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noh is a major form of classic japanese musical drama that has been performed since the 14th century this title introduces the work of the noh mask artist michishige udaka it presents photographs of 32 typical noh masks shot in dynamic lightings and close up angles it features captions that explain characters of each mask noh is a major form of classic japanese musical drama that has been performed since the 14th century many characters are masked with men playing both the male and female roles the repertoire is normally limited to a specific set of historical

a remarkable combination of superb artistry sophisticated design and a lengthy history of continuous usage sets the masks of the noh theater of japan apart from all others that so little is known outside of japan about their great beauty and brilliant craftsmanship prompted the author to undertake the two decades of study research and writing that has culminated in this work the result is nearly 800 pages of text and images published in a two volume boxed edition limited to 1200 copies volume 1 consists of an extended treatise on the history of noh and the evolution of its masks including mask forms and functions types and roles nomenclature and taxonomy mask carvers and their lineages signatures and other markings it includes plot and character synopses of the plays most often staged as well as others rarely performed with particulars about the masks used by various troupes for the principal roles volume 2 is an album

showcasing in full color over 140 of the finest masks of noh both ancient and more recent with detailed information on their creation character and significance as well as photos of their backs showing inscriptions and artists signatures an extensive bibliography glossary and index round out this presentation of an exquisite centuries old art form no existing publication on the subject in either english or in japanese remotely compares in scope and depth to the present work

the third volume in dr sky s inspiring five part sohokido series pathways iii and iv masks and rituals focuses on two powerful tools for use in therapeutic healing and self discovery sohokido a japanese hybrid word created by dr sky essentially means the way of transpersonal creativity this book explains the third and fourth of its seven pathways using masks and rituals as therapy can be extremely effective as an alternative to more traditional and clinical methods using a myriad of discoveries from dr sky s own creative and spiritual journey including centuries old japanese noh theater techniques and finnish lamenting traditions pathways iii and iv masks and rituals will inspire you to access the healing power available to us all through sohokido and its unique and life changing insights into spirituality and the self

cursed masks explores the captivating intersection of history and spirituality through the lens of masks believed to harbor spiritual forces or bring misfortune diving into cultural beliefs and folklore the book reveals how masks beyond their physical form have been perceived as conduits for the occult and concealed identity from ancient rituals to modern interpretations masks reflect humanity s enduring fascination with hidden realms and the darker aspects of the human psyche the book deconstructs the idea of inherent power in masks arguing that their perceived potency stems from deeply ingrained cultural beliefs and psychological projections it progresses systematically beginning with foundational concepts of mask symbolism across cultures then moves into case studies of masks associated with malevolent forces finally it culminates in an analysis of the psychological underpinnings of these beliefs revealing how masks tap into primal fears and desires

w anthony sheppard considers a wide ranging constellation of important musical works in this fascinating exploration of ritualized performance in twentieth century music revealing masks uncovers the range of political didactic and aesthetic intents that inspired the creators of modernist music theater sheppard is especially interested in the use of the exotic in techniques of masking and stylization identifying japanese noh medieval christian drama and ancient greek theater as the most prominent exotic models for the creation of total theater drawing on an extraordinarily diverse and in some instances little known range of music theater pieces sheppard cites the work of igor stravinsky benjamin britten arthur honegger peter maxwell davies harry partch and leonard bernstein as well as andrew lloyd webber and madonna artists in literature theater and dance such as william butler yeats paul claudel bertolt brecht isadora duncan ida rubenstein and edward gordon craig also play a significant role in this study sheppard poses challenging questions that will interest readers beyond those in the field of music scholarship for example what is the effect on the audience and the performers of depersonalizing ritual elements does borrowing from foreign cultures inevitably amount to a kind of predatory

appropriation revealing masks shows that compositional concerns and cultural themes manifested in music theater are central to the history of twentieth century euro american music drama and dance

an examination of the conventions and techniques of the greek theatre of menander and subsequent roman theatre

the final volume in dr skys inspiring five book sohkido series explores pathway vii therapeutic noh theater

in 1999 fukuoka city museum collected 169 noh and kyōgen masks including eighteen presumably passed on by the koruda family many of them were made by hereditary mask carvers some are dated back to the 16th century the exhibition omote the world of noh masks introduces about 70 great pieces selected out of the collection of the museum we hope the exhibition will help you to explore the beautiful world of noh a refined art developed over a long passage of time foreward

bookwise is a carefully graded reading scheme organized into five cross curricular strands encouraging links to other subjects comprising 16 fiction and ten non fiction titles the 25 books at each level span a two year reading age and the three tier levelling system within each level facilitates an accurate match of reading ability and text the full colour readers are accompanied by teacher s guides and resource sheets to help teachers get the most out of their guided reading and writing sessions

object lessons is a series of short beautifully designed books about the hidden lives of ordinary things from the theater mask and masquerade to the masked criminal and the rise of facial recognition software masks have long performed as an instrument for the protection and concealment of identity even as they conceal and protect masks as faces are an extension of the self at the same time they are a part of material culture what are masks made of what traces do they leave behind acknowledging that that mask wearing has become increasingly weaponized and politicized sharrona pearl looks at the politics of the mask exploring how identity itself is read on this object by exploring who we do and do not seek to protect through different forms of masking sharrona pearl s long history of masks helps us to better understand what it is we value object lessons is published in partnership with an essay series in the atlantic
