will begin in the heavens and end in the earth but before that the rules will be broken the change is coming and the world as we know it is ending sixteen year old ellie has changed she looks the same but her mother detects someone else looking out through her blue eyes ellie builds a shelter in her room with an entrance that leads elsewhere and what of the convoy of tractor trailers hari tate watches drive up a mountain road and return without the trailers leaving nothing on the mountain what are they shipping and the writer who finds a hole in the floor of his nyc apartment and tumbles through into elsewhere they will all find each other and find their answers in the electromagnetic pulses piercing the earth from out there pulses that no one should hear but some do but they are not simply pulses they are signalz

rx mayhem picks up only hours after the finish of rx murder dr norrie marconi is in a good place she s solved an old friend s murder and her love life is blooming she still has issues to deal with such as her father s ghost and that malpractice suit but she feels like things are settling down and she s getting her life in order wrong the senior doctor in her medical group drops a bombshell that threatens to disrupt her life some of the patients start acting strange and one winds up near death from multiple gunshot wounds then there s her father s ghost who insists he won t be free until she finds out what happened to his boyhood friend corrado whom he s sure was murdered when norrie s inquiry turns up a dark side to corrado she hires an eccentric psychic to free her father from the family home and that s when things take a sharp left turn

rage terror and redemption these are the stones upon which f paul wilson builds the concluding chapter of repairman jack the early years the prequel trilogy focusing on the formative years of wilson s globally popular supernatural troubleshooter the strands of jack s life established in the first two books cold city and dark city are now woven into a complete pattern centered around an obscure group of malcontents intent on creating a terrible explosion in new york city in 1993 fear city shows the final stages of young jack becoming repairman jack it is a dark and terrible story full of plots and needless mayhem with secret agents a freelance torturer a secret society as old as human history love death and a very bleak triumph jack threads his way through this intricate maze as people he loves are stripped away from him in a way that presages the later epic series of novels at the publisher s request this title is being sold without digital rights management software drm applied

an original graphic novel starring repairman jack written by series creator f paul wilson and illustrated by antonio james bond fuso got a problem he can fix it he thought he d seen the last of the rakoshi but one has survived a particularly cunning and deadly rakosh known to jack as scar lip now jack faces the fights of his life

as he seeks to end the creature once and for all before it ends him

this third volume collects all the stories of paul wilson published from 2000 to 2020 presented in chronological order with introductory notes by the author this is a monumental and historical document as well as a wonderful celebration a staggeringly impressive career by one of our best included in this collection anna performance sole custody the tapework letters hunters interlude at duane s do gooder the sound of blunder piney power pranksters renaissance the compendium of srem secret ingredient the long and the short of it to the lonely sea and the sky ellie the last bonneville

double dose picks up right where double threat leaves off with a snarl of threads to tie up a host of mysteries to explain all complicated by some embarrassing intrusions from the past so many secrets in nespodee springs the biggest is revealed when rhys and daley track down the second half of the pendry film and learn the secrets of the clan s tesla tower and the catastrophic details of the plan to bring the visitors back to earth but the insidious malady known as the horrors remains a mystery claiming more and more victims every day daley and pard learn they can cure it if only the powers that be will allow them daley finds herself in an ironic situation for the first time in her life she s trying to play it straight help people instead of scam them and no one will let her in the past when she s spun a web of lies the marks lapped it up like honey now when she s telling the truth a life saving truth no one believes her and meanwhile over the salton sea an ominous darkness is growing

jack is back wilson never said he was through with repairman jack he said he was through turning in a new novel every year he also said when a story came along that was right for jack he d write it the last christmas is that story it s late december between ground zero and fatal error a winter of discontent for jack who s perhaps spending too much time hanging at julio s an old contact edward burkes convinces him to take on a missing person fix as usual nothing is as it seems and the missing person isn t exactly a person in fact it s like nothing anyone has ever seen and in the middle of all this the mysterious madame de medici hires him to safeguard a valuable object simple right not even close yep jack is back and as usual weird trouble is on his heels
