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this volume initiates a new series of books on maritime or underwater archaeology and as the editor of the series i welcome its appearance with great excitement it is appropriate that the first book of the series is a collection of articles intended for gradu ate or undergraduate courses in underwater archaeology since the growth in academic opportunities for students is an

important sign of the vitality of this subdiscipline the layman will enjoy the book as well academic and public interest in shipwrecks and other submerged archaeological sites is indicated by a number of factors every year there are 80 to 90 research papers presented at the society for historical archaeology's conference on historical and underwater archaeology and the proceedings are published public interest is shown by extensive press coverage of shipwreck investigations one of the most important advances in recent years has been the passage of the abandoned shipwreck act of 1987 for the first time providing national level law concerning underwater archaeological sites the legislation has withstood a number of legal challenges by commercial treasure salvors a very hopeful sign for the long term preservation of this nonrenewable type of cultural resource the underwater archaeological discoveries of 1995 were particularly noteworthy the texas historical commission discovered the belle one of la salle's ships and the css hunley was found by a joint project of south carolina and a private nonprofit organization called numa

school textbooks in iran saudi arabia egypt and elsewhere in the arab and muslim worlds are filled with anti western and anti israel propaganda most readers will be shocked to discover that history and geography textbooks widely used in america's elementary and secondary classrooms contain some of the very same inaccuracies about jews judaism and israel did you know that there is no record of any important jewish contribution to the sciences world civilizations thomson wadsworth or that christianity was started by a young palestinian named jesus the world scott foresman pearson supplemental materials and other classroom influences

are even worse the trouble with textbooks exposes the poor scholarship and untruths in textbooks about jews and israel the problems uncovered in this ground breaking analysis are instructive and illustrate the need for reform in the way textbooks are developed written marketed and distributed substitute another area how we teach american history western civilization or comparative religion and we have another equally intriguing case study the trouble with textbooks shows what can go terribly wrong in discussing religion geography culture or history and in this case all of them the trouble with textbooks tells a cautionary tale for all readers whatever their background of how textbooks that americans depend on to infuse young people with the values for good citizenship and to help acculturate students into the multicultural salad that is american life instead disparage some groups and teach historical distortions with millions of young people using these textbooks each year the denigration of some should be a concern for all

the language of the past analyzes the use of history in discourses within the political media and the public sphere it examines how particular terms phrases and allusions first came into usage developed and how they are employed today to speak of something or someone as representing the stone age or characterize an institution as byzantine to describe a business relationship as feudal or to disparage ideals or morality as victorian refers to both a perception of the past and its relationship to the present whilst dictionaries and etymologies define meanings and origin points of words or phrases this study examines how history is maintained and used within society through language detailing the specific words and phrases associated with particular periods used to describe contemporary society this thorough examination of language and history will be of great interest to those studying historiography social history and linguistics

water is a vital resource and is widely acknowledged as such thus it often serves as an ideological and linguistic symbol that stands for and evokes concepts central within a community this volume explores thinking of water and concepts expressed through references to water within the symbolic system of the late persian early hellenistic period and as it does so it sheds light on the social mindscape of the early second temple community

in addition to sections devoted to latin paleography diplomatics computer assisted research numismatics archaeology problems in chronology and prospography this text describes state of the art research methodology and critical approaches to english literature latin philosophies law science art and music

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
