michel de certeau is becoming increasingly recognised as a cultural theorist whose methodologies could rival those of foucault in this engaging book ben highmore provides a stimulating account of michel de certeau s work and its relation to the field of cultural studies the book explores those aspects of de certeau s work that both challenge and re imagine cultural studies highlighting the potential this work has for supplying a critical epistemology and a practical ethics for the study of culture within the arts and humanities more generally michel de certeau analysing culture provides an ideal introduction to the work of this extraordinary and important thinker

since his death in 1986 michel de certeau s reputation as a thinker has steadily grown both in france and throughout the english speaking world his work is extraordinarily innovative and wide ranging cutting across issues in historiography literary and cultural studies anthropology sociology theology philosophy and psychoanalysis this book represents the first full length study of certeau

stheought it is organized around the central theme of interpretationand alterity which ahearne uses to illuminate certeau s work as awhole the author also examines certeau s theory and practice ofhistoriography his reflection on the relations between changinghistorical forms of writing reading and orality and hisdistinction between the strategic programmes of the politicallypowerful and the tactics of the relatively powerless ahearne places certeau s work in its general intellectual context relating it to the views of important contemporary thinkers suchas pierre bourdieu and michel foucault and demonstrating thedecisive importance to certeau s thought of the writings of theearly modern mystics and travellers this book constitutes an excellent critical introduction tocerteau s work while also providing a comprehensive and nuancedreading for those already familiar with his thought

a historian of early christianity considers various theoretical critiques to examine the problems and opportunities posed by the ways in which history is written clark argues for a renewal of the study of premodern western history through engagement with the critical methods that have transformed other humanities disciplines in recent decades

throughout chartier keeps his focus on historians who have stressed the relations between the products of discourse and social practices

in his book *I tranger ou l union dans la difference* the french jesuit historian michel de certeau 1921 1986 wrote when we confess our incapacity to know others we confess simultaneously their existence our own to which we are returned and a fundamental reciprocity between them and us to the extent we agree not to identify ourselves with anything they can expect from us and not to identify them with satisfactions or assurances we hope to take from them we discover the sense of the poverty which funds all communication this poverty signifies in effect both the desire which unites us to others and the difference which separates us from them the same is the structure of faith in god an elegant statement which opens for its reader a way to understanding how like a relation of trust in any other christian faith in the other god begins and ends with the unknown humans are incapable of fully grasping others either with their minds or their wills the same is true of the relation of faith in the other given humans are ever different from but desirous of union with others the everyday ideal of all communication in trust is an attitude which has as its goal neither

control nor change of the other but rather union in difference also therefore the everyday ideal in faith george b york ii holds an ma from st louis university an m th from the jesuit school of theology berkeley and is currently completing a ph d at the gregorian university rome he lives in denver colorado where over fifty years ago he was introduced to the jesuits who became his way to meeting his mentor michel de certeau

ben highmore traces the development of conceptions of everyday life from georg simmel s cultural sociology through the mass observation project of the thirties to theorists such as michel curteau

the 1930s were one of the most important decades in defining the history of the twentieth century it saw the rise of right wing nationalism the challenge to established democracies and the full force of imperialist aggression cultural encounters makes an important contribution to our understanding of the ideological and cultural forces which were active in defining notions of national identity in the 1930s by examining the work of writers and journalists from a range of european countries who used the medium of travel writing to articulate perceptions of their own and other cultures the book gives a comprehensive account of the complex intellectual climate of the 1930s

this book presents a new reading of the history of french social science and religion through an investigation of early sociology s techniques for narrating the category of belief the author argues that by looking at the history of social sciences in this manner we gain a deeper understanding of both our present debates on post secularity as well as our modernist past both of which were thoroughly shaped by their reflections and critiques on the notion of belief yet failed to enter into any sort of meaningful communication with each other this book seeks to rectify this failure by introducing the concept of belief languages an anthropological framework designed to historicize different discussions on belief and allow for their comparative description and analysis

this text provides an overview of major critical theorists from across disciplines including the humanities social sciences and education that discusses the importance of these critical perspectives for the advancement of lis research and scholarship the practical application of library and information science is based upon 75 years of critical theory and thought therefore it is essential for students and faculty in lis to be familiar with the work of a wide range of critical theorists the aim of critical theory for library and information science exploring the social from across the disciplines is to provide a comprehensive introduction to the critical theorists important to the lis audience and to give insights into how such theory can be incorporated into actual lis research and practice this book consists of chapters on individual critical theorists ranging from aglietta to habermas to spivak written by an international group of library and information science scholars each chapter provides an overview of the theoretical stance and contributions of the theorist as well as relevant critical commentary this book will be particularly valuable as a reference text of core readings for those pursuing doctoral or masters level degrees in lis

de certeau is often considered to be the theorist of everyday life par excellence this book provides an unrivalled critical introduction to de certeau s work and influence and looks at his key ideas and asks how should we try to understand him in relation to theories of modern culture and society ian buchanan demonstrates how de certeau was influenced by lacan merleau ponty and greimas and the meaning of de certeau s notions of strategy tactics place and space are clearly described the book argues that de certeau died before developing the full import of his work for the study of culture and convincingly it tries to complete or imagine the directions that de certeau s work would have taken had he lived

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
